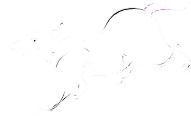

### DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From the USA: Take the Pacific Truck Crossing. Go north on 176 Street. Do a U-Turn at 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue and go south till you get to 3507 – 176 Street.

From Highway 1: Take the 176 Street exit heading south. When you cross 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue start watching for the driveway on your right.

From Highway 99: Take the 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue exit and stay on 32<sup>nd</sup> until you reach 168<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn left on 168<sup>th</sup> Street, Turn right on 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Turn right on 176 Street. Watch for driveway on the right.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. **FLEXI LEASHES ARE NOT PERMITTED INSIDE ANY BUILDINGS.** There is **NO SMOKING** in this facility or on the grounds. If you must smoke you will need to do so inside your vehicle and dispose of the butts in the vehicle also (this is a City Ordinance). Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers.



### RUNNING ORDER:

Dogs will be run in height order with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different staged groups.



**AWARDS:** Certificates of attendance shall be given to all workshop participants Ribbons will be given to all qualifiers and the Instinct test. Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place in Novice through Master.



Please bring weather appropriate gear. These trials will be held indoors but the facility is affected by the outside temperature. There will be crating space available inside the building but please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited.



**Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial.** Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes, entry fees will not be refunded. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.



Please bring adequate water for you and your dogs. There will be a potluck Lunch, bring something to share and there are also numerous fast food restaurants within 5-10 minutes of the trial.
