

"MIXED BREED" (MIXED BREED of no breed designation)
Canine Companion Number (CCN) Effective: July 1, 2015

Definitions

- a) Mixed Breed dog: is a dog of unknown ancestry that belongs to no recognized breed and is not the result of selective breeding. b) Unrecognized breed: is a dog of known ancestry not on the CKC list of recognized or miscellaneous breeds, and that is registered with a Registry recognized by the CKC.
- c) Recognized breed is a breed that CKC is authorized to register in accordance with the Animal Pedigree Act (APA) or a dog of a breed included in the CKC Miscellaneous Breed list
- 2 Purpose
- a) A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows mixed and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events of Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials.
- 3 Eligibility a) In order for a dog to receive a Canine Companion Number (CCN) the following criteria must be met:
- 1) The dog must be either a mixed breed or unrecognized breed as defined herein.
- 2) Mixed breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered.
- 3) The dog must be identified with a Canadian Kennel Club approved microchip. 4 Applying for a Canine Companion Number (CCN)
- a) Complete the appropriate Canadian Kennel Club Canine Companion Number application form.
- b) With the completed form, accompanying documentation must be included as follows
- 1) Mixed breed dogs proof of spay or neuter.
- 2) Unrecognized dogs not eligible for registration by CKC and not on the Miscellaneous List a copy of a registration certificate from a CKC recognized Registry.
- c) The appropriate fee as noted in the CKC fee schedule.
- 5 Upon receipt of a Canine Companion Number (CCN), the dog may be entered in any of the events noted in 2 a. 6 A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.

The following Official CKC Classes will be provided: Pre – Novice, Novice "A", & "B", "C", Intermediate Novice, Open "HA", Open "18A", Open "18B", and Utility A & B.

6.9 MOVING UP - OBEDIENCE

CKC Rules And Regulations (Effective January 01, 2021)

6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, and ERN, or a MCN and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for the trial has not received confirmation of the title may be moved to the next level of competition providing the request is submitted to the trial secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler a minimum of one half hour before the opening of the first trial on that day, schedule permitting.

6.9.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

6.9.5 If it is established by the CKC that a dog moved up to the next level has not completed the requirements for the lower level before moving up, then all qualifying ribbons and/or awards earned by the dog incorrectly entered shall be forfeited and cancelled by the CKC and the owner may be subject to disciplinary action.

6.9.6 In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered in the CKC or have a Performance Event Number (PEN), an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) before entries close. The addition of a CKC number after close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will result in referral to the Discipline Committee.

6.9.7 **Exhibitors incorrectly entered** in the "A" class are permitted to move the dog to the corresponding "B" class up to one hour before the start of the trial.

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER (PEN)

Effective Jan 01, 2002,

A Performance Event Number (PEN), allows an unregisterable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in those competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. Those events are as follows: Obedience, Tracking, Herding, Draft Dogs, Agility, Lure Coursing, Earthdog Tests, Hunt Tests, Working Certificate Tests, and Pointing Field Dog Tests. A Dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a listed dog. Dogs may only enter events after a PEN has been issued to that dog. This restriction shall also apply to dogs with ILP numbers. Unregisterable Dog means, a dog of a recognized CKC breed that cannot be registered because of unknown parentage or the unavailability of its registration papers.

Selected and Veteran Titles

Titles for Selected include an "S" at the end of the title e.g. AG.N.S. Titles for Veterans include a "V" at the end of the title.

CLASSES

Novice replaces Novice A and Novice B. Excellent replaces Excellent A. Master Excellent replaces Excellent B.

Agility Novice (Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, Points and Distance): Open to any dog that has not earned a qualifying score in the CKC Agility Intermediate Class. Novice Standard and Novice Jumpers with Weaves will have one set of 6 weave poles, used once.

Agility Intermediate (Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, Points and Distance): Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Excellent (Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, Points and Distance): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Master Excellent (Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, Points and Distance): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title.

Steeplechase: One level, jumpers style course with weave poles and A-Frame. Scoring – time plus faults.

Jumps & Tunnels: One level, jumpers style course Scoring—Time plus faults.

