****NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE/TCN Number:** The CKC requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). TCNs will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). <https://www.ckc.ca/en/News/2020/March/TCNs-What-Are-They-And-How-Do-You-Get-One> If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by the Shows and Trials division by telephone.

SPECIAL STATEMENT ACCORDING TO CKC SCENT DETECTION TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a reporting indicating that this has occurred.

Bitches in season - Bitches in season are eligible to compete as of January 1, 2024. Should a bitch be in season, the handler must notify the trial secretary prior to the trial date. Bitches in season will be scheduled to run last in each component and must wear clean, properly fitted panties.

Reminder: Anyone discussing hides before the end of the class will be awarded a score of “NQ” and will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules.

Test Site: Indoor benching is not available. Please be prepared to bench out of your vehicle. The trial will run rain or shine. All dogs must always be under control and on leash, except where off leash searches are permitted.

Washroom facilities are onsite. Dogs are not permitted in washrooms except when searching.

- ❖ If, due to civil disturbance or acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, there shall be no refund of entry.
- ❖ Please allow for absentees and variances in the rate of judging.
- ❖ Please obey staging directions, including entry and exit directions, in the trial area. Any competitor failing to comply with staging directions may be removed from the trial.
- ❖ Please clean up after your dog. Competitors failing to pick up after their dogs will be excused from the trial.
