The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

GRAND CHAMPION POINTS

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh) 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). (c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (17-09-20) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (07-04-21) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) 5354 (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In

Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The

Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE:

1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club we will be unable to accept, cancel or substitute an entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing date.
2. All entry confirmations and Judging Schedules will be sent as soon as possible after entries close.
3. It is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY** the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries.
4. All exhibitors should review Section 4.1-Judges-General, sub sections 4.1.3, 4.1.4 & 4.1.5 of the CKC Conformation Rules and Regulations.
5. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
6. It is the **exhibitor's responsibility** to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged.
7. The Miramichi Kennel Club, its officers and associates will use due care & diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. If because of riots civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, and it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
8. **The Show Superintendent** will be in complete charge of the show and/or trial which will be governed by the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC)
9. **SHOW PRECINCTS** - The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers, and an area of 30 feet outside of the judging rings. **There will be NO GROOMING TABLES, CRATES OR EXERCISE PENS ALLOWED UNDER THE SHOW TENT.**

CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES

Chapter 13, Section 10 of the Dog Show Rules States:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry. Notice of withdrawal must be in writing and received by the Show Secretary on or before the official closing date as published in the premium list. When the premium list indicates that entries will be limited, cancellation of entries will not be permitted.

MOVING A DOG TO THE SPECIALS CLASS

Chapter 13, Section 13, of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which is “INDIVIDUALLY REGISTERED AT TIME OF CLOSING” in the recorded of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirement of a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to “Specials Only”, providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least **ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THE BREED** by the owner or handler.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS FROM THE CKC

NOTICE TO ALL CLUBS: HEALTH REMINDERS

This notice is to provide clubs with a reminder regarding the health of the dogs on the premises of events.

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have

Tests are open to all purebred Dachshunds and those Terriers in:

TESTS

Introduction to Quarry (IQ – Not an official CKC Test)

This test is a simple instinct test requiring no training or previous exposure to earthwork. Young dogs with no previous working experience and novice handlers are encouraged to enter. Open to all eligible dogs that have not completed requirements for a JE title or higher title.

Novice Earthdog (NE – optional) – This test is designed to provide a titling option for those dogs that are not yet ready for Junior but who have mastered the requirements for Introduction to Quarry. It is an elective test and dogs are not required to attain a Novice Earthdog title prior to entering Junior. The Novice Earthdog class is open to dogs who have not previously earned an Earthdog title. A dog may not enter Novice Earthdog and another regular class in the same test.

Junior Earthdog (JE) Open to all eligible dogs. A dog that has completed the requirements for JE is not required to move up to the next level but may no longer compete in IQ.

Senior Earthdog (SE) Open to dogs that have completed the requirements for the CKC Junior Earthdog title. A dog that has completed the requirements for SE is not required to move up to the next level.

The quarry used in these tests will be two live rats.

CKC REGULATION 15.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred

CKC Non-member Participation Fee: An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a CANADIAN non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to become a CKC member or pay the non- members participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

MOVE UPS: Move ups are permissible one (1) hour before the class provided that the dog is not already entered in that test.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a return e-mail address on their form.

AWARDS: Qualifiers in the Introduction to Quarry, Novice, Junior, Senior Earthdog tests will receive rosettes.

TEST PRECINCT: The precinct of this test will be the marked section of Noteworthy Farm, Cross Creek, NB. Dogs waiting to be tested shall be kept at least 30.5 m (100ft) from the perimeter of the test area in a designated holding area.

VALIDATION OF ENTRIES: Entries must be complete, with entry fees, signed including Participation Agreement. Entries submitted without this agreement filled in and signed will be refused participation in the tests.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the test, must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The trial-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

You are responsible for reading the club waiver (attached) which you will **electronically sign** with your online entry. Your helper (if you bring one) must complete a paper waiver and bring it to the tests (or email it to patrickmudge2@yahoo.ca beforehand). **You are responsible for calculating/checking your own points and knowing if your dog has achieved any titles. Your dog's Sprinter points (earned *after* August 28, 2019) are now available on your CKC online portal.** The calculations and handicaps are available via the Sprinter Rules & Regulations from the CKC website at: <https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations/Sprinter-Rules-and-Regulations-Effective-January-1>

On arrival for your scheduled time slot:

1. When you arrive, go to the main check-in station for the lameness and in-season inspection. You will need to swab your bitch with a tissue for in-season check and all entries may also be measured to determine their handicap. **AS OF Jan 1, 2024, bitches in season are permitted to enter these test but must wear clean, dry, snugly fitting panties specifically designed for the purpose of preventing/containing discharge. Bitches in season will run at the end of the day.**
2. **Have your dog's name added to the running order. Two to three dogs before your run**, proceed to the start line waiting area with your dog and have your Catcher (which maybe you or your helper) proceed directly to the finish line **with a leash**. ***Catchers CANNOT wait at the start line then walk/run down the chute when their dog steps to the start line for their turn. The Catcher must ALREADY be at the finish line and ready to catch the dog as the dog steps to the start line with their Releaser.*** Dogs may run "naked" or wear a flat, snug-fitting buckle catch collar with nothing hanging from it that can become entangled in the line (**NO running in martingale or slip collars and NO tags on catch collars**). You may walk your dog to the start line in a martingale, slip collar or harness, but it **MUST** be removed

- prior to releasing them.
3. Once your dog runs and is caught and leashed, **clear the chute area**, and prepare for their second run. For safety reasons, **please stay CLEAR of the chute when walking your dog back from the finish line.**
 4. Once you have completed your entered runs per dog, collected your ribbons and times from the table, and taken your photos, please feel free to stay and enjoy the day at Noteworthy Farm, have lunch at the Woodsmoke Café and cheer on your friends. There are other events you might want to participate in.

OTHER EVENT INFORMATION

You will need to crate your dog in/by your car. There will be no shade provided so please keep your dog cool by keeping windows open, using shade cloths, and providing fresh water (Water is available on site).

There's plenty of room for pop-up tents.

All competitors must bring ***TWO* leashes**, one each for the Releaser and Catcher. **A slip leash is ideal for the Catcher.** You may bring your own helper to act as your Catcher or Releaser. If you are not bringing a helper, you may list another exhibitor as your helper or request that a club volunteer release your dog. **This information will be gathered in a form via email ~2 weeks before the tests.**

Also, Noteworthy Farm would appreciate and will post any event pics/candid photos anyone wishes to share. (again to patrickmudge2@yahoo.ca)

Please ask for help when getting your title and Q ribbons from the check-in table. There are different rosettes for each Sprinter title and club members will help you get the right one.

There will be a "photo booth" set up near the parking area with title/event boards. Feel free to take some pictures of your dog with their ribbons.

Important Notes: Please respect instructions, pick up after and maintain control of your dog. **Retractable leads, prong collars, and electronic collars are not allowed on the premises. Owners may have their dog wear a muzzle, if they desire. Dogs may run “naked” or wear a flat, snug-fitting buckle catch collar with nothing hanging from it that can become entangled in the line. You may walk your dog to the start line in a martingale, slip collar or harness, but it MUST be removed prior to releasing them.**
