Non-Member Participation Fees are in effect

An annual "Non-Member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number. In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "Non Member" will have a choice (a) either become a CKC member Or (b) pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please note: These fees only apply to dogs that are wholly owned by "Non-CKC Members" and are not applicable To CKC Members.

The precinct of the show/Trial will be the building and its entrances

This show/trial is held under the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club. The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the dog show rules of the CKC. A copy of the rules pertaining to Shows and Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel club 416-675-5511. The Cape Breton Kennel Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators. They will not be responsible or any equipment left at the show.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, Discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

Per CKC regulation 19.7. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, disqualified or barred from competition by action of the Committee. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after closing time is prohibited. The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules If because of riot, civil disturbance or acts of God, it is impossible to open or complete the shows/trial, no refund of entries shall be made

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship Points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of Championship points to be credited to the dog awarded Winners shall be provided here under:

In addition to Championship Points allocated at the Breed Level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, providing that a dog was defeated at the Group Level.
