Regular classes: (All classes divided by sex except Specials only)

Junior Puppy - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY 9-12 month CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of this Specialty

<u>12 to 18 months CLASS</u> - This class shall be for dogs at least 12 mos. of age and under 18 mos. on the day of this Specialty

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u> - This class is for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Female classes will not compete for championship points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

<u>SPECIALS ONLY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for Champions of record at the time of closing of entries for this Specialty. Note: A Listed dog may be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded.

Non-Regular Classes: (Baby Puppy 3-6 month Class divided by sex

<u>BABY PUPPY 3-6 MONTH CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

<u>BRACE</u> - This class is for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily the same sex). A brace must be handled by one person on one lead

<u>STUD DOG AND GET</u> - This class shall be comprised of the stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be spayed /neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

BROOD BITCH AND PROGENY - This class shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog and Get.

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades. if, provided for in the premium list. DOGS ENTERED IN NON-REGULAR CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

Unofficial Classes: (PARADE OF LIONS and BREEDER/OWNER /HANDLER)

PARADE OF LIONS - to Be Held Before the Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes

PARADE OF LIONS: (spayed/neutered dogs in any trim may enter parade).

Please send along a bio up to 50 words about your Lowchen when entering the "Lion" parade to Nadine at chenoka.lions@gmail.com at time of entry. All parade exhibitors enter the ring together and the bio is read as each Lowchen takes their turn parading around the ring.

BREEDER/OWNER/HANDLER

The Breeder/Owner/Handler shall be comprised of Lowchen 6 months and over on the day of the specialty (including specials). Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. This class must be held after the Best of Breed judging and any non-regular class judging.

Obedience:

In addition, the LCC will support the Highest Qualifying Score by a Lowchen in an Obedience or Rally Obedience trial on the day of the Specialty.

SWEEPSTAKES - to be held after the Parade of Lions and before Specialty Judging

Sweepstakes Classes: (Divided By Sex)

PUPPY CLASSES: Junior Puppy 6-9 months, Senior Puppy 9-12 months and 12-18 months.

Dogs entered in the Sweepstakes MUST be entered in one of the regular classes or Exhibition Only.

For final judging, the first place dog from each of the above six classes will be brought together for the final placing of "Best Puppy in Sweepstakes" and "Best of Opposite Sex Puppy in Sweepstakes"

PRIZES:

Best Puppy in Sweepstakes will receive a Rosette and 25% of the total entry.

Best of Opposite Sex in Puppy Sweepstakes will receive a Rosette and 20% of the total entry.

First in each class will receive a rosette and 5% of the total entry.

2nd thru 4th place in each class will receive a rosette.

The Club will retain 25% of the entry fees for expenses.

Sweepstakes Classes: (Divided By Sex)

VETERAN CLASSES: 7-10 years and 10+ years on the day of the specialty

To enter these classes the dog MUST be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, veterans or exhibition only.

For final judging, the first place dog from each of the above four classes will be brought together for the final placing of "Best Veteran in Sweepstakes" and "Best of Opposite Sex Veteran in Sweepstakes"

PRIZES:

Best Veteran in Sweepstakes will receive a Rosette and 25% of the total entry.

Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes will receive a Rosette and 20% of the total entry.

First in each class will receive a rosette and 7.50% of the total entry.

2nd thru 4th place in each class will receive a rosette.

The Club will retain 25% of the entry fees for expenses.

<u>Prizes:</u> suitable prizes and/or Rosettes have been donated by the LCC and the generosity of friends and members of the Lowchen Club of Canada for:

BOB, BOS, BOW, BPIB, WD, WB, RWD, RWB, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best Baby Puppy, Best Veteran, Best Brace, Best Stud Dog & Get, Best Brood Bitch & Progeny and Breeder/Owner/Handler. A Rosette will be awarded for $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ in each class and $\mathbf{2}^{\text{nd}}$ to $\mathbf{4}^{\text{th}}$ in each class.

Award of Merit will be given at the judge's discretion one for every 10 dogs competing at the Best of Breed level. Award(s) of Merit receives a Rosette.

A Rosette with dogs name printed on it will be given to all Parade exhibitors.

A suitable prize and/or Rosette will be given to the Highest Qualifying Score by a Lowchen in an Obedience and/or Rally Obedience trial on the day of the Specialty.

A Listing Fee of \$10.50 (per day) must accompany the entry if a CKC INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION NUMBER, ERN or PEN NUMBER does not appear on the entry form.

In the case of a listed dog competing, the Canadian Kennel Club does not confer a title on any dog until said dog is Registered Individually or is issued an ERN or PEN number in the Club's records.

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ISSUED ON ANY DUPLICATE OR OVERPAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES

MAKE ALL CHEQUES/MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO The Lowchen Club of Canada.

In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$45.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. **Fax entries** and/or **credit card payment** will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD credit card number, expiry date and card holder's name. 10% of total fee will be added for FAX/Credit Card entries. GENERAL RULES COVERING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the Show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above Shows and Trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- 2. The Show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the Show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the Rule, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this Rule has been violated.
- 4. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds.
- 5. Dogs must be on the Grounds one hour before the judging of their Breeds, and may be removed when not required for further judging.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of Breed or Class Judging. No Ring shall be held up waiting Exhibitors or Handlers. Exhibitors and Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute Handlers available so that judging will not be delayed.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these Shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the Entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship Show held under these Rules cannot again be shown at a Show held under these Rules until the dog has been examined by an Official Committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the Examining Committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and Handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the Exhibitors and the Spectators we insist upon keeping our Grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please Exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging Ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, NOT in the vicinity of the Ring areas.
- 11. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fore, an act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13. The use of PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM will be kept to an absolute minimum. Therefore, IT WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITORS TO HAVE THEIR DOGS AT RINGSIDE, when necessary. There will Be no paging for individual dogs.
- 14. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the Grounds for the duration of the shows.

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

JUDGES - SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information, may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- (a) Registered with the CKC
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number
- (c) Eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (d) If it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification

Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES - SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonored cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

BORDER CROSSING - A RABIES CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED TO BRING A DOG INTO CANADA, GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE AND IT MUST BE DATED AT LEAST 30 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY INTO CANADA.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE FAMILIAR WITH THE RULES PERTAINING TO THE EVENT IN WHICH THEY ARE COMPETING. THE "DOG SHOW RULES & OBEDIENCE REGULATIONS ARE AVAILABLE FROM:

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS: For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC degrees and titles, individual registration will no longer be required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs, instead they may apply for an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a photocopy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and the appropriate fee (currently \$58.50) with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering events only)

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Conformation Championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Conformation Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship. All required points are to be earned at the breed level. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points which must include one Best of Breed and a minimum of two wins of at least two points each. a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed Winner and the number of similar sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship title.
