Classifications

For Judging The Dogs Will Be Divided Into The Following Classes:

Junior Puppy Male – 6 To 9 Months

Senior Puppy Male - 9 To 12 Months

Junior Puppy Female – 6 To 9 Months

Senior Puppy Female – 9 To 12 Months

All first place winners will compete together for the award of Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-Up in Sweeps

PRIZES: Rosettes will be awarded to First in each class and Best in Sweepstakes. Flat ribbons will be awarded to 2nd, 3rd & 4th in each class. Class winners will receive 10% of total fees collected. Best in Sweepstakes will receive 25% of the total fees collected, Runner-Up will receive 10% of the total fees collected.

Balance of 25% will be retained by the club to defray costs.

Junior handling is open to all persons from ages 4 up to 18 years of age on the date of competition. All Dogs must also be entered in the regular classes at the all-breed show, but need not be owned by the junior.

A rosette and suitable prize will be awarded to the winners of First in each class, flat ribbons will be given to 2nd through 4th in each class. PeeWee handlers will receive a Participant ribbon and prize. A rosette and prize will be offered for Best Overall.

Junior Handling Number

Please note that effective January 1, 2016, in accordance with Section 3.4.1 of the Junior Handling Rules & Regulations, Junior Handlers will be required to apply to CKC Head Office for a Junior Handling Number.

Section 3.4.1 "Junior Handler with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

The Application For Junior Handler Number is posted on the CKC website under the Events tab, and then Under Event Forms, Exhibitor, or Event Supplies, Junior Handling. The application can be mailed, faxed, or e-mailed to CKC Head Office and there is no fee.



GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are PACIFIC TIME.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$107.80 + GST (CKC member) or \$161.60 + GST (non-member) which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13. The Club has a zero tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with these shows, including spectators.

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES Section 8.3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$10.50 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES Section 8.2:

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled.

DISHONORED CHEQUES Section 8.6.2:

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitor who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order, cash or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 – DISQUALIFICATION Section 14.1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

CHAPTER 5 – SHOW OFFICIALS Section 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points Allocated* 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder. Points awarded beyond breed level shall be as follows

(This points system is the same for GCh. point calculation at group level)

A class Dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. <u>To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and be individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a CKC EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN).</u>

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Conformation Championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Conformation Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship. All required points are to be earned at the breed level. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship title.

Conformation Classes

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

Junior Puppy - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

Senior Puppy- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 Month Class - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

Canadian Bred - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder. The handler *MUST* be the owner/co-owner *AND* breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

Open Class - shall be for all Dogs.

Specials Only - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BABY PUPPY- 4 months & under 6 months on the day of the show

VETERANS CLASS - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

Exhibition Only - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class *MAY NOT COMPETE* in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

ADDITIONAL CLUB RULES

N.S.F. cheques for Parking Fees, Entry Fees, Booth Space etc. will bar you from entering any future Nicola Valley Kennel Club shows.

Attention Exhibitors Welcome to the NVKC 2021 Show. After so much time apart lets all abide by the rules set forth and have a very enjoyable show! Attached is a waiver. It must be filled out daily by every person entering the showground. Please take it to the Show Secretary or the Show superintendent. You will be given an armband. Only exhibitors with an armband on will be allowed on the showgrounds. Please do not wait until just before ring time to do this...get it to us first thing in the morning please. It not only meets the club's requirement to have information to contact trace but allows you access. You must show it to the ring steward before you will have entry into the show ring. If you exhibit any of these symptoms you must complete the covid-19 self assessment tool online to determine if you should be tested. You must not attend this show. The washrooms and showers will be open and used at your own risk. They will be cleaned daily. There will be hand sanitizer at the show secretary desk and at the ring steward desks. Otherwise, you must keep hand sanitizer with you. Masks are mandatory within the confines of the show...which is within the inner track area. We encourage you to wear them whenever you are not in your own setup. There is no hugging, kissing, handshaking within the confines of the show. We also encourage this rule on the grounds. At your own setup you may use your own discretion. Please maintain social distancing at all times when you are not in your own set-up area. You can make your way into the inner circle 10 minutes before your breed judging. Maintain social distance and watch for you turn before moving closer to the judging area. No ex-pens, mats, or tables are allowed at ringside. If you are showing more than one dog in breed you may put a crate at ringside but it must be removed immediately after you are done showing. If you wish to put up a small pop-up tent on the inner circle grass for your own personal shade while you wait this will be allowed this year- note though this is only for shade not grooming. If you are grooming, we will ask you to remove the tent. Grooming must be done outside the inner track only. We will enter the ring on the show secretary side and leave the opposite side to avoid piling up. Once your breed is done you must leave the area and come back when group judging is called. Violation of any of these rules will result in our entries for the weekend being cancelled with not refund of entry fees. There will be No Exceptions or Excuses Be respectful to one another and to the club volunteers and keep each other safe. Most importantly Have Fun!!!!! It's so good to see you again.


