CKC RULES REGARDING APPROACHING JUDGES AND REGARDING INDIGNITIES

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Baby Puppy	A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show
Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Altered Class	For sexually altered dogs only.
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over not in competition. Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

Junior Handling

Judge to be announced. Held under CKC Rules. Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the Show Secretary. A Junior Handler may compete with any dog entered in the Show provided he/she has the consent of the owner or agent to do so. If necessary, due to conflict, substitution of dog will be allowed. Dogs being used in the competition, **MUST BE OF APPROPRIATE SIZE AND TEMPERAMENT FOR THE JUNIOR HANDLER.**

4.1 Class Structure (Age Requirements)

- (a) PEE WEE CLASS - For handlers 4 years of age up to 6 years of age. Optional and noncompetitive. No placements are to be awarded, participant ribbons, rosettes and token prizes may be presented.
- (b) JUNIOR NOVICE CLASS - For handlers 7 to 10 years who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.
- (c) JUNIOR OPEN CLASS - For handlers 7 to 10 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Junior Novice Class, OR any handler wishing to enter this level. It is understood that once that handler has entered and competed in the Open Class, he/she may not compete in the Novice Class again.
- (d) INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS - For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.
- (e) INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS - For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have won six first places in the same class with competition.
- (f) SENIOR NOVICE CLASS - For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.
- (g) SENIOR OPEN CLASS - For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he/she has enough experience to compete at this level.

4.2 BEST OVERALL

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only on the day of competition. Entry to be made at the show. Dogs being used in the competition must be of appropriate size and temperament for the Junior Handler.

Refund Policy

If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. However, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry, and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation are appreciated. Thank you.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

- 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from zero (0) to five (5)) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.
- 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

- 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

- 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.
- 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs which are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number, simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership: for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed"; however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

Junior Handling (Conformation)

Junior handling will be held Saturday & Sunday during the lunch break. Dogs competing in junior handling must be entered in the show in one of the regular classes or on exhibition only. Registration will take place each morning (by 11:00 am) at the Secretary's table. Entry fee is \$2.00 (correct change is appreciated)

Catalogues

Pre-Order Catalogues are available at \$15.00 per copy. Pre-ordered catalogues must be paid for at time of ordering (with entry). Catalogues will not be mailed to absent exhibitors. A limited number of catalogues will be available for sale at the show on a "First-Come First Served" basis. (Correct change is appreciated)

CKC HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease; Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises, and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Tantramar Kennel Club, its officers, associates, Show Committee and Mowatt Canine Company, will use due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. The Tantramar Kennel Club (and Mowatt Canine Company) will not be responsible for equipment left on site overnight.

The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials, which are governed by CKC rules

The site will be open no earlier than 12:00 noon until 4:00pm and again after 6:00 pm until dark on Friday May 15th for set-up. The site will be open at 7:00 AM Saturday and Sunday. Please be aware that this is also a place of business & that there will be other customers coming in on Saturday and Sunday mornings so it will be busy during that time. No Exhibitors will be allowed in for set-up between 4:00 - 6:00 pm on Friday as that time is reserved for business customers.

NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT ON SITE OVERNIGHT. BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring grounds.

Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.

Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds' conflict.

Due to the limited amount of space, the Superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to co-operate with the Superintendent in this regard.

Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.

Please keep your dogs crated when unattended and clean up after your dogs.

SHOW PRECINCTS - The precincts of the show shall be the fenced area of the rings and 10 feet surrounding the rings.

Parking Yan Mowatt, and her staff, will be in complete charge of parking. Everyone is to abide by their instructions as they know the ground on the site and where best to park your vehicle.
