Sue will cover:

DOGS: what breeds can pull, and what breeds can pull in competition.

CARTS: 2, 3, and 4-wheeled, 2 shafts and dorsal hitches.

TACK: what the harness' job is, how to fit it and what type is best for your dog.

SAFETY: conditioning the dog, carrying children, and warmups

RULES: of CKC Draft Tests

TRAINING: getting your dog ready to pull the cart
