

#### **RULES**

Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the C.K.C. and available from the Show Secretary.

A Junior Handler may compete with any dog entered in the Conformation Show provided he/she has the consent of the owner or agent to do so. If necessary, due to conflict, substitution of dog will be allowed. Dogs being used in the competition, MUST BE OF APPROPRIATE SIZE AND TEMPERMENT FOR THE JUNIOR HANDLER.

### **CLASSES OFFERED AT THIS SHOW**

#### 1A. JUNIOR NOVICE

For handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.

#### 1B. JUNIOR OPEN

For handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won six first places with competition in the Junior Novice Class, OR any handler wishing to enter this level. It is understood that once that handler has entered and competed in the Open Class, he/she may not compete in the Novice Class again.

### 2A. INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS

For handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.

### 2B. INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS

For handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won six first places in the same class with competition.

### 3A. SENIOR NOVICE CLASS

For handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

### 3B. SENIOR OPEN CLASS

For handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he/she has enough experience to compete at this level.

### 4. BEST OVERALL

Optional at the discretion of the host club.

A Rosette and Trophy will be offered for Best Overall Junior Handler.

UNOFFICIAL UP AND COMING STARS This class is open for children under the age of 6 years. It offers a perfect opportunity to introduce your child to show handling or gives your child who has been in the ring (but is under 6 years) the chance to hone their skills.

CLASSIFICATION OF CONFORMATION CLASSES (cont'd) 15–18 MONTHS - for dogs at least 15 months and under 18 months of age on day of specialty.

**CANADIAN BRED** - for dogs born in Canada, champions in any country excluded.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR** - for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. Entry may be made by any person who is the owner/co-owner or breeder/co-breeder of the dog. That person must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for a higher award.

*OPEN CLASS* - for all dogs and bitches, divided by colour (yellow, black or chocolate).

**VETERANS CLASS** - for all dogs and bitches 7 years of age and over on the date of the specialty. These dogs and bitches to compete for the regular placements, and the 1st place dog and bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Spayed/neutered dogs may compete in Veterans.

SPECIALS ONLY - for all dogs and bitches recognized as champions in the records of the C.K.C. Listed dogs cannot be entered into the Specials class. SEXUALLY ALTERED - Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure. Altered Male Class – All sexually altered males, regardless of age will be judged together. Altered Female Class – All sexually altered females, regardless of age will be judged together. Winner of each of these two divisions competes for Best Altered in Breed.

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES:**

### PLEASE NOTE COLOUR ON ENTRY FORM FOR EACH DOG ENTERED.

Note: All dogs and bitches entered in non-regular and unofficial classes MUST be entered in one of the regular classes or Exhibition Only.

*STUD DOG* - Shall be for a dog and 2 of his get. The Get must also be entered in one of the official C.K.C. classes or for Specials Only. The 3 dogs comprising the entry need not be owned by the same owner.

# CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing\* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points allocated 0 1 2 3 4 5 \*includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge <a href="SHALL NOT">SHALL NOT</a> be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

### MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

### CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 4-Section 4.7.3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
