Rolling Inspection from arrival to Roll Call

Lure Coursing Field Trial Stakes

Open Stake – for all eligible hounds one year or older, including Field Champions. When the entry in a regular stake reaches 20 after roll call, the entry will be divided into separate stakes.

Mixed Stake – if there are multiple breeds with entries of three or less, upon agreement of all owners, they will be combined in a Mixed Stake

Lure Coursing Field Trial Unofficial Stakes

Best In Field – Offered on Sunday all Best of Breed and Stakes winners from both days are eligible.

Best In Field will be run on the Regular course.

Puppy Stake – 6-9, 10-12, 13-18 months – Saturday after completion of preliminary runs

Veteran Stake (Unofficial) – dogs 7 years and older Saturday after Puppy stake

Singles Stake (Unofficial) Limit of 5 dogs – Sunday after completion of preliminary runs dogs will run full course once by themselves.

Puppy and Veteran will be run on an abbreviated course.

*TCN – Temporary Competition Number MUST be obtained from the CKC prior to entering any CKC event. TCN's will replace the previous system of entering events with dogs as 'listed' and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

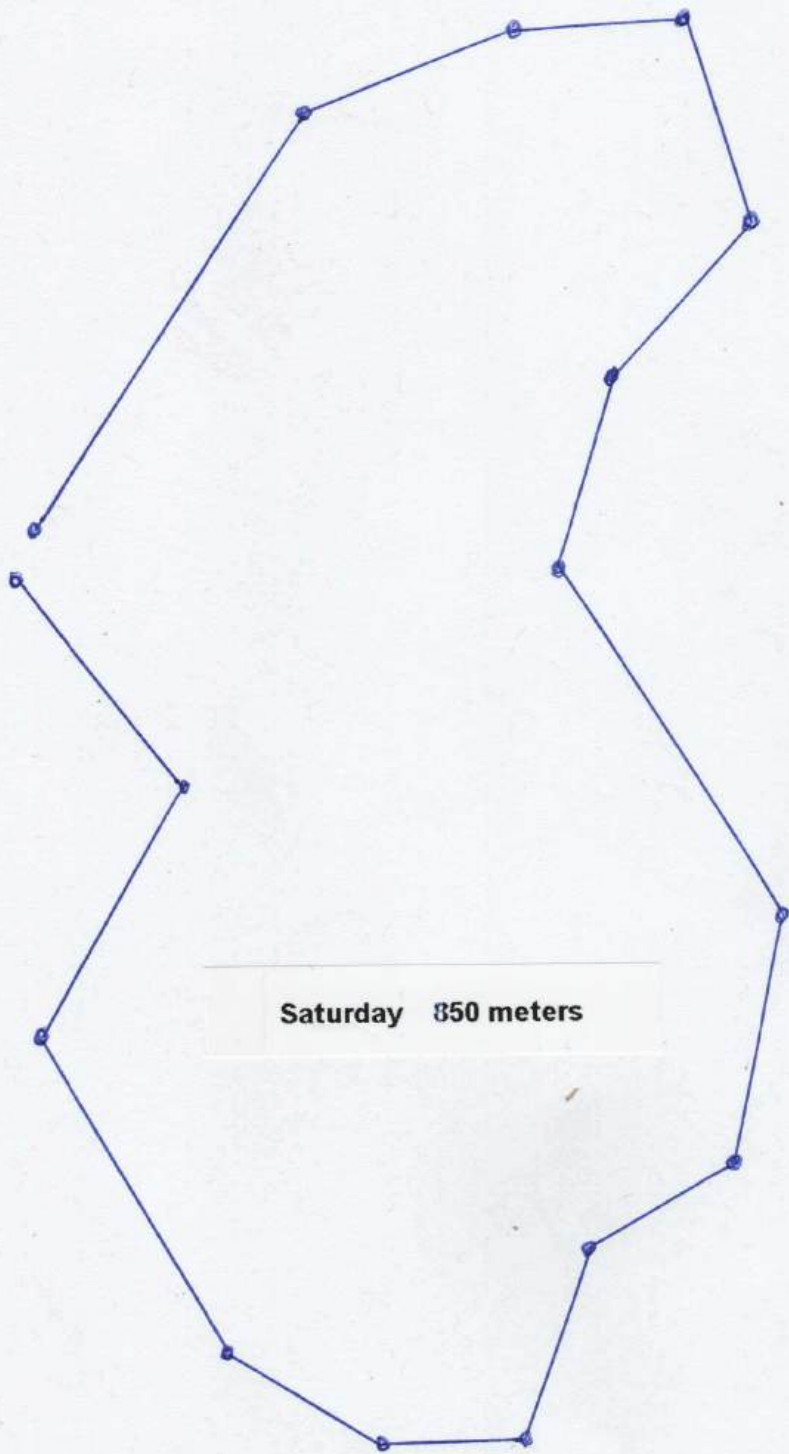

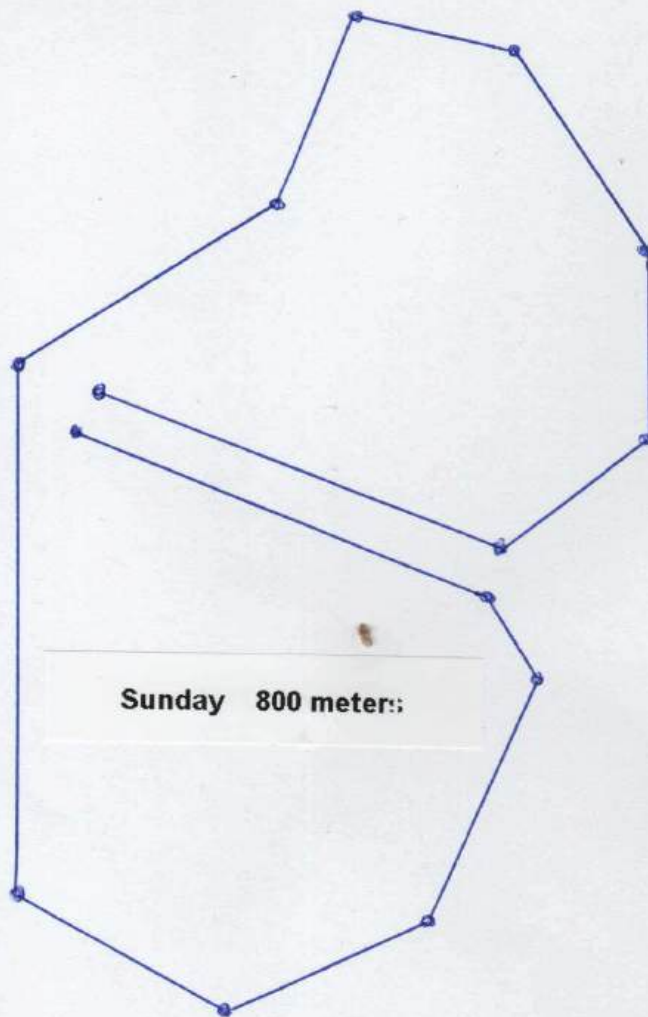

2. Use left 2 lanes to take Alberta 216 W/Anthony Henday drive exit toward West Edmonton Mall 1.5 km
3. Merge onto AB – 216 W 22.5 km
4. Take exit 25 for AB – 16 W/Trans Canada Hwy toward Jasper 1.7 km
5. Merge onto AB – 16.9 km
6. Take exit 368 toward Villeneuve/Westlock 850 m
7. Merge onto AB – 44 N 9.5 km
8. At the roundabout, take 2nd exit and stay on AB – 44 N 6.6 km
9. At the roundabout, take 2nd exit onto AB 44 N 29.8 km

EQUIPMENT AND FIELD CONDITIONS

The field is a gently rolling hay field with farm fencing (not barbed)

