The following CKC regular conformation classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Baby Puppy: 3 months of age/under 6 months of age. Baby Puppies are *not* eligible to

compete for Championship points.

Junior Puppy:6 months of age/under 9 monthsSenior Puppy:9 months of age/under 12 months12-18 Month:12 months of age/under 18 months

Canadian Bred: Dogs born in Canada, <u>champions in any country excluded</u>
Bred by Exhibitor: Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder

Open: For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC

Veteran: Any dog 7 years of age or older

Specials Only: For any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration, ERN or MSC

number must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing. The entry of

a "listed" dog in Specials Only is not allowed.

Exhibition Only Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may

enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in

this premium list.

Exhibition Only Puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months

PROVIDED THE OWNER ALSO HAS A DOG ENTERED IN A REGULAR

CLASS.

The following additional non-regular and unofficial classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

Brace Class Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex)

Stud Dog and Get Entry into this class shall comprise the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get

(Note: Get MUST be entered in a regular class, Stud Dog must be entered in

a regular class or for Exhibition Only)

Brood Bitch and Progeny

Shall have all the same requirements as the Stud Dog & Get Class

Sexually Altered Classes

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows:

Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed

Working Class This class shall be open for all Samoyeds 12 months of age or older who have

participated in sledding, skijoring, obedience, rally obedience, agility, draft dog, herding, or weight pull. Age divisions in this class will be **Adult** - 12

months to 7 years; Veteran - 7 years and older.

Note: the winners of these classes will compete for Best Working in

Specialty - they DO NOT compete for Best of Breed.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Saturday, August 3, Held under CKC Rules.

Classes Offered: Conformation: Pee Wee (non-competitive); Junior Novice, Intermediate

Novice, Senior Novice, Junior Open, Intermediate Open, Senior Open.

Age Structure: Pee Wee (4-6 years), Junior (7-11 years), Senior (12-18 years).

Entries: \$2.00 payable at registration, with \$1.00 contributed to the Provincial Finals fund.

Entries will be Samoyeds entered in the show or for Exhibition Only that day. 1. Entries will open one (1) hour prior to the commencement of judging of the Specialty on Saturday, Aug. 3, and will be taken at the SAC tent. Junior Judging will commence immediately following the completion of all regular and non-regular classes at the Specialty.

Awards: Rosettes for first to fourth in each competitive class and for Best Overall. Participation ribbons for all others.

Rosette for Winners Male, Winners Female, Reserve Winners Male, Reserve Winners Female. Rosette and a prize for Best Altered in Breed and Best Opposite Altered in Breed.

Non-Regular Classes

Best in each Non-Regular Class receives a prize and rosette.

Unofficial Classes

Winners of each class will receive a prize. Best Overall Working Samoyed will receive a prize and a Rosette.

NOTE: Payment in full must accompany your entries. Tendering of a dishonored cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.) Any dishonored cheque or declined credit card(s) will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made

Exhibitors Please Note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary not later than closing date and time. If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

ERN NUMBERS: Effective Jan. 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard number, (expiry date, cardholders name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. Cost \$59.40. ERN number must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee:

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian nonmember of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

A ramp will be available for use at the Judge's discretion.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 2. All rules and regulations applying to the Alberta Kennel Club Summer Classic shows shall apply to this specialty show.
- 3. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
- 4. SHOW PRECINCTS: Within 50 feet of the designated specialty ring.
- 5. DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- 6. There will be no cover provided for the Specialty ring in the event of inclement weather.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*} includes the dog awared Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.
