Canadian Association of Rally Obedience

This is a titling event under CARO rules and regulations. CARO is open to all dogs being at least six (6) months of age, including purebred and mixed breeds and dogs with physical challenges, except bitches in season or dogs with injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.

Dogs must have a current CARO registration number (which may be applied for when you submit your entry) and be handled by their owner or a member of the owner's immediate family. Handlers may submit a completed Individual Dog Application form and a cheque payable to CARO to the Trail Secretary with their entry. Current cost: \$25 + HST for CARO Members \$35 + HST non-members.

Competitors, through the submission of their entries, acknowledge that they know the CARO Rules and Regulations. For complete up-to-date CARO rules go to: http://www.canadianrallyo.ca/FilesPDF/Master%20Handbook%20Feb%202013.pdf

An officiating Judge, and/or the Chairperson of the trial, may dismiss from the trial site any person subjecting the Judge or members or the organizing committee to abuse, whether that person is competing in the trial or not.

Physically challenged handlers and dogs are encouraged to participate. Modifications of the course for both handler and dog are permitted, at the judge's discretion. If the handler has any concerns regarding the judge's decision, or wishes to challenge it, the handler should be prepared to present a "letter" from a veterinarian stating that the dog is fit to compete. The judge will then consider this in the final decision. As all injuries are not always obvious or consistent, the judge shall have the final discretion at the day of the trial. All requests for modifications to a course must accompany the Entry Form for the trial. The request should be in writing and should explain the handicap and the modification(s) requested.

Dogs must be shown on a flat buckle or snap collar or fixed harness. No choke, martingale, prong or shock collars, head halters or moving harnesses such as no-pull harnesses are allowed. Leashes should be made of fabric or leather and be long enough to provide adequate slack. Dogs at the advanced, excellent or versatility level are not required to compete with a collar. All dogs in all classes must enter and exit on leash.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Muskoka District Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liabilities in the event of an accident or other mishap, however caused, to either dog or exhibitor. A dog shall not be touched without the permission of the owner or agent.
- 2. Only dogs entered in Trials will be permitted in the Trial Building.
- 3. Trial start times will be indicated on the judging schedule.
- 4. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless or the reason for such dismissal. However, refunds will be issued for dogs that come into heat or are injured, provided a veterinarian's certificate is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial.
- 5. Handlers are required to pick up after their dogs.
- 6. Dogs must be on leash or crated when not in the ring.
