

Telephone entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the Board of Directors of the CKC may otherwise authorize. Online entries and/or credit card payment will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD or AMEX credit card number. Customers' charges that are declined will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date. It is recommended that you phone after you fax your entry to ensure that it was received and readable. #### Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will NOT be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Post- dated cheques will NOT be accepted. Please DO NOT mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank-you.

BORDER CROSSING – A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada, Government Regulations require a Certificate prior to entry into Canada.

#### Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at: (416) 675-5511 or Fax (416) 675 -6506.

DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN THE SHOW OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY TO BE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. THE PRECINCTS OF THIS SHOW SHALL BE 30' AROUND THE RINGS.

### **CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 +
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group. 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

#### As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHEX) for details.

## CONFORMATION: The following classes will be provided, divided by sex. <u>REGULAR CLASSES</u>

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

**12-18 MONTH CLASS** - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

**CANADIAN BRED** - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded. **BRED BY EXHIBITOR** - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

**OPEN CLASS** - shall be for all Dogs.

**FIELD CLASS** – shall be for dogs who have attained a title or placement in a field trial OR test. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered. This class is judged prior to Best of Breed judging and the winners in each sex will compete for Best of Breed

**VETERAN CLASS** – This class is for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. This class will be divided into 7 years of age and under 10 years and 10+ years of age. These dogs will compete for regular placements with the first-place males and females in each age division competing Best of Breed, Best Veteran in Specialty and Best Opposite Sex Veteran in Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Class do not compete for championship points. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

**SPECIALS ONLY** - A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

## **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

**BABY PUPPY CLASS** DOGS 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes

## **UNOFFICIAL CLASSES**

**EXTENDED GENERATIONS** – Shall be comprised of 3 dogs representing three successive generations. Specifically, the entry must be a dog or bitch, one offspring of that dog or bitch and one offspring of that offspring. Each dog/bitch must be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only but only one entry fee is paid. This entry may not be of the same sex. All three dogs are judged. Ownership is not a consideration – each dog/bitch can have different ownership. Judge's decision is based on the merits and likeness of the entry of three.

## **CONFORMATION TROPHY LIST**

Rosettes and/or a suitable prize will be offered for the following awards:

Best in Specialty, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Male, Select Female, BOW, Best Puppy, Best Veteran, Best Opposite Sex Veteran, Winners Male, Winners Female, Reserve Winners Male, Reserve Winners Female, Best Field Dog, Best Extended Generations, Best Baby Puppy, First through Fourth in each Class.

A prize will be offered for High Scoring Golden Retriever at the WKKC Obedience Trial on Monday August 29<sup>th</sup>.

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members." EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS - SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent. ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

**ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1** 

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

a. registered with the CKC

b. have an Event Registration Number

c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or

d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous

Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

**DISQUALIFICATIONS - SECTION 14.1.4** 

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.



## GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

- \_\_\_\_\_
- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are PACIFIC TIME.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$107.80 + GST (CKC member) or \$161.60 + GST (non-member) which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13. The Club has a zero tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with these shows, including spectators. Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Lakes District Kennel Club Shows individuals will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds).
- 14. For all other rules governing these shows, please read the Premium List for the WKKC shows thoroughly.

#### Number (MCN) REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

**DISQUALIFICATIONS - SECTION 14.1.4** 

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

BORDER CROSSING - A RABIES CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED TO BRING A DOG INTO CANADA, GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE AND IT MUST BE DATED AT LEAST 30 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY INTO CANADA.

This number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a photocopy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and the appropriate fee (currently \$58.50) with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering events only)

#### Gates will be locked and re-opened at 6:00am on Sunday, August 28th, No Exceptions!!

All vehicles must be parked within the boundaries of the show site as directed by the parking personnel. No exhibitor tow vehicle/cargo trailers will be permitted to park on the show grounds. Self-contained vehicles only. Extra trailers and vehicles will need to be parked in the parking lot.

There are water and a sani-dumps available in Castlegar. There are no showers available. Dry camping only. No hook-ups for power, water or sewage are available. Absolutely NO discharging of <u>clean</u>, grey or black water! Porta potties with wash stations will be available on site.

DAY TENTING - Limited pre-booked and paid 10 x 10 spots available within the ball diamonds. NO GENERATORS. Vehicles will have to be parked with regular show parking and your equipment and tents will need to be transported by hand to the day tenting area. When the ball diamonds are full, day tenting will be available in the RV area where you can also park your vehicle at your 10 x 10 spot. If you want your day tent in the RV area, please let me know when making your reservation. Otherwise your spot will be in the ball diamonds until they are full. Your spot may be in the obedience or the conformation diamonds depending on available space. If you require the use of a generator, you MUST book a day tent in the RV Area. Only professional handlers with more than 4 dogs entered each day are permitted in the Handler Row in the parking lot (space is limited).

Vehicles parked on grass must have ground cover placed under their generators and/or exhaust pipe extensions to protect the grass. Violators will be required to leave and no refunds given.

Please exhaust away from your neighbour. All generators must be turned off between 10:00pm and 6:30am daily.

There is no security in the RV or ball diamond areas, leaving your belongings is at your own risk.

If the weather is wet, the gates will be closed and NO ONE will be allowed to drive onto the grounds after parking your RV. Day parking will also have to walk to their sites so, please be prepared.

Please note: If you have friends dropping off dogs to be shown, or extra equipment, they will need to park in day parking and walk down to the RV area. Any vehicles who do not have a RV reservation will be not be allowed into the RV Parking area (last year we had too many people parking in fire lanes and not moving vehicles when asked).

We are going to try not taking damage deposits this year. If any damage occurs, we will reinstate a higher deposit next year.

GARBAGE - If you purchase items while you are enjoying our beautiful town and the packaging cannot fit into our dumpsters (<u>YOU MUST BREAK IT DOWN</u>), you are REQUIRED to take it home with you or dispose of it OFF the show grounds. Last year we spent over an hour collecting large cardboard boxes and trash out of the treeline where people had hidden it. Anyone seen doing this will not be welcome in our RV Camping area next year.

NO FOUL OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE WILL BE TOLERATED. ANYONE ARGUING OR NOT FOLLOWING OUR PARKING RULES (OR VOLUNTEER'S INSTRUCTIONS) WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE AND NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN. WE ARE ALL VOLUNTEERS AND POLITENESS AND RESPECT IS MANDATORY. WE ALL WANT TO HAVE A GREAT SHOW, LET'S KEEP IT HAPPY AND FUN.
