IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THIS SHOW

By submitting entries to this show you are declaring that you agree to the following rules and regulations. All these rules will be **strictly enforced.** Please do not enter this show if you have personal or political reasons for not respecting the protocols and guideline set forth by the Alberta Government, regarding COVID-19 protocols, rules to keep us all safe. Execution of the show is contingent on permission from Albert Health Services and the Alberta COVID reopening plan that allows ADULT SPORT EVENTS and we are allowed to compete in the numbers expressed in the catalogue. LDKC is communicating regularly with AHS and will follow their direction. Refunds will not be considered if you cannot travel to the show due to a restriction on travel, at the time of the LDKC All Breed Dog Show.

There will be a PHOTOGRAPHER at this show. Photos Now will have their own COVID-19 Protocols in place. See attached information sheet.

THE SHOW GROUNDS

The Official Show Grounds will be the **AREA SURROUNDED BY THE WHITE FENCE** and will be used for all shows. The AREA SURROUNDED BY THE WHITE FENCE is considered the Official Show Grounds.

There will be signage as to Entrance and Exit of the official Show Grounds. All entrances will have Screening Booths. There will be hand sanitizing stations provided in all areas.

There will be NO lost and found. Judges' tables and other touch surfaces will be sanitized regularly, throughout the day.

MASKS

Masks are mandatory at all times while in the ring. Masks must be worn properly. <u>Additional</u> Face Shields will be accepted as well, worn along with a face mask. Neck warmers, masks with exhalation valves, handkerchiefs and any other loose fitting face coverings are NOT masks and will not be considered as Masks.

If you do not bring a mask, one will be provided for you, at a cost.

HAND STAMPS

Every day, before you can enter the SHOW GROUNDS you will fill out the COVID-19 Assessment Tool located in this Premium List and bring it to the Screening Station. Upon acceptance, a LDKC volunteer will give you a STAMP ON YOUR HAND YOUR STAMP is ONLY GOOD for one day. The COVID-19 Screening can be done at any time throughout the day, at any Screening station.

Upon entry onto the show grounds, you will need to show your stamp before you can enter. LDKC will refuse entry into the "official show grounds" to anyone without a STAMP.

Each exhibitor will receive a maximum of ONE STAMP only per entry. Due to COVID-19 protocols, there will be a maximum number of people allowed ON THE SHOW GROUNDS at one time. NO replacement STAMPS will be issued.

COVID-19 WAIVER/DISCLAIMER

Order 05-2020 legally obligates any person who has the following core symptoms of cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat (that is not related to a pre-existing illness or health condition) to be in isolation for 10 days from the start of symptoms, or until symptoms resolve, whichever takes longer, or they receive a negative COVID-19 test. If they are exhibiting any of these symptoms, it is suggested they complete the COVID-19 Self-Assessment online tool to determine if they should be tested. If you exhibit any of these symptoms or the symptoms on the COVID-19 Assessment Tool, you will NOT be allowed to attend the show.

The LDKC COVID-19 WAIVER/disclaimer, can be found on Dogshow.ca under COVID-19 WAIVER. Please print off a copy for EACH DAY that you are entered in the show.

When you arrive for the first time, please fill out the WAIVER/DISCLAIMER, found on Dogshow.ca and bring it to the Screening Station. Look for the SCREENING Stations at the East entrance. Do not wait until just before you need to be in the ring with your dog, to get your wristband for the day. The LDKC volunteers are not responsible for poor timing on your part and the COVID-19 Screening will take priority over everything else.

If you are unable to attend/exhibit due to COVID-19 or any other ailment, it is your responsibility to find an alternative handler for your dog, if you wish to show/trial your dog.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Maintain SOCIAL DISTANCING while ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. We are providing extra space in the rings to maintain these distances. We are marking the GROUNDS, so you do not encroach upon the person in front of you, be respectful.

There will be a staging area for each group, do NOT encroach on other areas or rings.

