Additional information:

Many present day dog owners are getting into specific dog sports than depend on healthy, structurally sound working animals that have been bred to do the functions required of them, therefore we have asked Chris to do something different than she has in previous seminars in this area.

Aspects of this seminar will address:

- what breeders should be aiming for in their breeding programmes
- what puppy buyers should be looking for when selecting a puppy for a particular function in order to avoid potential injuries and disappointments

Chris' seminars are highly interactive and provide ample opportunity for participation by attendees and dogs. She will alternate between lecture time and activities in which participants can work with their dogs.

High quality visual aids are used including PowerPoint presentations and videos. There will be abundant opportunity for participants to ask questions and discussions will be tailored to items of most interest to the participants. Handouts including notes on some of the subjects covered and recent publications on the canine athlete will be provided. A selection of Chris' books and videos will be available for sale at the seminar.

Please note that everyone who registers will be asked to complete an online survey specific to this seminar that will go directly to Chris and allow them to request the specific topics they most want covered.

New! Chris now uses "audience response technology" with her seminars. Students respond to her questions using individual electronic keypads that send their responses via radio frequency to her computer, where the answers are presented on the screen. This gives everyone the chance to respond without having to raise their hands and enables Chris to discuss difficult concepts in more detail.
