DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD: This is a large, slightly rolling field.

From the east: Follow Hwy #1 west to 200th, turn left (south), and then follow the instructions above. For those coming from south of Hwy #1, make your way to 200th St., drive south until you reach 8th Ave and follow above directions.





- Stakes will be split if the entry in any breed reaches 24 or more at Roll Call.
- The owner of the filed requests all competitors or spectators not to bring a bitch in season onto the grounds. Please respect this for the sake of all entered males. Please check your bitches before leaving home.
- Entry fee for all bitches in season and lame hounds will be refunded .provided notice is given at or before Roll Call.
- Hounds not present at Roll Call will be scratched and entry fee not refunded.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has happened.
- Only the 1st place winner of the Mixed Stake may compete in Best in Field.

The dogs will run in groups of three and will be drawn for courses based on their appropriate size. They will run 2 courses, once in each direction.

Your dog should have had some previous experience running long distances and be in appropriate physical condition to run such a course. Your dog should have had experience running with other dogs and have not shown any signs of aggression.

All owners of dogs running in this event understand that they run their dog(s) at their own risk. The Club will accept no liability whatsoever in the event that a dog is injured in any way while participating in the event.
