CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January — December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You."

JUNIOR HANDLING Junior handling will be held Saturday and Sunday, Ring & time will be announced in the Judging Schedule.

Competitors are asked to please fill out the pre-registration form.

Class Structure- Conformation

Peewee Handlers 4 years of age up to 6 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year. This is a non-competitive class.

Junior Novice Handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Junior Open Handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won 6 first places with competition.

Intermediate Novice Class Handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Open Class Handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won 6 places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open Level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Senior Novice Handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

Senior Open This class is for handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have won 6 first places with competition, in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Best overall is optional at the discretion of the host club. Junior handlers are eligible to compete in the above class structure from their seventh birthday until they reach their eighteenth birthday.

TROPHIES & AWARDS

A rosette will be offered for Best In Show, Best Puppy in Show, Best Baby Puppy in Show, All Group placements, Best Puppy in Group and Best Baby Puppy in Group each day.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Judging will not commence prior to 8:00 am

The show precincts will be a 150-foot (45m) perimeter from the exterior of the rings.

The venue will be locked each evening. Opening and closing times will be posted in the judging schedule.

Limited number of catalogues will be available at the show.

This is an outdoor show with no cover. Exhibitors are encourage to bring their own pop-up tents.

No hydro or water hook-ups available. **BE SELF SUFFICIENT!**

RVs and Generators are permitted.

Exhibitor are requested to keep their grooming and crating areas clean and tidy

Dogs not entered in these shows will NOT be allowed within the precincts of the show.

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, governed by CKC rules.

If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the controls of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show or trial, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.

In the event of cancellation between the closing date and the opening of the show this show is forced to cancel due to provincial or federal restrictions related to Covid-19, the entry fees will be fully refunded.

Conception Bay Kennel Club and it's show officials will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortunes however caused.

REMEMBER TO 'STOOP AND SCOOP'

GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept entries reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list.

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES. TELEPHONE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

It is your responsibility to verify the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date.

The Show Secretary reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Dog Show Rules.

Identification cards and judging schedule will be mailed / emailed as soon as possible after entries close.

Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and the New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC, has ruled that where a conflict arises between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules that the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Changes or cancellation of any entry after closing date is prohibited.

In the event that the dog is absent, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, disqualified, or barred from competition by action of the bench Committee, no entry fees will be refunded.

To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loudspeaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.

Only dogs eligible for registration with CKC may enter this show and trial.

Conception Bay Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entries, subject to CKC rules.

Covid-19 Safety Protocol for The Conception Bay Kennel Club 2021 Shows/Trials

If it becomes necessary to cancel this show due to changes in provincial guidelines brought on by an increase in the incidence of positive COVID-19 cases all entries will be refunded. COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols seem to change frequently these days and we will expect everyone to follow the protocols which are required by the province, the venue and the club at the time of the show. Our Waiver must be signed by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants, Volunteers, Family Members, Friends etc. Contact tracing information must be provided for all who attend (name & phone number).

Be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring your own masks. Do not leave personal belongings at ringside. Do not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc. behind, dispose of these items in the garbage/recycling bins. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your

responsibility. **Avoid** common use pens/pencils – bring your own writing instrument.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

<u>SECTION 1:</u> A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6 -9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5
*Includes the dog awarded \	VINNERS					

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.