SHOWING

Exhibitors should arrive on the grounds at least ONE HOUR prior to their scheduled show/trial time and allow time for COVID-19 screening. Once screened, stay outside of the SHOW GROUNDS until 15 minutes before your breed time for showing. Once inside the SHOW GROUNDS, go directly to your staging area and stay there until your breed is called into the ring.

Once you have finished showing your breed, you will be required to leave the GROUNDS promptly if you have no other dogs to show within the next 15 minutes. You may return 15 minutes before your next breed or Group judging, etc.

If you are showing more than one dog, you may bring a crate to house your conflicting dogs, in a holding area. This crate must be removed at once, upon completion of your breed judging. No Xpens, floor mats or tables will be allowed

ON THE GROUNDS

BATHING FACILITIES

The wash bay will only be available in 15-minute intervals. There will be a sign-up sheet at the entrance to the bays.

REFUND POLICY

If we are required to CANCEL the show due to any Alberta Government, COUNTY OF LETHBRIDGE or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies, or directives, as outlined in paragraph 1, a partial refund (based upon our unrecoverable costs) of entries will be reimbursed. In the event of any refunds, DOGSHOW.CA service fees will not be refunded. If you are refused entry due to not passing the Covid-19 Assessment Tool you will not be given a refund.

Violation of any of these rules set forth will result in your entries being cancelled with NO refund of entries. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS AND NO EXCUSES. Be respectful to each other, the LDKC volunteers and let us keep each other safe.

** TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBERS (TCN) **

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent CKC registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained BEFORE submitting an entry for any event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$59.40 plus 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. CKC Non-Member Participation Fee - (24-12-3)

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by <u>Canadian resident non-CKC members</u> and are not applicable to CKC members"
 *Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

This fee does not have to be paid before entering this show.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of closing of entries for show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only <u>providing the transfer is</u> submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the order/handler at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show.

When one or more all-breed championship shows and/or specialty shows are held on the same date in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, <u>but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time.</u> If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

ERRORS IN ENTRIES

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Dog Show Rule books and regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 3. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY EMAIL after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" CKC rule book, Section 19.7.
- 5. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE if during the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. IF DUE TO COVID THE SHOW MUST BE CANCELLED, A PARTIAL REFUND OF ENTRY FEES WILL BE GIVEN. NO SERVICE FEES FROM DOGSHOW.CA WILL BE REFUNDED.
- 6. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show grounds. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the grounds for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
- 7. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
- 8. SHOW PRECINCTS shall be the AREA SURROUNDED BY THE WHITE FENCE
- 9. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.

Covid Protocols for **Photos-Now** dog show Photography.

Taking photos inside and out.

Our usual setup for picture taking is

Flowers and sign, then Judge, dog and handler.

Revised setup.

Judge, flowers and sign, dog then handler.

This setup would have at least 6 or more feet from judge to handler.

Mask protocols would follow what is set for the show.

The photographer is at least 15 feet from those getting their photos taken. He will follow show mask protocols as well. We would also take photos for each judge as they arrive for the day so they can be inserted into a photo taken without a judge.

Viewing photos

INSIDE

We normally set up the viewing stations behind the main table to allow multiple exhibitors to view at once.. the covid protocol will change the setup to have the viewing stations in front of the table to restrict access. Only one exhibitor and those in their bubble will be allowed at the viewing stations at a time. The viewing stations would be wiped down before another exhibitor uses them.

OUTDOORS

The viewing stations will be setup in the tent as always but the same system will be used, only one exhibitor or those in their bubble will be allowed in the tent at once. Then viewing stations wiped down before another can access.

We will setup for photos as far from the rings and general show area to respect social distancing.

To show organizers. We will work to follow all covid protocols put in place for your show. Please add our protocols to your premium list protocols so we can all be protected.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

** Dogs competing at	breed level	2	3 - 5	6 – 9	10 - 12	13 or more

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more then five points at a single show.
