Entry Fees (Cdn or U.S.): **TD** or **UTD** test: \$75.00; **TDX** or **UTDX** test: \$90.00

A Listing Fee of \$9.60 Cdn or U.S. must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number, or Event Registration Number (ERN), is not shown on the entry form. The registration number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entry in a CKC event.

- U.S. Exhibitors: We accept U.S. cheques or U.S. bank Money orders in U.S. funds. Please do not mark U.S. cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" as the bank will not accept them.
- An NSF cheque will be subject to a \$40.00 service charge. The Entry fee plus NSF service charge must be paid in cash prior to competing.
- Faxed, emailed, drop-box or hand-delivered entries will NOT be accepted.

Field & Urban Tracking Tests: May 27th – 28th, 2017: General Information

** **SATURDAY: 4 TD, 4 TDX tracks**. If a level does not fill, we may offer a different track level (exchanges per CKC 6.2.2), depending on site & tracklayer resources. Exhibitors may send in an entry & cheque for <u>any</u> level on Saturday in case there are exchanges or to be placed on an alternate list.

** **SUNDAY: 5 UTDXs** offered: If the UTDXs do not fill we will offer exchanges to UTD only. (No field tracks). Exhibitors may send in an entry for UTD on Sunday in case this occurs, or to be an alternate. Cheques for unused entries will not be cashed and will be returned or destroyed at exhibitor's option.

ELIGIBILITY:

- A CKC TD title is a prerequisite for entering either a CKC UTD test or TDX test.
- A dog eligible for a PEN number must have their PEN number prior to entering the test, and may not enter as a Listed dog.
- A Listing Fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.
- Canadian entrants who are not CKC Members: An annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles
 will be charged for dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member. This fee is not applicable to CKC members or
 dogs co-owned by CKC members. Non-CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or
 pay the Non-Member Participation Fee within 30 days of notification, or awards will be cancelled by the CKC.

ENTRIES, DRAW, ALTERNATE LIST, and REFUNDS:

- Entrants will be notified by email or phone when their entry has been received by the Test Secretary.
- **DRAW FOR ENTRY**: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date will take place at the Canine Coaching Club on Wednesday, May 17th at 7:30 pm, to determine placement into the test or alternate list. Position of the exhibitor in the test or alternate list will be provided within 24 hours of draw completion.
- Club Worker Draw (per CKC 6.6.2): At the entry draw, 1 TDX track (Sat) and 1 UTDX track (Sun) will be reserved for eligible "Club Workers" as defined by the TBK&TC Tracking Test committee. The worker draw precedes the regular draw, and any entries not drawn are then returned into the Regular draw.
- An entry of a non-titled dog in a given class (level) will be given preference over the entry of a dog already
 having the CKC title in that class/level. (rule 6.1.18). Purebred dogs untitled or titled have preference over
 entries of Mixed Breed or unrecognized breeds. This preference shall also apply if a level does not fill and tracks
 are exchanged (at the time of the entry draw) for other levels as permitted by CKC and club resources.
- If an entered dog is withdrawn after the closing date, a refund will be given if the vacancy is accepted by an Alternate. Alternates will be contacted in Catalogue order and may accept or decline. Remaining Alternates as of test day are encouraged to attend the draw in case there is a withdrawal or no-show of a confirmed entrant.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to compete, but will be assigned the last track. Please advise the Test Secretary immediately upon arrival at the meeting place, **or earlier if possible**.

The Draws will be held at Tim Horton's at the corner of Oliver Road and Golf Links Rd.

Any primary entrant(s) who is absent at the assigned draw time will forfeit his/her position if there are alternates present. Please be sure to arrive on time for your draw.

AWARDS & LUNCHEON:

 Each passing team will be awarded a Rosette and Medallion from TBK&TC, after completion of the days tests. Bring your camera for a photo with the judge!
