COVID -19 PROTOCOLS AND PROCEDURES

Protocols regarding the management of the COVID-19 Pandemic will be sent out to all entered exhibitors before the show in order to ensure we have the most up-to-date information available for everyone. All exhibitors will be expected to adhere to the protocols put in place by the Lakes District Kennel Club, without exception. Anyone not adhering to the protocols will be directed to leave the show grounds immediately, and there will be no refund of entry fees or camping fees.

Covid Protocols for Photos-Now Dog Show Photography

Judge, flowers and sign, dog then handler. This setup would have at least 6 or more feet from judge to handler. Mask protocols would follow what is set for the show. The photographer is at least 15 feet from those getting their photos taken. He will follow show mask protocols as well. We would also take photos for each judge as they arrive for the day so they can be inserted into a photo taken without a judge.

Viewing photos:

The viewing stations will be setup in the tent as always - only one exhibitor or those in their bubble will be allowed in the tent at once. Then viewing stations wiped down before another can access. We will setup for photos as far from the rings and general show area to respect social distancing.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12 to 15 MONTHS – This class shall be for any dog 12 months of age and under 15 months of age on the day of the show.

15 to 18 MONTHS – This class shall be for any dog 15 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co- owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs divided by colour: Black, Chocolate, Yellow.

VETERAN CLASS - This class is for dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of the show. Class will be divided 7 Yrs to under 9 Yrs, 9 Yrs to under 12 Yrs, 12+ Yrs. The winners of each class in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

FIELD DOG CLASS – Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging and the winners in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog may be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary **ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED**. Listing Fees **WILL NOT** be refunded

UNOFFICIAL CLASS

GUN DOG - Gun Dog – This class is for dogs that have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. Dogs entered in this class need not have been entered in the regular Field Dog Class; dogs entered in any regular conformation class, or For Exhibition Only, are eligible.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades **ONLY**

STUD DOG - This class shall be comprised of the stud dog and two or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a regular class.

BROOD BITCH - This class shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog and Get. The brood bitch may be spayed.

BRACE - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily the same sex). A Brace must be handled by one person on one lead.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age, which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class will be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed divided by sex.

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed.

SWEEPSTAKES – Thursday, July 22, 2021 Preceding Regular Conformation Classes

Juvenile Sweepstakes

Judge: Colleen Doll

Juvenile Sweepstakes is open to all Labrador Retriever puppies six months and under eighteen months of age regardless of place of birth. All dogs must be entered in one of the regular official classes on the same day. Dogs will be judged in one of the following eight classes (divided by sex):

- 6 months and under 9 months
- 9 months and under 12 months
- 12 months and under 15 months
- 15 months and under 18 months

For final judging the first place puppy from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes,

Best in Sweepstakes - rosette & 25% of total fees collected for the Juvenile Sweepstakes

Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes - rosette & 15% of total fees collected for the Juvenile Sweepstakes

First place winners in each class will divide the remaining 35% of the total fees collected for Juvenile Sweepstakes

25% of fees collected will be retained by the club to defray costs

Veteran Sweepstakes

Judge: Colleen Doll

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Labrador Retriever dogs 7 years of age and over and entered in a regular class or for exhibition only on the same day. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete provided they are also entered in exhibition only.

Dogs to be judged in one of the following six classes (divided by sex):

- 7 years and under 9 years
- 9 years and under 12 years
- 12 years and over

For final judging the first place winner from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes

Best in Sweepstakes - rosette & 25% of total fees collected for the Veteran Sweepstakes

Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes - rosette & 15% of total fees collected for the Veteran Sweepstakes

First place winners in each class will divide the remaining 35% of the total fees collected for Veteran Sweepstakes

25% of fees collected will be retained by the club to defray costs

Note: There will be a Best Canadian Bred Puppy and a Best Puppy. The Best Puppy placement will be the official one, and the ribbon will be the official light blue. The Best Canadian Bred Puppy will be the unofficial colours, as CKC does not allow us to have both as official awards.

The person handling the dog in the ring shall be recognized as the Agent for the owner of the dog. Delivery in the ring of any prizes won shall constitute full delivery of the prize to the rightful owner. No prizes will be mailed.

OVERNIGHT RV PARKING BY RESERVATION

Exhibitors may enter the show grounds starting at **1:00 pm on Wednesday, July 21, 2021.**
All exhibitors must be cleaned up and off the fairgrounds no later than **8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 27, 2021**



CAMPING AT THE SHOW SITE

NO HOOK UPS and no showers on site.

Washroom facilities available on site.

Showers available at the Tom Forsythe Arena in Burns Lake (\$4.00/shower with exhibitor card)

Ringside Camping Sites (20'x50' max) - \$35/night (will be numbered & assigned before the gates open)

- We have a limited number of ringside camping sites. They will be available on a first booked/paid basis.
- All bookings for ringside spots must be for a minimum of 4 nights (Thursday through Sunday, July 22 to July 25) but can be extended to include Wednesday and Monday nights.
- Access to the ringside camping sites may not be available when the Labrador Specialty is in progress on Thursday, July 22nd – if you arrive during this time, you may be held in a general holding area until the rings are finished for the day or there is a reasonable break that will allow you time to park.

General Camping Sites (20 x 50') - \$20/night (first come, first serve): Campers will be parked as you arrive so if you want to camp together it is best to arrive together otherwise we can't guarantee our ability to hold a space next to you for your friend

Day Tenting - \$10/day (sites will be approximately 20'x20' and your vehicle may be parked at your site within the boundaries) *in designated area only; pop up and any other equipment/items may be left overnight at exhibitor's risk*

Day vehicle parking will be available at no charge, in designated area only.

