U.S. Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

^{*} Dogs entered in Unofficial events must also be entered in Exhibition Only or in a regular class

FEES / CHEQUES / N.S.F. CHEQUES:

All fees must accompany your entries. No entries will be accepted without accompanying full payment. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards that have maxed out shall be considered an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$50.00 fee charged for any N.S.F. funds issued to the Prince Albert Kennel & Obedience Club. (Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted). Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded.

OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORMS

ENTRIES MUST BE TYPED OR DISTINCTLY PRINTED. Owners are responsible for errors on entries. Incomplete entry forms must be returned to the designated owner or his authorized agent. Unsigned, telephone, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal strike when telephone entries may be made in accordance with the Canadian Kennel Club Regulations.

BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

12.2.1 Regular Official Classes: All of these classes must be divided by sex. Note: no dogs under the age of six months on the first day of the show shall be allowed within the Show precincts as defined in the Premium List. Every dog within these must be entered in one of the Regular Official Classes or in Exhibition Only.

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY</u>: shall be for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.
<u>SENIOR PUPPY</u>: shall be for dogs nine months of age and under twelve months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MONTH: for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any other country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder /co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: for all dogs.

VETERANS: for dogs 7 years of age and over. Can be spayed or neutered.

<u>SPECIALS ONLY</u>: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status <u>including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level</u>. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

NON REGULAR CLASSES:

- BABY PUPPY: shall be for dogs three to six months of age on the first day of the show. Baby Puppies can enter Sweepstakes from
 either the Baby Puppy class OR from Exhibition Only (3-6 months) class.
- EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 Months): Puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. Puppies in this category may enter and compete in Sweepstakes if a 3-6 months class is offered.
- EXHIBITION ONLY: Must be entered in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions; may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if offered.
- STUD DOG & GET Any sire and 2 or more of his offspring. Please indicate the Get on the Entry Form.
- BROOD BITCH & PROGENY Any dam and 2 or more of her offspring. Please indicate the Progeny on the Entry Form.
- BRACE (CONFORMATION) Any 2 dogs of either sex. Please attach the info for the second dog to the first dog's entry form.
- BABY PUPPY: 3 months and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. Winners of this class do not compete for points. The class is to be judged after breed judging..
- PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS: For Shetland Sheepdogs that have achieved any CKC recognized Title. Please supply a brief write up, about 100 words including the dogs Registered & Call names, along with your entry or send to Show Sec separately. Will be held after Best In Specialty.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show shall be credited with a number of Championship points (Ranging from 0 - 5) and the number of championship points to credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more	
Points Allocated"	0	1	2	3	4	5	* includes the dog awarded WINNERS

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT (effective 2012) be included in the calculation of points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED a the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded Best Of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same class competition shall be included in the total. The number of Championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 20.2. In addition to Championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

CKC Conformation Show Rules & Regulations – 19.7

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an even held under these rules is not subject to indignities...."
