The Working Certificate Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

Entry forms: On Line entry form must be completed for each dog entered.

Credit cards: Credit card payment is available for entries submitted online or by fax.

Paper Entries: Will not be accepted

Enter Online: At www.dogshow.ca. 5% service charge will be applied.

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the Entry Fee. Telephone or emailed entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal disruption. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Non-Member Participation fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC. It is not applicable to CKC members or dogs owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is paid in the calendar year (January-December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

HEALTH OF DOGS ON THE PREMISES OF EVENTS

As per CKC rules, no dog may be brought onto the grounds of an event if it:

- Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.
- Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

Entry Fee: \$5.00 per dog (please bring fees to event)

Age Range: 7 years or older

Requirements: Dog must have at least 1 CKC or equivalent field title

Test: Each Dog will run 2 single land marks. Ducks will be used

Running order: youngest veteran to oldest veteran

Entry is limited with preference given to oldest veteran

Every dog is a winner and will receive an award! Entry forms will be available the day of the event.



The Shilo Perpetual Trophy

To be awarded at the 2022 Canadian National Specialty

The SHILO Perpetual Trophy is to be awarded to the oldest Toller, aged 7 and older on the day of the Specialty Working Certificate Test that successfully passes a WC or WCI test.

Eligible Tollers must be trained and handled by their owner and must not have earned any field or hunt test title by any other organization that required double marked retrieves.

While owner/handlers may seek training instruction from others, eligible Tollers must not have been trained by anyone other than the owner/handler as this Trophy is mean to reward a senior Toller and his/her companion.

Applicants that are eligible for the SHILO Perpetual Trophy may complete and sign the accompanying form which is to be sent to the trial secretary at dlangley1@cogeco.ca prior to the close of entries.

TEST DETAILS

• Please check-in with Test Secretary upon arrival.

- All dogs must be kept under control at all times on test grounds.
- Refunds will be given for bitches in season or dogs injured and under veterinarian care. Veterinarian certificate must be presented to the test secretary prior to the event.
- Please respect the landowners that have graciously allowed us access to their property. Drive and park only in designated areas and remove all garbage and debris.
- Airing of dogs is only allowed in designated areas (away from tests and upcoming tests) please check with Test Marshall and you MUST pick up after your dog.
- Birds: Ducks will be used on land and water
- Clothing: All handlers and spectators must wear dark or camouflage clothing. Light coloured clothing is not allowed in the vicinity of the tests (except for handlers when running blinds in the WCX).
- Running order: Running order will be determined by random draw after entries close. Wherever possible, handlers with more than one dog will run in non-consecutive order. Running orders will be emailed to entrants when finalized, and available at the test
- Catalogue: Catalogues will be emailed to all entrants running order will be available on site
- Shotguns: Handlers entered in the WCX stake may be required to handle a gun or a replica during the test. Gun safety is considered part of the test.
- Awards: All qualifying dogs will be awarded a rosette and duck band at the end of each test. All qualifying Tollers will be awarded a rosette, duck band and keeper trophy.
- Drinks, food or snacks will not be available at these trials, please come prepared with food and water for yours self and your dogs.

Be prepared: Bring adequate shade, sunscreen, water and cover for hot or wet weather for both you and your dog(s). Carry a first aid kit.

Training: No training is allowed on test grounds within 24 hours of the start of the test. (A bumper thrown by the handler for the purpose of a warm-up shall not be considered training).

E-collars: No electronic collar use on test grounds please. However bark collars while dogs are kenneled are permitted

Assistance: In the unlikely event that exhibitors and/or observers are requested to "chip-in" and assist in the execution of a test – please be willing to help the event run smoothly and efficiently. No previous experience required, just ensure you understand what is being requested!

Refunds: No refunds will be given for scratches or withdrawals received after the closing date, except as stated in the CKC Working Certificate Test Rules & Regulations or referenced herein


