LISTING FEE (per dog, per trial) \$8.85 A listing fee is required for each dog that does not possess and individual CKC registration number, or if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number (ERN), a Performance Number (PEN) or a miscellaneous Class Certification Number (if designated as a Listed or Miscellaneous Breed with the Canadian Kennel Club). The fee is in addition to each entry for each trial

EXHIBITION ONLY: per dog/per trial \$10 (this is a non-competitive class which allows a dog to be present on the trial grounds)

PAYMENT OF FEES

Entries may be paid by personal cheque, bank draft or money order (payable to the Prince George Kennel Club). OVERPAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES WILL BE CONSIDERED A DONATION TO THE TROPHY FUND. *Please do not send cash in the mail!!!*

All funds must be made payable to "Prince George Kennel Club." <u>Tendering of NSF cheques is</u>

considered non-payment of entries and is punishable by CKC disciplinary action. <u>The Trial</u> <u>Secretary will not accept any entry from an exhibitor known to have tendered dishonored</u> <u>cheques.</u> Telephone entries are prohibited.

*Day of Entry will be accepted if space allows. Please note that Obedience trials are Limited so enter early to avoid disappointment. Please contact the Show Secretary after August 9,2014 to find out if there is space available. Please note for Day of Entry: 1) Entry form must be fully filled out and submitted to the Show Secretary 1 hour prior to the beginning of the trial. 2) Entry fee must be paid in cash (no cheques).

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. "When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial." (6.5.2 Obedience Rules) The club will then refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

<u>ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS</u> - Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds.

If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "At Par". The Banks will not clear them. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase Bank Drafts or Money Orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and co-operation are appreciated.

BORDER CROSSING - A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Every dog entered in an approved obedience trial must be one of the following:

- (a) Registered with the CKC
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number
- (d) Eligible for registration with the CKC
- (e) Have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number if designated as a miscellaneous class breed

And:

- (a) Must be at least 6 months of age
- (b) May be spayed, neutered, or debarked
- (c) May not be lame (it is the judge's responsibility to determine whether a dog is lame)
- (d) May not compete if it has tape or bandages that may impair its working ability (such a dog must be immediately excused and under no circumstances may it be returned later for judging after the tape or bandages have been removed).
- (e) Entries in each class may be arranged according to the size of the dog.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED

OBEDIENCE CLASSES: REGULAR

Refer to Section 9 of the O.T.R.&R. The rules are paraphrased below. <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> The word 'trainer' means any person who conducts or has conducted a dog obedience training class or who regularly assists with the training of dogs in the class or who regularly trains dogs belonging to any person outside his/her immediate family.

The following REGULAR classes, are offered at these trials:

NOVICE A CLASS-

shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have not earned the title of CD in Canada or any other country. A dog shall not be entered in a Novice class once it has been exhibited in an Open class. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. No professional handler or trainer, or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

NOVICE B CLASS

shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have not earned the title of CD in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog that has earned the title of C.D., or a comparable title in any other country, but has not earned its title of C.D. in Canada, may only be entered in the Novice B Class.

OPEN A CLASS

shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have earned the title of CD in Canada but have not earned the title of C.D.X. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families and must be eligible to handle under S.10.1 .3. No professional handler or trainer, or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D.title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

OPEN B CLASS

shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which shall have earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B classes at any one trial.

UTILITY CLASS A

Shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which shall have earned the title of CDX in Canada. Dogs in this class must be handled or exhibited by the owner or immediate family member. However, the same person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person that has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may NOT handle in this class

UTILITY CLASS B-

Shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which shall have earned the title of CDX in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. However, the same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES: Transition

Refer to Section 13 of the O.T.R.&R. The rules are paraphrased below: The following transition classes, are offered at these Trials:

PRE-NOVICE CLASS

shall be for dogs of any recognized or listed breed and of either sex which have not earned the title of P.C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may be entered in Pre-Novice that has of earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice classes.

NOVICE C CLASS

Open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title C.D, C.D.X., U.D. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class. Exhibitors may compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs may be in N.I. (if offered) and this class and/or any of the Official or Unofficial Classes.

EXHIBITION ONLY is an official class.

No dog so entered can compete in any Regular class, however it may be entered in and compete in any Unofficial class or Parade if offered. A listing fee is not required for a listed dog entered in Exhibition Only (not entered for any competition).

OBEDIENCE CLASSES: Unofficial

Refer to Section 15 of the O.T.R.&R. The rules are paraphrased below. The following classes are offered at these Trials:

VETERAN'S CLASS

Is open to dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years and older. Dogs entered in this class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

MOVING UP IN OBEDIENCE – as per 6.8 of the Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations 6.8.2 When one or more trial s are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

6.8.1 A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, an ERN or a Miscellaneous Class Certification Number and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the provisions of the CKC rules, may be moved up to the next level of the competition. The transfer must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler one hour before the opening of the first trial of that day, schedule permitting.

The move-up dog must be individually registered in the CKC or has a PEN, an ERN or a Miscellaneous Class Certification Number before entries close. CKC numbers added after the close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will be referred to the Discipline Committee.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog)

For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of obtaining scores or awards to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (presently \$58.30 Canadian Funds) along with a letter of request to the CKC (this ERN number replaces a CKC individual Registration Number for entering CKC events ONLY).

GENERAL INFORMATION & RULES GOVERNING THESE TRIALS

- ✤ All dogs must be exercised in the designated areas provided for that purpose, not in the vicinity of the Obedience Ring/s. PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG.
- The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that you will exercise control and restraint over children on the days of the trials.
- The Club and Trial Committee reserve the right to refuse an individual's entries, for just cause.
- The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the Trial. The Trial Superintendent shall have full control of these Trials which will be governed by CKC Rules
- The Club and Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- The owner of a dog entered in these Trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom entry was made.
- All recreational units will have buckets underneath for their drains. Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed.
- If because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the Trials, there will be no refund or entry.
- * Bitches in season are not permitted entry in a CKC Obedience Trial

ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

19.7 Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue."
