#### RALLY OBEDINECE INFORMATION

Note: there is a new class called Novice Intermediate. It is an OPTIONAL class that uses signs # 1 to 18 and is performed ON LEASH.

- To be eligible to compete in a rally obedience or rally trials, a dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) or CCN number, to be obtained by contacting CKC at www.ckc.ca
- Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
- Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.

Please be aware that there is a new Rally Obedience Rule book effective January 1 2015.

It is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations.

New signs and exercises will be used in these trials. Please update and train according to the new rules.

#### CANINE GOOD NEIGHBOUR INFORMATION

Any dog of any breed may take part in Canine Good Neighbour. The Canine Good Neighbour Program is a 12-step test, that when completed successfully, will ensure that one of our most favored companions, the dog, is accepted as a valued member of our communities right across the country. Canine Good Neighbours can be counted on to present good manners at home, in public places and in the presence of other dogs.

The test is non-competitive and allows dog and handler to demonstrate confidence and control in 12 steps. It assesses the handler and dog's relationship, together with the handler's ability to control the dog. Dogs are evaluated on their ability to perform basic exercises as well as their ability to demonstrate good manners in everyday situations.

The program embraces both purebred and mixed-breed dogs and is fun, rewarding, and useful. It encourages owners to have a better and richer relationship with their dogs. The program also enhances community awareness of responsible dog ownership and the numerous benefits associated with dog ownership.

Please be aware that as the CGN evaluations will be conducted so as not to interfere with the efficient operation of the Rally Obedience trials, all dogs registered for Canine Good Neighbour evaluation will be contacted by email by January 26<sup>th</sup> and advised on the start of the evaluation.

#### **OUR FACILITY -- WATSON'S HOUND LOUNGE**

These trials are being held in a dog daycare facility and so it is important to adhere to the following CKC rule: As per 2011, CKC rule 6.6.1 No dog may be entered in the above events or classes if the dog has distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough, or other communicable diseases or has recovered from and infection within the last 14 days.

6.6.2 All dogs entered in the trial are required to provide current immunization status. Please include a copy of your dog's current immunization record with your entry.

- Crating is provided in the "small dog room" of Watson's Hound Lounge. Please ask for directions to the correct room. Crates may remain on site overnight on Saturday.
- There is no off leash area at this trial site. However, there is an off leash dog park within a 15 minute drive. Ask for directions.
- Watson's Hound Lounge is in an industrial area of Kelowna. Dogs may be walked outside in the parking lot but for safety must remain on leash.
- Dog potty area is at the rear of the building. Please pick up after your dog.

#### Other information - GENERAL, CKC

- 19.6 Any person, either within or outside the judging ring, who does anything calculated to attract, distract or otherwise interfere in any way with the attention, deportment, or performance of a dog under judgment, may be disciplined by the Discipline Committee in whatever way it considers to be in the best interest of the club, or the judge may take summary action.
- 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
- Non Member Participation Fee \$57.60 + HST
- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to
- either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.
