Pre-entries close end of day May 15th at 8pm Atlantic Time, or when Test(s) fill.

Post entries will be accepted if space is available.

The ECSA reserves a small number of entry spots for club members working the Tests

All accepted entries will receive email confirmation.

If the Tests fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added.

A running order will be emailed 1-2 days prior to the Test(s).

Lure coursing equipment will be battery powered continuous loop machine or drag lure.

Schedule for Each Day

First Sprinter Test:

8:00am – Post entries close

8:00am – Roll call inspection

8:30am – Handlers' meeting

8:45am – First dog on the line

There will be a 30 minute break between the first event ending, and the next roll call beginning.

Second Sprinter Test:

Will begin 30 minutes after the end of the first Sprinter Test.

Note: Every Test is its own event; therefore, dogs must be inspected every time.

Directions to Tests

PLEASE BE CAUTIOUS WITH GPS & GOOGLE MAPS. REFER TO THESE DIRECTIONS TO CONFIRM YOU ARE NOT BEING TAKEN THROUGH THE WOODS.

From NB & YONDER:

- Take Trans Canada highway 104. PLEASE NOTE TOLL HIGHWAY (\$4 for cars). Take exit 15 for highway 102 at Truro. Take exit 12 at Brookfield. Follow ramp to the right. Proceed straight at lights. Turn right onto Cloverdale Road. In 500m, turn left onto South Branch Road. At stop sign, turn left onto Ridge Road. Trial is on the right, turn in between barn and house.

FROM HALIFAX:

- Take highway 102. Take exit 12 at Brookfield. Follow ramp to the right. Proceed straight at lights. Turn right onto Cloverdale Road. In 500m, turn left onto South Branch Road. At stop sign, turn left onto Ridge Road. Trial is on the right, turn in between barn and house.

Important Additional Information

- The Tests will be run on a large field, away from paved roads.
- Neither the field nor Test track will be fenced, but there will be a rope-lined "chute" to guide the dogs as well as a catch basin lined in snow fencing at the end of the chute/track.
- This is a PRIVATE residence and we are grateful for the use of this location. Parking, potty, and exercise areas will all be designated. Please respect instructions, pick up after your dog, and always maintain control of your dog.
- Please bring everything you will need to keep your dog safe and comfortable for the weather, crating in vehicles is recommended if you can safely do so. Retractable leads are not allowed on the field.
- There will be no lunch provided, please bring your own food, snacks, and water.
- There is a risk of injury for all active sports; you can reduce this risk by ensuring your dog is in athletic condition, only running your dog when you feel the field and weather are appropriate, and staying aware of your environment and any safety hazards.
- Any dog off leash (unless an accidental escape) when it is not their turn to run will be excused for the day. A \$10 fine, payable to ECSA, will be levied for any dog accidentally loose on the field from the time of inspection until the completion of all Tests for the day.
- A \$10 fine, payable to ECSA, will be levied for any exhibitor not picking up after their dog.

- Events run rain or shine.
- Lure coursing style slip leads are recommended for releasing dogs. However, dogs may wear a plain, snug fitting "catch" collar as long as tags are removed or secured. Dogs may also wear muzzles.
- **Having someone catch/leash your dog at the end of the run helps the tests run smoothly. Please bring a volunteer, if possible, or make an agreement with another handler as soon as you arrive. Catchers and releasers must be lined up and ready to go when it is their turn.**
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds or pay online via DogShow.ca.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee: The CKC has a tracking fee for non-members. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. CKC Regulation: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Eligibility: Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age that are: (a) Individually registered with the CKC; or (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN), (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN), (d) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN), (e) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed, or (f) Have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN).

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the Test.

Border Crossing: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada, and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada.

Earning Points and Titles

The dog's time to complete the 100 meter dash is converted into KPHs. A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

(a) 18" or greater = handicap is 1.25.

(b) 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5.

(c) Below 12" = handicap is 2.0.

Points = KPH multiplied by the dog's handicap. For example $20 \text{ KPH} \times 1.5 = 30$ points. Points are rounded to the nearest whole number. Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded:

Novice Sprinter (NS) = 150 points;

Sprinter (S) = 500 points;

Advanced Sprinter (AS) = 1,000 points;

Sprinter Excellent (SX) = 1,500 points; and SX followed by a number (e.g. SX2) for every additional 500 points. These suffix titles will appear on a dog's pedigree, with a higher level title superseding a lower level title.

Awards and Prizes: Qualifiers will receive flat ribbons. Rosettes will be awarded to dogs achieving a title during the Test(s). For each height class (plus sighthounds >18") of each Test, flat ribbons will be awarded to the 1st-4th place qualifiers and Fastest Veteran qualifier. For each Test, one "Starter's Choice" flat ribbon will be awarded to one qualifier at the discretion of the Starter/Test Committee.
