Please note that entries will be accepted only thru DogShow.ca – paper entries and entries thru other online entry services will not be accepted.

Mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds with a Canine Companion Number (CCN) are permitted to enter these trials.

The trial precinct shall consist of all areas inside the Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association (NADA) facility as well as the parking lot and surrounding grassy areas.

Fee Structure

Entry Fee per Dog per Class (Pre-Entry) - \$35.00
Entry Fee for Additional Class, Same Dog/Trial - \$25.00*
Entry Fee per Dog per Class (Day of Trial) - \$45.00
Listing Fee (TCN) per Dog per Trial - \$11.50
Exhibition Only per Dog per Day - \$15.00

* This discount is for dogs who are entered in multiple classes in the same trial (Rally Advanced B, Excellent B, & Master, or Open B & Utility B Obedience only.)

There will be no refunds for withdrawn entries after the closing date except in the case of a female in season. When a female comes into season after entries have closed, she may be withdrawn from the trial and refunded provided the Trial Secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the female was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT POLICY

The Newfoundland (All-Breed) Kennel Club Obedience & Rally Committee has an absolute zero-tolerance policy for unsportsmanlike conduct displayed in relation to our trials, whether in person or on social media.

If anyone has a concern about a dog or person at a trial, the **ONLY** appropriate action is to speak to the Trial Chairperson who will seek to resolve the issue and will convene a committee meeting if deemed necessary.

Under absolutely **NO** circumstances is it acceptable or appropriate for anyone to approach another handler, judge, or volunteer in a confrontational, aggressive, or demeaning fashion.

The Trial Chairperson has the right to excuse any person without refund for the remainder of the weekend on the basis of unsportsmanlike conduct, and the committee has the right to reject future trial entries and bar entry to the trial site on the basis of unsportsmanlike conduct.

AGGRESSIVE/UNCONTROLLED DOG POLICY

All dogs **MUST** be under control at all times when on the trial grounds. Incidents such as barking at and/or lunging towards other dogs will not be tolerated, regardless of if contact is made. Consequences for aggressive behaviour could range anywhere from an Excusal for the weekend up to a Disqualification from competing in any future CKC events. Keep your dog on a short leash - short means they have **NO** leeway to pull you, for many of the large dogs this may even mean having a hand in their collar - and if you cannot have **100%** attention them, put them back in their crate. These incidents most often happen while people are distracted chatting with their friends. If your dog is out of the crate, only they get your attention! Put them away and then chat as much as you like. Likewise, if your dog is out of the crate, **100%** of their attention should be on you. They should under no circumstances be staring at other dogs or be approaching or attempting to approach other dogs out on the floor or in their crates.

These are Obedience competitions and as such, there is a bare minimum expectation that all dogs entering these trials are under control of the handler and are safe to be around other dogs.

Please, if you see anything that gives you cause for concern on the trial grounds, let the Trial Chair know so she can resolve the issues before anything happens.

All exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs. Clean up bags and garbage bins are available for this purpose throughout the trial site. There continues to be those who do not take responsibility for their dogs, jeopardizing the club's access to this venue. For this reason, exhibitors who permit a dog to soil on the trial grounds without cleaning up will be denied entry to NKC shows and trials for one full calendar year.

There is absolutely no urinating allowed against the building, the steps, or the grass immediately next to the building and steps. Please move your dog away from the building before allowing them to potty. These are NADA's policies, and we must ensure they are followed if we wish to continue using this facility in the future.
