NOTICE LIMITED ENTRIES

Entry in the obedience trials will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging. Total time allotted for judging at this sanction match will be 6 hours. Once a judge has reached their capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. There will be no waitlist maintained for this sanction match.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

All fees include HST and are in Canadian funds. A TCN fee is payable for all dogs entered at trials who do not have an individual CKC registration number, an ERN, a CCN, or a PEN. A TCN number must be obtained for these dogs. This can be done online at www.ckc.ca.

No entries will be accepted on the day of the trial.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full, including waiver form.

2 Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. A confirmation e-mail will be sent to notify exhibitor that their entry has been accepted and completed.

3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made

4. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, with the exception of pulling of bitches in season as stated in this premium list.

5. Only dogs that are registered with the Canadian Kennel Club or are eligible to be registered can be entered.

6. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.

7. Entries close on Saturday, June 24, 2023 at 9pm or when the entry limit is reached, whichever occurs first.

8. Judging schedules and will be sent as soon as possible after entries close, and no later than seven (7) days prior to the start of the trial. Armbands will be provided upon arrival at the trial.

9. Indoor crating area will be provided for exhibitors, but space is limited - please do not bring dogs that are not entered in the trial.

10. Washroom facilities are provided on site.

11. Trial is located on upper floor with elevator and stairwell access. Signs will be posted at entrance.

12.If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management; it is impossible to open or to complete the show no refund of entry fee will be made.

AWARDS

Flat ribbons signifying a passing score will be awarded where applicable; High in Class and High in Match rosettes will be available.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Section 20.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: it shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it seems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

In consideration of acceptance of the entry and the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons or prizes at the events held on the date(s) above, I agree:

1. To hold the Host Club including its members, directors, officers, employees and volunteers (collectively referred to as "the Host Club"), as well as the owner and lessor of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.

2. To hold the Host Club harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the Host Club or any other person(s);

3. To assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the Host Club harmless from any and all loss and expense, including legal fees, by reason of the liabilities imposed by law upon the Host Club for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person(s), including myself, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in the event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Host Club or any other person(s);