Divisions - Regular, Selected, Veterans

Selected Classes

Any dog eligible to participate in a CKC agility trial may enter the Selected Class. In the Selected Classes, dogs jump one height lower than their regular jump height and the Standard Course Time is increased by 10%. Once a dog is entered in Selected Classes, the dog may not go back to compete in the Regular classes. Dogs move laterally and take any legs they have earned in the Regular classes with them.

Veteran Classes

Dogs 7 years or older may be entered into the Veterans division at one OR two heights lower than their Regular jump height. Dogs entered in Veterans may NOT move back into Regular or Selected. The dog will retain titles and/or qualifying scores accumulated towards titles and will have the same 10% additional Standard Course Time as Selected dogs.

JUMP HEIGHTS (one height lower than Regular for Selected, one or two heights lower than Regular for Veterans)

4 inches (Selected and Veterans only)
8 inches for dogs over 14" up to and including 18"
20 inches for dogs over 18" up to and including 22"

12 inches for dogs over 10" up to and including 14" 24 inches for dogs over 22"

Height of tire will be 4" lower than the jump height for other jumps, except for the 4" jump height. For example, if a dog jumps 20", the tire jump will be 16".

Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be eliminated. Judges may require any dog to be measured.

Check the CKC Agility Rule Book 2017 for all the changes and updates.

ENTRIES

- 1. All dogs must be individually registered with the CKC or eligible for CKC registration.
- The entry form must be completed in every respect and exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.
- 3. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Incomplete entries will be returned.
- 4. The tendering of a dishonoured (NSF) cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence subject to disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.
- 5. CANCELLATION of entries after Closing \$15.00 ADMINISTRATION FEE

Canine Companion Number (CCN)

1 Definitions

- a) Mixed breed dog: is a dog of unknown ancestry that belongs to no recognized breed and is not the result of selective breeding.
- b) **Unrecognized breed**: is a dog of known ancestry not on the CKC list of recognized or miscellaneous breeds and that is registered with a Registry recognized by the CKC.
- c) **Recognized breed**: is a breed that CKC is authorized to register in accordance with the Animal Pedigree Act (APA) or a dog of a breed included in the CKC Miscellaneous Breed list

2 Purpose

a) A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows mixed and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events of Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials.

3 Eligibility

- a) In order for a dog to receive a Canine Companion Number (CCN) the following criteria must be met:
 - 1) The dog must be either a mixed breed or unrecognized breed as defined herein.
 - 2) Mixed breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered.
 - 3) The dog must be identified with a Canadian Kennel Club approved microchip.

4 Applying for a Canine Companion Number (CCN)

Complete the appropriate Canadian Kennel Club Canine Companion Number application form.

With the completed form, accompanying documentation must be included as follows:

- 1) Mixed breed dogs proof of spay or neuter.

- 3) The appropriate fee as noted in the CKC fee schedule.
- 5 Upon receipt of a Canine Companion Number (CCN), the dog may be entered in any of the events noted in 2 a.
- 6 A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.
- 7 The Canadian Kennel Club may cancel for cause, any Canine Companion Number.

- Limited number of catalogues will be available at the show for \$ 25.00. (Pre-ordering is highly recommended.)
- The show precincts 30 feet from any ring or building housing show executives.
- "No Show All Breed or Specialty, Event, Performance Event, or Best in Show Judging, shall be delayed for any Exhibitor who has a conflict in another ring or event. All exhibitors are expected to have alternative arrangements made for any possible conflict."
- The Show Superintendent has the authority to ask exhibitors to move or take down any crates and private exercise pens, etc. Failure to do so when requested could result in disciplinary action.
- Exhibitors are requested to keep their grooming and crating areas clean and tidy. If space is at a premium, exhibitors must remove exercise pens if requested by the Show Superintendent or designate.
- Dogs not entered in these shows will NOT be allowed within the precincts of the show & trial.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, governed by CKC rules.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the controls of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show or trial, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to ensure that a judge or any show committee members are not subjected to any indignities. The Conformation Show Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee will have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- Diana Edwards Show Services & the Stormont, Dundas, & Glengarry Dog Association will use care and diligence for the
 welfare of all dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or
 misfortunes, however caused.
- Dogs need only to arrive 15 minutes before scheduled judging time and will be excused from each show when not required
 for further judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if
 judging times for their breeds conflict.
- ♦ Diana Edwards Show Services will only collect and utilize data and information that you provide us, and only for the purposes of the service we provide exhibitors entering a CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) event, and the subsequent documents generated for this event, and required by the CKC. Personal information will not be retained longer than needed for the specified purposes.

