Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes – it will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

The Dog Show Rules states a judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR GOLDEN RETRIEVERS

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months

Bred by Exhibitor Canadian Bred Open

Veterans Specials Only **Exhibition Only** Baby Puppy (3-6 Months) – does not compete for championship points

Veterans class will be divided into - 7 up to 9 years, 9 up to 12 years, 12 years and older

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her Progeny only

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed, colour and identical ownership

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Field Dog - shall be for any dog that has earned a title at WC Test, Hunt Tests or a placement at a Field Trial

Parade of Title Holders - is open to any titleholder of any country. Dog must be entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition only.

Parade of Veterans - shall be for all dogs and bitches seven years of age or over

Note: Parade of Title Holders and Parade of Veterans - Owners are requested to submit a resume of their dogs' accomplishments at the time of entry - limit 100 words.

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

SWEEPSTAKES

Baby Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 3 months up to but not including 6 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be two classes in all, divided by sex.

for Goldens at least 3 months of age up to but not including 6 months. **Baby Puppy**

The winners of these classes, Best Baby Puppy Male and Best Baby Puppy Female will compete for Best Baby Puppy in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to the first, second, third and fourth places in the class and Best Baby Puppy in Sweepstakes.

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Goldens at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months. Senior Class for Goldens at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months. 12-18 Open for Goldens at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 up to 9 years for Goldens at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years 9 up to 12 years for Goldens at least 9 years of age up to but not including 12 years

12 years of age and older for Goldens 12 years of age and older

For Best Baby Puppy, Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes

Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 21

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

for all purebred dogs over 6 months of age. (Not eligible for HIT Competition) Pre-Novice "A" Classes for dogs handled by owner or immediate family member through all exercises. "B" Classes for trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Cdn. OTCh.

degree or dogs who have earned titles in another country.

for dogs who have completed a C.D. title in Canada.(Not eligible for "C" Classes

H.I.T.competition)

C.D.I. Class Novice -Intermediate, for dogs who have earned a C.D. title in Canada (Not

eligible for H.I.T. Competition)

for dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada. Open A Open B for dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada

Utility A for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. but not a U.D.in Canada.

Utility B for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. or U.D. in Canada

Exhibition Dogs 6 months & over, not in competition.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Brace Class - is open to any two dogs of either sex which have attained no less than a CD degree in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs, nor that they be of the same sex. The Brace Class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class except that any non-qualifying score of an exercise will be automatically a zero for that exercise rather than less than 50%.

Veterans Class - is open to all dogs seven years of age or older, who have attained not less than a CD degree in Canada or U.S.A. It is not necessary for the dog to be entered in any of the official CKC Obedience Classes at this trial. The test shall consist of a complete Novice routine.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms

Novice A for dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and is handled by the

owner or immediate family member

Novice B For any dog until such time as a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.

for dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and is handled by Advanced A the owner or immediate family member

For any dog that has earned the RN title. Advanced B

Excellent A for dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and is handled by

the owner or immediate family member

Excellent B For any dog that has earned the RA title.

Please ensure jump heights are indicated on entry form for Open & Utility.

- The Show & Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show premises and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The MGRC and Charlottetown Civic Centre will not be held responsible for any equipment left on the grounds overnight.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

- The MGRC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the MGRC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted on the show premises.
- The precincts of the show shall be the areas designated where the shows and trials are being held within the Charlottetown Civic Centre.