An electric drag will be used for all classes

CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

- Rolling inspection – check in for inspection as you arrive, with your dog(s). Inspection ends ½ hour after entries close each day (roll call). It is your responsibility to take your dog for inspection prior to roll call.
- All hounds will be run in trios or braces, twice, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched, and their entry fee will NOT be refunded. No exceptions will be made.
- All handlers MUST use a slip lead when releasing their hounds.
- Hounds may wear muzzles and/or catch collars at the owner/agent's discretion.
- **Singles:** Is your dog DQ'd, declared ineligible or not ready for running in competition? This is the place to be! Dogs will be run individually and scored by an experienced volunteer judge. A random draw will determine the order of running of dogs in this stake. No points are awarded and all ties will be settled by a coin toss. Your dog will be given one opportunity to chase the lure when it comes to the line. Handlers may not run/walk the course with their hounds. Entry limited to 5 dogs. **Dog will run the full course once.**
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused and will have their entry fee returned if notice is given to the secretary **prior** to roll call.
- The Chair may excuse any hound from competition for any reason deemed justifiable.
- A \$20.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for any hound loose on the field at any time between Roll Call and the completion of Best in Field or Regular classes.
- There is limited shade so please come PREPARED.
- There will be overnight camping.
- Water is available on the field
- Please be prepared to carry all trash off the property

**FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE RULES PERTAINING TO SOME
FAQ'S ARE PRINTED BELOW**

7.1 Eligibility of Hounds

7.1.1 To be eligible to compete at approved lure coursing field trials a dog must meet the following requirements:

- (a) A hound must be tested with another dog, of the same breed or a breed with a similar running style (preferably not a kennelmate) and certified running clean by a licensed judge or a judge who is Provisional for the breed being tested. Hounds must be a minimum of 11 months old prior to being certified, and must run either a course of at least 600 yds (548.6 m) or two courses of 300 yds (274.3 m) consecutively in order to be certified.
- (b) A certificate signed by the judge is given to the owner at the time of the test and must be submitted to the Field Trial Secretary at the dog's first trial.
- (c) All dogs must be one year of age on the date of the trial to enter a regular stake and must be registered or eligible for registration in the records of the CKC as hereinafter provided.
- (d) Any dog entered in competitive singles is not required to be certified.

1.1 Definitions

"hound" means when used in these rules: Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzois, Deerhounds (Scottish), Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS – INFO REGARDING TITLES

The following is quoted from the CKC website:

"The following non-member participation fee now applies and is retroactive to January 1, 2011.

The non-member participation fee applies to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members and a participating non-member can choose to purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member fee. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.*
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.*
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."*

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN simply mail a copy of the dog's registration certificate with a cheque money order or VISA/Mastercard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) in the amount of \$64.00 + GST payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for with 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC Event. Chapter 9.5 Placements and Awards

9.5.1 Hounds which are not to be scored are not to be added to a course.

9.5.2 Championship points in regular stakes shall be awarded on the basis of the following:

First Place: Four times the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 40 points.

Second Place: Three times the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 30 points.



Third Place: Twice the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 20 points.

Fourth Place: Points equal to the number of hounds competing in the stake to a maximum of 10 points.

Next Best Qualified Dog (NBQ): No points awarded.

Qualifying Score (QS): No points awarded.

9.5.3 A hound shall not receive a placement or be awarded points if it does not score at least 50 per cent of the total possible combined scores. Hounds which do not receive placements under this provision will, nevertheless, be considered as having been in competition for the purpose of awarding points. If a hound is excused in the preliminary run, that hound will not count as having been in competition when computing championship points. Hounds that are dismissed or declared ineligible shall count as having been in competition when computing championship points.

Membership Terms, Consents, "Own Risk Participation" Waiver, Release of Liability Form

1. Photography Consent:

I consent to having myself and or my dogs photographed while participating in events, sponsored by the association or its agents or volunteers. I agree to allow my photo, video, or likeness to be used for any legitimate marketing purpose by the activity holders, producers, sponsors, organizers, and delegates.

2. Medical Consent - Emergencies during Hosted events:

I consent to receive medical treatment which may be advisable in the event of injury, accident, and/or illness during the hosted activity and I assume financial responsibility for all such treatment received by myself and or my guests participating in events hosted by the association, whether received during the event or afterwards if such treatment is required as a result of participation in the event.

3. Own Risk Participation:

Any participation by my dogs, myself, or my guests in coursing events, or at any events sponsored by the association, including practice fun runs, competitive events or social events of the association is at my own risk.

4. Liability Waivers/Indemnity Agreement:

I will be responsible to reimburse the organization hosting the event(s), the organizing committee, its members, officers and directors, volunteers, owners of the premises upon which events are held, and/or their employees, as the case may be, for any claims for loss or injury which may be or are alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of my dog, myself or my guests, while in or upon the event(s), premises or grounds, or near any entrance to events, and I personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claims.

5. Legal Claims Waiver:

I waive any rights I may have under the law to hold responsible or make claims against any of the parties or organizations hosting or organizing events for loss of dog(s) whether by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to persons or property caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of this organization, or it's affiliated agents or volunteers, in hosting events at which my dog(s) are participating.

6. Vicarious Liability Waiver

By participating in events of any kind sponsored by the association, whether on public or private property, I assume sole responsibility for any and all loss and expenses, including legal fees on a full indemnity basis, that may be imposed by law upon the association, property owners, where events are held, volunteers, agents, or any other affiliated persons for damage, resulting from bodily injuries, including death, of myself, and my guests arising out of my participation in this event, regardless of how such injuries, death, or damage to property may be caused, or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the association, or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
