JUDGES PROFILE




Karen Brearley

My Tervs, Poms and Shelties have brought home High in Class and High in Trial wins. We also compete in conformation, herding, agility and rally. My first sheltie, finished her championship, earned a rally and herding title all before one More recently, she has completed her Obedience year of age. Championship and Herding Championship. She was awarded the TOP VERSATILITY DOG at the ASSA 2013 NATIONALS and the TOP VERSATILITY at the 2010 Canadian Nationals. She has ranked in the top 10 Herding dogs at the Intermediate and Advanced levels for the past 3 years. I am now working with my younger sheltie who has a Rally title

and 2 legs of Herding Intermediate with a High in Trial...

I am certified to judge in all levels of obedience as well as rally and am a CGN Evaluator. I have volunteered as an instructor for the Junior Kennel Club and also as an evaluator for the St. John's Pet Therapy Program. Ember and Kitty were members of a K9 Vaudeville act who performed in care homes and hospitals. I love that my dogs make people smile!





My life with dogs began early with my father's hunting dogs, a pair of Springer spaniels. Recognizing my interest, a family friend introduced me to the Vancouver Junior Kennel Club where I became involved with obedience training. Education and work took priority for a few years, but when the time was right, I acquired a Springer puppy, became involved with obedience training once again and have had one or more Springers in my household since then. I have trialed my own dogs since 1975 and became an obedience judge in 1988 and a tracking judge in 2013.

I am actively involved in tracking, obedience, rally, spaniel hunt tests, and the St. John Ambulance therapy dog program. Presently I share my home with yet another Springer with whom I am enjoying all of these activities and have even

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE TRIALS

- 1. The club reserves the right to remove any person from the trial. The trial chairperson shall have full control of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the chairperson or veterinarian for any reason, shall not, after being excused compete in any class for any award the balance of the trial.
- 3. The trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability for, either dogs, exhibitors or patrons in the event of an accident or misfortune.
- 4. Dogs must be on the grounds one hour prior to the judging of their respective class.
- 5. The owner of a dog entered in these trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 6. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.
- 7. Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only, not in the show building.
- 8. If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, if it is impossible to open or complete the trials, there is no refund of entry.
- 9. No dog entered in any trial will be allowed to be off leash at any time on the precinct grounds unless it is in the ring being judged according to the trial rules and regulations.
- 10. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, or competitor at an Obedience or Rally Trial held under these regulation, is not subject to indignities of any kind.
- 11. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in these trials comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted, if a veterinarian's certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- 12. The Trial Superintendent has the authority to expel any dog deemed to be a danger to other dogs or exhibitors. There will be no refunds for dogs that are expelled.

PRECINCTS OF THESE TRIALS WILL BE THE AREA INSIDE THE GYM OR OUTSIDE IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OR ANY OTHER AREA DESIGNATED BY THE CLUB All exhibitors, handlers and patrons are expected to know the trial rules. Copies of Obedience and Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, may be obtained by sending \$8.50 plus 5% GST to the Canadian Kennel Club, 100-89 Skyway Ave. Etobicoke, Ontario. M9W 6R4

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee ("Non-Member Participation Fee Form No-150-00-50")

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the CKC website (http:/;/www.ckc.ca) under CKC Services – Forms. If submitted a membership application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dog(s) involved.

Event Registration Number ("Event Registration Number Application Form No-150-14-50"

For Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dogs)

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require and Event Registration Number (ERN). An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at (416) 675-5511 or by fax (416) 675-6506. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of the dog's forest Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (\$59.40 CDN) along with a letter of request to the CKC. This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering CKC events only. Go the www.ckc.ca for details.

CLASSIFICATION – OBEDIENCE

The following regular CKC classes (not divided by sex) will be provided for purebred dogs of any breed and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous class breeds of either sex. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A or Novice B Class, Open A or Open B Class, Utility A or Utility B Class at any one trial.

All exhibitors are required to be familiar with the CKC Obedience Trial and Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2015.

Obedience Classes: Regular

Pre Novice, Novice A, Novice B, Novice C, Novice Intermediate, Open A, Open B, Utility A and Utility B

Refer to Sections 9 to 13 of the Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for full details.

Obedience Classes: Unofficial

Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility, Team, Brace, Wild Card-and Veterans

Refer to Section 16 of the CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for full details.

Dogs entered in Unofficial Classes must also be entered in any regular class or for Exhibition Only.

EXHIBITION ONLY: This is an official class. A dog may be entered for Exhibition Only which must be specified on the entry form. All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as for a dog entered for competition. No dog so entered can compete in any Regular class, however it may be entered in and compete in any Unofficial Class. A listing fee is not required for a listed dog entered in Exhibition Only (not entered for any competition).

CLASSIFICATION - RALLY OBEDIENCE (Ring Size 40' x 50')

The following regular CKC Rally classes (not divided by sex) will be provided for purebred dogs of any breed and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous class breeds and of either sex. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B or Advanced A and Advanced B or Excellent A and Excellent B at any one trial.

RALLY NOVICE A: 9.1.1 Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, coowner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Please see 9.1.2 in the Rally Obedience Rule Book which states in part ...

RALLY NOVICE B: 9.2.1 Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. 9.3 All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE: 10.1.1 The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced. 10.1.2 This class shall be for dogs that have earned a RN Title.....

RALLY ADVANCED A: 11.1.1 This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Please see 10.1.2 in the Rally Obedience Rule Book which states in part ...

RALLY ADVANCED B: 11.2.1 This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. 10.3 All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT A: 12.1.1 This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Please see 11.1.2 in the Rally Obedience Rule Book which states in part.

RALLY EXCELLENT B: 12.2.1This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Sit Stay Exercise: See 12.3.1 – 13.3.6 A sit stay exercise must be included in the Rally Excellent classes
