	3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
	4. Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials or unfinished Specials back to the classes is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. 	The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.
	a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
	b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
GCHEX and Grand Champion Excellent Points	The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. Section 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:
	a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
	 b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins. c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.
	Section 15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.
Altered Champion and Altered Points	Section 13.8.1 Championship points will be awarded as per Chapter 15, with the exception of 15.1.11. The winner of an Altered Best in Show shall be awarded points according to the total number of dogs in competition following the point schedule in Section 15.1.2.
	Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion [Alt] and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

Conformation Show Rules and Regulations	The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Section 4.7.1 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
Moving Class Dog to Specials Only	Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler. <i>A dog that has a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) is not eligible to be transferred from one (1) of the regular classes to Specials Only.</i>
	When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.
Moving from Specials Back to the Classes	Section 8.10.5 A dog can be moved back into the classes from a Special if it has been entered incorrectly, only where the shows have already closed.

HEALTH REMINDERS



No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the even on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

SHOW ETIQUETTE

Exhibitors, handlers, judges and assistants are expected to participate with honesty, fairness and integrity, ever mindful of the practice of "good sportsmanship," before, during and after this show.

- Any person engaging in an activity that might be considered malicious, threatening
 or constitutes bullying, including but not limited to social media, will be asked to
 leave this show without compensation and will be banned from any future shows
 held by this club.
- Any exhibitor who allows his/her dog to defecate or urinate inside or outside the building other than in the designated Exercise Area without immediately cleaning up or arranging for a cleanup may not be permitted to exhibit at future shows or trials held by this club. Please co-operate in keeping the show site clean.
- PLEASE ABIDE BY THE NO SMOKING RULES OF THE COMPLEX. Absolutely no smoking or vaping inside the building or within 30 feet of an entrance/exit.

STATEMENT ON BULLYING

ZERO TOLERANCE

Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Caledon Kennel Association shows will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with the CKC and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit.

DEFINITION OF BULLYING

Refers to a range of behaviours in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, Isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group.

Examples include:

- insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits
- spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo
- berating/belittling an Individual
- unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others
- giving insulting nicknames
- engaging In practical jokes that humiliate
- undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work
- physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates
- mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms
- yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles


