Judging will commence at 12:00 noon on Friday and 8:00 am on Saturday & Sunday unless entries warrant an earlier or later starting time. All Group Judging will commence on completion of Breed Judging within each group.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (4.1.5)

CKC HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;

Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);

Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

At events where judges will be checking bites, judges should be encouraged to have the exhibitors show the bite. If the judge insists on checking bites themselves, they are expected to use hand sanitizer or soap and water in between each exhibit. Please ensure that sanitizer wipes and bottles of hand sanitizer are available at all times at events.

ALL Entries **MUST** be received by closing date: **WEDNESDAY, June 11, 2025 @ 6:00 pm Atlantic Time**

Online entries accepted ONLY through <u>The Entry Line</u>
No other entry service is authorized to take entries for these events.
All entries paid by Credit Card, Debit Card, or eTransfer MUST be done via The Entry Line.

MAIL IN, DROPPED OFF OR EMAIL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE SHOW SECRETARY Judging schedules and Receipt of Entry and Arm Band Numbers will be emailed to all entrants.

To speed up the process of picking up your armbands - please know your armband #(s) before arriving at the Show Secretary table.

All Receipts of Entry & Armband #s will be sent via <u>nancy.downing@dogeventsecretary.ca</u> This email is an outgoing email only, please **DO NOT REPLY to any email you receive from that address, you WILL NOT receive a response.** Please add the address to your contact list to prevent emails being blocked or sent to your Spam or Junk Folder by your email provider. For any questions or concerns, please use the address listed at the top of the Premium List. The schedules will be sent to you and also posted on <u>www.canuckdogs.com</u> No extra schedules will be available on site.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. All entries must be received on or before the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper fees. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees.
- 2. Moving class dogs to specials is permitted as per CKC Rules and Regulations Section 8.9. An error in the class, date of birth or sex many be amended on the entry (in writing) at least one (1) hour prior to breed judging.
- 3. Agents and Handlers, please note that **full name and address of owners <u>MUST</u>** be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made. Please review email confirmations so corrections may be made **prior to closing date** to avoid disappointment. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receipt of any electronic entries before the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries. Until the closing date any changes to your entry can be made via The Entry Line, after the closing date please contact the Show Secretary.
- 5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date and time.
- 6. Only dogs entered in the Shows may enter the venue. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Service Dogs are welcome
- 7. The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).

Refund Policy - Covid & Otherwise: If, due to Covid, these Shows are not able to be held: refunds will be issued to exhibitors - MINUS any costs incurred by the EKC. Entry Line WILL NOT REFUND SERVICE FEES. If because of an act of God, riot or civil disobedience, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations or decree (other than Covid related), or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the EKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase a bank draft or money order in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the Non-Member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account. A dog may not move to the Specials class with a TCN. The dog must be fully registered with the CKC – CKC registration, ERN or MCN.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023**, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN. To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership to CKC, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide your full return address to enable to enable the ERN to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicated your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. Please forward your request to:



1. Grooming Space & Set-Up

EKC will be renting prime indoor 10ft x 10ft grooming spaces which includes 2 electrical outlets for the 3 days -\$60.00 total (includes HST). For more information contact: <u>cremme@eastlink.ca</u> to reserve your space. **PLEASE NOTE:** Only Exhibitors renting a space will be allowed to set up indoors for these shows. All other Exhibitors are welcome to set up in the designated parking areas free of charge. There will be NO power supplied outdoors.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Evangeline Kennel Club, its officers, associates, and Show Committee, will use due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- The Evangeline Kennel Club will not be responsible for equipment left on site overnight, or on the show premises
- The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials, which are governed by CKC rules
- The site will be open no earlier than 10:00 am Friday, June 27th for set-up. The site will be open at 7:00 AM Saturday and Sunday.
- NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT ON-SITE OVERNIGHT.
- BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring floors.
- Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes before the commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA

system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.

- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- Please keep your dogs crated when unattended, and clean up after your dogs.
- SHOW PRECINCTS The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers. This includes the fenced dog exercise area outside the show building.
- The welfare of an exhibitors child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitor will exercise control over their children while they are on the show premises.
- The building will be closed 30 minutes after the completion of judging for the day.
- Puppy for Sale or Dog for Sale signs will not be permitted in the building.
- There will be no prong/spike collars or Flexi leads permitted in the venue.
- Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or in harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table or left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed safely by the proper authorities.
- Dog Bathing is available on the outside of the building cold water only.
- Exhibitors, Handlers, Judges and Volunteers are expected to participate with honesty, fairness and integrity, ever mindful of the practice of "good sportsmanship", before, during, and after the EKC show. Any person engaging in an activity that might be considered malicious, threatening or constitutes bullying, will be asked to leave the show.

All exhibitors will be held responsible for CLEAN-UP in the show rings, on the show grounds and surrounding areas, for their dogs or dogs they are handling. Additionally, CLEAN-UP after your dog(s) at your motel or campground.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	0	1	2	3	4	5
*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS						

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at any single show.
