<u>How to Enter</u> - Entries must be made ONLINE through <u>www.dogshow.ca</u>. NO EMAIL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES AND E-TRANSFERS SENT DIRECTLY TO THE SECRETARY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Refunds will be given for bitches in season. Veterinary certificate must be submitted by April 4 2025 5pm.

Move Ups will be allowed if the schedule permits and must be sent to the Secretary by e-mail NO LATER THAN MONDAY MARCH 31 8:00 p.m.

NO RESETS multiple dogs owned by the same person in the same class must have a separate handler.

WARM UP: A warm up area will be provided. Exhibitors are not permitted to be in possession of any of the target odors when on the trial grounds (this includes the building and the parking lot).

PRIZES AND RIBBONS: Flat ribbons will be given to successful entrants. Title ribbons are available.

To make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

1. No Crating indoors. Please crate in your car

2. No outdoor shoes allowed on the rubber flooring. Please bring a clean, dry pair of indoor shoes to trial in.

3. PLEASE drive slowly down the long laneway. Do not let your dogs out in the front of the property or anywhere near the house as this is a private residence!

4. DOG airing area is under the pine trees on the east side of the driveway.

5. DO NOT WALK IN THE BACK FIELD PAST THE POND

6. Park only in the EAST/MAIN parking lot area. Please respect boundaries and roped off areas.

7. Dogs must always be on leash unless directed by the judge at the time of a search.

8. PLEASE RESPECT: Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive. There is NO nose-to-nose contact at this event.

- 9. Please pick up your dog's waste, there are waste containers provided.
- 10. No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- 11. Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.

Awards

Qualifying flat ribbons will be awarded for each element and New Title Rosettes will be offered for completion of a new title. Ribbons will be awarded at the end of each class.

<u>CKC Rules</u>: All Participants are expected to read the CKC Scent Detection Rule Book prior to the day of the trial. The rule book can be found online at the CKC web site.

<u>Unsportsmanlike Conduct</u> 4.1.5: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

<u>Collars, Leashes & Harnesses</u>: 9.4.1: "Dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. The harness will be constructed of plain, pliable material and will be designed so that there is minimal restriction of the dog's movement. No special training tools, such as electronic collars, prong collars, head halters, choke chains, or no-pull harnesses may be used during the search. Martingale collars are permitted. No odor emitting collars (such as no-bark collars that spray citronella, or DAP calming collars) may be worn or present in the search area"
