ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- 3. Telephone/fax/online entries are accepted by www.dogshow.ca.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 5. Alterations, substitution, or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dog to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
- 6. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book or are eligible for registration can be entered.
- 7. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 8. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE TUESDAY May 24th, 2022 at 8:00 pm or when the entry limit is reached, whichever occurs first.
- 9. Armband numbers and judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented to the Trial Secretary upon arrival at the trial.
- 10. Tendering an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to the current fees charged by LOC's financial institution.

ORDER OF CLASSES

On Saturday June 4 judging will start with Veterans Sweepstakes and then Juvenile Sweepstakes. This will be followed by the Official Classes, Baby Puppy, Sexually Altered, Non-Regular Classes and then Unofficial Classes.

On Sunday June 5 judging will start with Veterans Sweepstake and then Juvenile Sweepstakes. This will be followed by the Official Classes and then Baby Puppy. There are no Non-regular, Unofficial Classes or Sexually Altered Classes on Sunday.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes is open to all Labrador Retrievers 6 months and under 18 months on the day of the Sweepstakes. Dogs and bitches must also be entered in one of the regular official classes at this specialty. The following classes, divided by sex, will be provided:

Junior Puppy - 6 months and under 9 months

Senior Puppy - 9 months and under 12 months

Open - 12 months and under 18 months

All class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Money received as entry fees will be divided as follows:

1st in each class will divide 30% of the class prize money.

2nd in each class will divide 25% of the class prize money.

3rd in each class will divide 15% of the class prize money.

4th in each class will divide 5% of the class prize money.

Best in Sweepstakes will receive 10% plus a prize.

Best Opposite Sex will receive 5% plus a prize.

Rosettes will be offered for the above placings.

10% will be held for administration costs.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Labrador Retrievers dogs and bitches, including spayed or neutered dogs at least 7 years of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. They must be entered in one of the official classes, Specials Only or Exhibition Only at this specialty. The following classes, divided by sex, will be provided:

7 years to and including 9 years

10 years and over

All class winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes. Money received as entry fees will be divided as follows:

1st in each class will divide 30% of the class prize money.

2nd in each class will divide 25% of the class prize money.

3rd in each class will divide 15% of the class prize money.

4th in each class will divide 5% of the class prize money.

Best in Veteran Sweepstakes will receive 10% plus a prize.

Best Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweeps will receive 5% plus a prize.

Rosettes will be offered for the above placings.

10% will be held for administration costs.

An Award of Merit will be offered for every 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed. These are awarded at the discretion of the judge.

Best Altered Dog, Best Altered Bitch & Best Altered in Breed (Saturday Only).

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15 Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	Points Allocated
1	0
2	1
3 to 5	2
6 to 9	3
10 to 12	4
13 or more	5

^{*}Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges and,
- (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

CLASSES OFFERED

OFFICIAL CLASSES:

The following C.K.C. classes (divided by sex) will be provided at these Specialty Shows: JUNIOR PUPPY - for puppies 6 months and under 9 months of age on day of specialty. SENIOR PUPPY - for puppies 9 months and under 12 months of age on day of specialty. 12–18 MONTHS - for dogs at least 12 months and under 18 months of age on day of specialty.

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, champions in any country excluded. BRED BY EXHIBITOR - for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. Entry may be made by any person who is the owner/co-owner or breeder/co-breeder of the dog. That person must handle the dog in this class but need not handle the dog for a higher award. OPEN CLASS - for all dogs and bitches, divided by colour (yellow, black, or chocolate). Please Note colour on entry form for each dog entered.

VETERANS CLASS - for all dogs and bitches 7 years of age and over on the date of the specialty. These dogs and bitches to compete for the regular placements, and the 1st place dog and bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Spayed/neutered dogs may compete in Veterans.

FIELD CLASS - This class is offered at Specialty shows for breeds that have performance events in the field. Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging with winners of each sex competing for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered. SPECIALS ONLY - for all dogs and bitches recognized as champions in the records of the C.K.C. Listed dogs cannot be entered into the Specials class.

BABY PUPPY CLASSES OFFERED ON SATURDAY AND SUNDAY

BABY PUPPY - for puppies 4 months and under 6 months of age on day of specialty.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES OFFERED ON SATURDAY ONLY

Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure.

Altered Male Class – All sexually altered males, regardless of age will be judged together. Altered Female Class – All sexually altered females, regardless of age will be judged together. Winner of each of these two divisions competes for Best Altered in Breed.

NON- REGULAR CLASSES OFFERED ON SATURDAY ONLY

EXHIBITION ONLY - Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered in Exhibition Only. Dogs and bitches entered for Exhibition Only, may only compete in the non-regular and unofficial classes. Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. Please Note: All dogs and bitches entered in the following non-regular and unofficial classes MUST be entered in one of the regular classes or Exhibition Only.

STUD DOG - Shall be for a dog and 2 of his get. The Get must also be entered in one of the official C.K.C. classes or for Specials Only. The 3 dogs comprising the entry need not be owned by the same owner.

BROOD BITCH - Shall be for a bitch and 2 of her progenies. The Progeny must also be entered in one of the official C.K.C. classes or for Specials Only. The 3 dogs comprising the entry need not be owned by the same owner.

BRACE - Shall be for 2 dogs of either sex or same sex. Both dogs must be entered in one of the official C.K.C. classes or for Specials Only. A brace shall be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait and stride, handled on one lead by one handler.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES OFFERED ON SATURDAY ONLY

OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASS – For dogs and bitches who have earned at least a C.D. degree. 3 GENERATION CLASS - Three consecutive generations, either dog or bitch.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Labrador Owners Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. A dog shall not be touched without permission of the owner or agent.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- 4. The show precincts shall consist of all judging areas set aside for show officials, judges, exhibitors, and handlers and thirty (30) feet outside of the rings
- 5. It shall be the duty and obligation of the Labrador Owners Club to see that judges, club officials. volunteers or any participant at an event held under these rules are not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

- 1. A non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- 2. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- 3. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- 4. All Premium Lists will carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and are not applicable to CKC members.
