CARO trials are open to all dogs being at least six (6) months of age, including purebred and mixed breeds, with a CARO Registration Number, except bitches in season or dogs with injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.

ENTRIES OPEN AT 9:00 AM TUESDAY MARCH 4, 2025. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED BEFORE THIS DATE AND TIME. ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6:00 PM THURSDAY MARCH 27, 2025 OR WHEN ENTRY LIMIT IS REACHED, WHICHEVER OCCURS EARLIER.

Entry Information:

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. No entry will be accepted until entry fees are paid. Telephone or paper entries cannot be accepted.
- 3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 4. Alterations, substitutions, or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited.
- 5. Only dogs with a CARO Registration number may be entered.
- 6. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE AT 6PM ON THURSDAY MARCH 27, 2025, OR WHEN THE ENTRY LIMIT IS REACHED, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
- 7. Judging schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after entries close.

Move Ups (Change of Class):

Same day move-ups will be permitted between classes. Please note that it is the handler's responsibility to inform the Trial Secretary before their next event.

Day of trial entries will NOT be accepted.

Rosettes and Ribbons:

Flat ribbons will be awarded for qualifying scores only. A rosette will be provided for 1st to 4th in each class. New title rosettes will be offered for \$10.00 on day of trial only (exact change please).

Bitches in Season:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, indicating that the bitch was in season within ten days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences. The club will refund entry fees, less the service fee levied by dogshow.ca.

Limited Entry:

Entry in each trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to perform 7 hours of judging at the rate 15 dogs per hour less time for walk throughs in Rally Obedience. Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after the closing of entries, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

Indignities:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-hosting club to see that any judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a Rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Rally Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall take action as deemed necessary to restore order, including removal of the offending person(s) without refund.

Accommodations for Disabilities:

CARO welcomes and encourages the participation of all dogs and handlers. Should a dog or handler have a physical disability which prohibits the completion of one or more station signs, modifications can be made to the course to reduce or remove components which are impediments to the team's performance.

Common modifications include:

- o Reducing the height or depth of the obstacles (e.g., jumps may be reduced to a pole on the ground)
- o Reducing the number of sits requested on the course
- o Allowing extra time
- o Minimizing the number of stations that include repetitive turns like spirals
- o Allowing for larger turns in stations such at the 270-degree and 360-degree turns

Judges shall make reasonable time modifications for owners or dogs with limited mobility or for larger, slow-moving breeds of dogs.

Veteran dogs (7 years of age and older) do not require a modification request to reduce the height of jumps or depth of the broad jump.

Process to obtain a modification:

- 1. Final approvals for modifications are at the discretion of the judge.
- 2. Competitors must submit a request for a modification to the Trial Secretary at the time of their entry.
- 3. Requests will be forwarded to the judge on your behalf. The request should include:
 - 1. A description of the physical challenges involved.
 - 2. A description of the modifications being requested.
 - 3. Contact information to allow the judge to contact the competitor if needed to clarify information and discuss modification options.
 - 4. For dogs: In cases where the challenge may cause the dog to appear unsound, such as having an uneven gait, the request should be accompanied by a letter from a veterinarian which states that the dog is able to compete without discomfort. A copy of the letter should be included with each trial entry where the modifications are being requested.

General Information:

- 1. The Trial Chair will be in full charge of the trial which will be governed by CARO Rules and Regulations, the CARO Code of Ethics and the rules of the Red Barn Event Centre.
- 2. The Red Barn Event Centre will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. The trial precincts shall be the entire building and grounds of the Red Barn Event Centre.
- 5. Request for refund for any reason other than Bitch in Season will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Request must reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences. Supporting documentation may be required.

Health Reminders:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease, AND/OR
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within 30 days prior to the event, AND/OR
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

There is no access to food or drinking water at this event. Please bring water for you and your dog.

RED BARN INFORMATION:

There is a private residence at the front of our property. PLEASE respect this and proceed slowly down the long driveway. 10 kph limit! Please do not walk dogs down the driveway. It disturbs the dogs who live there.

Check in is at the main entrance Registration desk when you arrive. Staff will be available to assist you if needed. Course maps will be available at check in.


ALL shoes MUST be changed to clean indoor shoes and dog paws cleaned/dried off in the entrance area of the facility.

There is space available for crating indoors at the Red Barn on a first come, first served basis. You are also welcome to crate from your vehicle, but we cannot allow your dog to bark constantly while in your car, and we do not call out names in the parking lot when it is your turn. All dogs must be crated or on leash when not in the ring (x-pens are allowed). Handlers are responsible to keep their dogs quiet at all times, clean up after their dogs and exercise them in appropriate areas only. There will be containers to dispose of dog waste, but we ask that you take your other trash home with you.

No prong, spike or shock collars are permitted on the property.

Any dog engaging in aggressive behavior at any time will be required to leave the trial grounds without refund.

<u>Directions to The Red Barn Event Centre</u>: 8464 County Road 27, Barrie, ON L4N 9C4

Please do not use address in GPS, use these GPS coordinates: lat 44.344860 long - 79.741025

From the 400 Southbound: Take the Essa Road exit 94. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Take the first right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to the end at County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27 (aka Town Line Road). Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

From the 400 Northbound: Take the Innisfil Beach Rd exit 85. Turn west at the lights onto Innisfil Beach Rd. and continue to CR 27 in Thornton (the road will end). Turn right onto CR 27 and head north for 3.2km, then turn left to stay on CR 27 (the sign is small). Look for the 20th Sideroad on your left and then McKay Road on your right, that's your cue to slow down. Continue north on CR27. After passing Mapleview Dr. W. you will go down a big hill, the Red Barn is on your left at the bottom of the hill. Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.