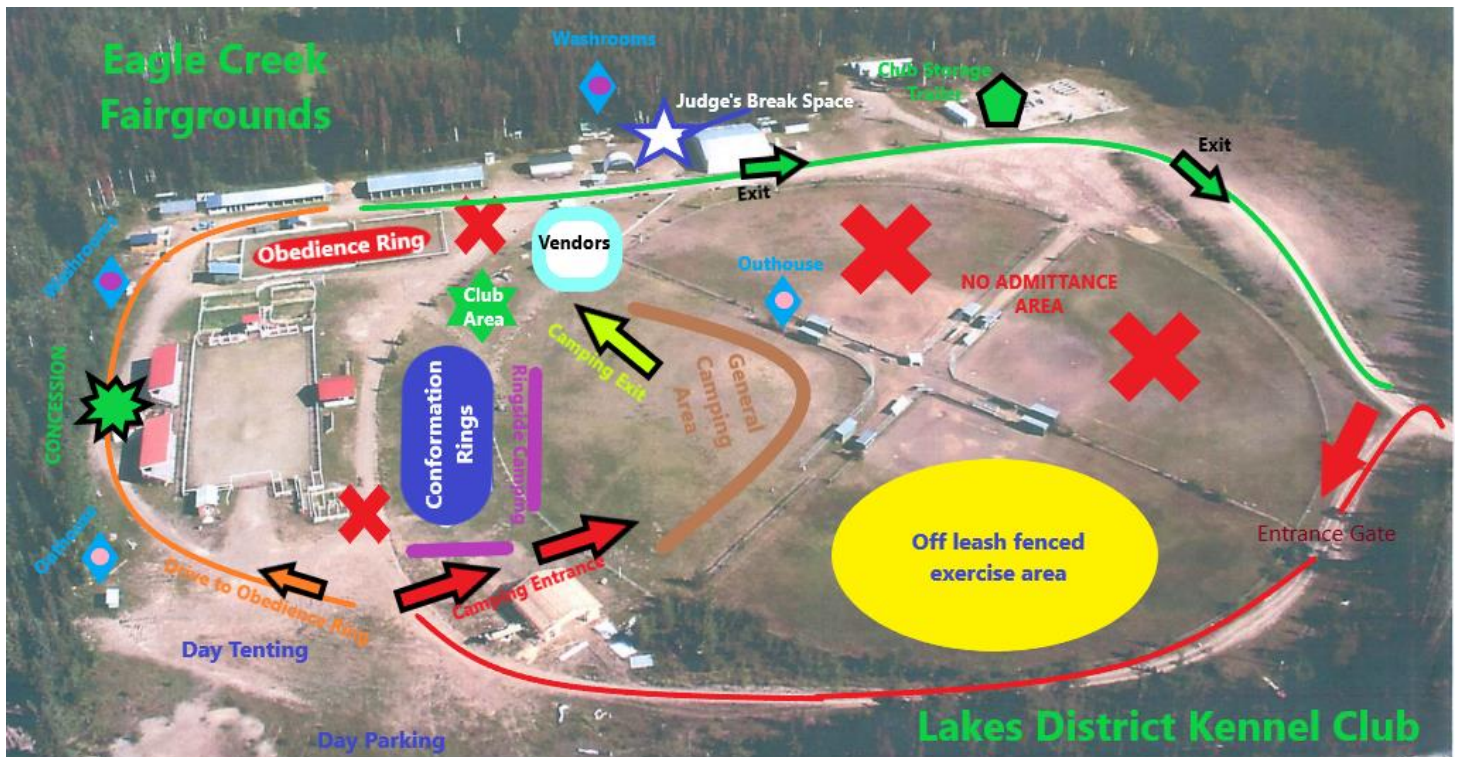
All reservations for overnight camping and day tenting will be made directly with the Show Chair (Candice Little) by email at tlakelabs@gmail.com. These reservations will be accepted in the order they are received. Payment in full (via etransfer) will be required once successful entry to the show is confirmed. Failure to pay within 48 hours of entries being confirmed or the show closing will result in your reservation being cancelled, and the next person in line offered your spot. Camping overnight on Monday, July 26th (at the end of the weekend) is free of charge, but all campers must be checked out no later than 8:00 a.m. Tues., July 27th.

THERE IS NO POWER AVAILABLE ON SITE FOR CAMPERS

The LDKC will attempt to arrange for septic service on site once over the weekend but please don't count on this. There is a sani-dump in Burns Lake if needed.

Quiet time is 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. – generators may not be operated during these hours

NOTE: All overnight campers will be expected to provide a \$50 deposit when they enter the grounds and, provided you have left your site in good shape, we will return your \$50 as you check out and leave the grounds. This can be in the form of cash or a cheque made out to the Lakes District Kennel Club.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.

3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
6. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are **PACIFIC DAYLIGHT TIME.**
7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

ADDITIONAL CLUB RULES

- Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Violators will be asked to leave the show grounds.
- Crates will be allowed at ringside during the judging of your specific breed only and must be removed immediately after. No Exceptions.
- Dogs are not allowed in washrooms and must be on leash at all times on the showgrounds with the exception of the obedience rings and the off-leash exercise area.
- The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that you will exercise control and restraint over the children in your care on the days of these shows.
- The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property from exhibitors or vendors/concessions.
- The Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.
- Dogs must be exercised in the designated areas only, and cooperation with other exhibitors exercising their dogs is an expectation.
- COVID-19 protocols are subject to change up to and during the show, as dictated by the Province of British Columbia. Exhibitors will be informed prior to the show, and as they enter the gates, of the current protocols that will be in place. Anyone who is not following these protocols will be directed to leave the show grounds and will not be refunded their entry or camping fees. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

Grand Champion (GCh) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level

The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 +
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship title.