GRAND CHAMPION POINTS

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh) 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. - 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.
- 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (05-06-20) (05-06-
- 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles
- 15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

BORDER TERRIER CANADA ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

(Adapted With Permission From The Border Terrier Club Of America Room Policy)

Border Terrier Canada (BTC) has adopted the following rules in order to insure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future: Any individual attending a Border Terrier Canada (BTC) sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all of the following actions by the BTC Board of Directors.

- 1. May be banned from showing at the next BTC sanctioned event(s).
- 2. May be subject to CKC sanctions.
- 3. Membership in the BTC may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

Damages shall be defined as:

- 1. Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.).
- 2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground.
- 3. Any verified complaint by a BTC member.

BTC Room Regulations:

- 1. All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog.
- 2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel or campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
- 3. No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms. A grooming room will be available whenever possible.
- 4. Dogs are to be allowed on hotel furniture/beds ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.
- 5. All owners/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.





This trophy has been donated by Tim & Sara Coombes, Emma Simon, Terry Johnson & Andrea Nixon.

The name might sound ridiculous to those of you outside of Australia, but there is a good reason it was selected. In Australia "Fair Dinkum" is a common slang term which the dictionary defines as; Genuine/Honest or True. Since it was desired that the name for the Trophy be uniquely Australian, the Fair Dinkum Trophy was selected to be awarded to the Genuine/True most versatile Toller in the Specialty.

The Toller must compete over the days of the Specialty earning points in Obedience, Conformation, and the Working Tests. The Toller can be owner or, handled by a non-owner.

The Toller must Qualify or Place under the points system below to remain in the running. The highest set of points, earned from each Category, are counted and are "not" accumulative within a category. Categories are Obedience, Conformation, and Working Tests.

Obedience

Qualifying Score of 170 or over in UD – 4 pts Qualifying Score of 170 or over in Open A or B – 3 pts Qualifying Score of 170 or over in Novice A or B – 2 pts Qualifying Score of 170 or over in Novice C, Novice Intermediate, or Veterans – 1 pt (***Pre Novice, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility, Brace & Team are excluded)



Conformation

Class Dogs;
First in Class – 4 pts
Second in Class – 3 pts
Third in Class – 2 pts
Fourth in Class – 1 pt

**Please Note; Official and Unofficial Classes must contain at least four dogs for the above points to come into place. If there are less than four dogs in any class (Official or Unofficial) then 1 point will be deducted for eachdog not making up the class.

Example One - 3 dogs in class, First Place - 3 pts, Second Place - 2 points etc.,

Example Two - 2 dogs in class; -First Place - 2 pts, Second Place - 1 point, 1 dog in class is 1 pt.

Specials Dogs;

Best in Specialty Show (BISS) – 4 pts Best of Opposite Sex (BOS) – 3 pts Award of Certificate of Merit – 2 pts

Best in Show (BIS) Judging 1 pt – or if Judge does not make a final cut then any Specials Dog that is in the running for the Fair Dinkum will get 1 pt.

Working Tests

Qualifying Run in WCX – 4 pts Qualifying Run in WCI – 3 pts Qualifying Run in WC – 2 pts

To Make things easier for the tallying of this award it is asked that the competing Tollers be identified to the Committee/Scorer as soon as possible prior to the start of the final day of competition.

The Fair Dinkum will be awarded to the owner of the winning Toller, after the last Qualifying event. The Owner of the "Winning Toller" shall be holder of the Perpetual Trophy until the next Specialty. Any Winner of the Fair Dinkum at the Specialty will be awarded a Keeper Trophy. Should the Fair Dinkum not be won at a Specialty (which might be the case) then we ask that the previous owner of the winning Toller keep it until such time that it is won.

In the event of a "Tie" at the end of the Specialty, then the highest point scorer in the Working Test shall be the winner. In the event there is still a tie then the highest point scorer in Obedience shall be the winner. In the last unlikely hood there is still a tie, then let the youngest Toller (not Handler) be the ultimate winner.


PARKING GUIDELINESFOR THE WEEKEND AT THE SHOW




