CKC will allow the use of the letters AG.M.X.2 and so on signifying an Agility Master Excellent earned a second, third or fourth time.

CLASSES OFFERED

Agility Novice A (Standard or Jumper with weaves): For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or with any organization. In Novice Jumper with Weaves, there are only 6 poles.

Agility Novice B (Standard or Jumper with weaves): Novice B is for agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and, for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

Agility Intermediate (Standard or Jumper with weaves): Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Excellent title.

Agility Excellent A (Standard or Jumper with weaves): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Excellent B (Standard or Jumper with weaves): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent, the Agility Master Excellent, Agility Excellent Jumper or Agility Master Excellent Jumper titles.

Classes – Regular, Selected or Veterans

A dog may be entered in one of the three types of classes: Regular Classes, Selected Classes and Veterans Classes during a trial or set of trials. The owner may choose to enter the Selected Class in lieu of entering the Regular Class at any trial. The dog must be entered only in Selected Classes or in Regular Classes, at the same set of trials (a dog may move back and forth between the Selected Classes and the Regular Classes, but not at the same set of trials offered by a club on the same day or on consecutive days). A dog must be started at the Novice Level for each Class: Regular Standard, Regular Jumpers with Weaves, Selected Standard and Selected Jumpers with Weaves.

Selected Class

The Selected Classes dogs run the same course as the Regular Classes but will have adjusted height and course times. (One jump height lower and additional 10% added to the course's time).

Veterans Class

At the option of the owner, a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Any new titles earned will be designed with the letter "V" for Veteran following the title (ex: AGMXV). All Veterans will compete as if running in the Selected Classes at one or two jump heights lower than regular and with 10% additional time allocated for the Selected Class.

Owners are responsible for entering the correct height divisions. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be excused from the trial. Judges may require any dog to be measured.

Entries

- 1. This agility trial is open to all CKC recognized and listed breeds, 18 months of age or over.
- 2. Entries forms must be filled entirely. Incomplete entries will be rejected. Exhibitors are responsible for any error on their entries.
- 3. No entry will be accepted without full payment of the entry fees.
- 4. Tendering a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fee shall be considered non-payment of fees, and will be considered an infraction of disciplinary measures and will bring cancellation of awards and scores.
- 5. Attention Foreign Exhibitors. Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.
- 6. Non Member Participation Fee: These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

NOTICE TO PARTICIPANTS

- 1. The Trial area will be a fenced ring plus a perimeter of 10 feet around the ring.
- 2. Only dogs entered at the trial are permitted inside the trial area.
- 3. No cover provided in case of inclement weather or for the sun. Please bring your own shelter. Space is limited for exhibitor shelters.
- 4. Please pick up after you dog.
- 5. All dogs must be kept on leash except during their runs or in the designated section for warm up.
- 6. No food or other reward is allowed on the course. The dog may wear a well fitting flat buckle, quick release or rolled leather collars.
- 7. The owner or agent entering a dog at a trial does so at his own risk. The Discharge form must have been signed.
- 8. Agility obstacles shall meet the requirements of the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 2010.
- 9. Société Canine de Québec reserves the right to decline any entries, as per CKC rules.

Rules applying to CKC Agility Trials

A judge officiating at a trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Trial Chairperson will immediately report any kind of infraction to the CKC rules and the CKC board of director will take necessary action pertinent to the infraction.

MOVING UP

A dog that has received 3 qualifying scores from at least 2 different judges may be transferred to the next level provided that a written or electronic request is sent to the secretary one week before the trial. Dogs may be moved up to the next level for the Sunday trials by filling in the required move-up form before the end of Trial 2 on Saturday. Dogs may move from excellent A to B between trials, however, no other move-ups will be permitted between trials on the same day.

WAITING LIST and REIMBURSEMENTS

- 1. No entries may be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries (except for provisions in the CKC rules)
- 2. If the limit of entries is reached before the closing date, an alternate list will be provided. Dog on this list will be able to participate at the trial by replacing cancelled dogs. Owner of non-participating dogs will be refunded
- 3. There will be no refunds for a dog absent at the day of the trial, if the dog/handler has been removed from the trial by the trial committee, or for bad weather.
- 4. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entry has been submitted to the trial Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 days period preceding the trial, must reach the trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. Then the owner will be refunded.
- 5. An owner with a dog injured after his entry has been submitted will be refunded if the owner sends to the trial Secretary before the trail day proof of injury with a veterinarian's certificate.

AWARDS & PRIZES

- Ribbons/rosettes will be offered in each height division for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placements in each class, for qualifying dogs only. All qualifying dogs will receive a qualifying ribbon.
- Société Canine de Québec will offer a rosette to dogs that receive a new CKC title at these agility trials.
- Les Mordus de l'agilité will offer a prize to the team with the highest qualifying score of the standards courses #1, 2, 3 and 4 in the novice, intermediate and excellent classes.
- The best overall cumulative qualifying score of the 4 trials by Border collie will receive a prize offered by Cindy Bergeron and Flavie Prévost, Élevage Instinct.
- The best qualifying score by a Group 1 spaniel at the Saturday afternoon (Trial #2) on May 26 will receive a prize offered by Corteo, Linda St-Hilaire & Alain Morissette.
- The best qualifying score by a Belgian Shepherd in the Saturday morning (Trial #1) on May 26 will receive a prize offered by Création JD.
- The best qualifying score by a Belgian Shepherd in the Saturday afternoon (Trial #2) on May 26 will receive a prize offered by Élevage Hidalgo Isabelle Bouchard.
- A prize for versatility will be given to the highest qualifying score in any of the 4 trials obtained by a dog that is a CKC show champion and also has a performance or working title (obedience, agility, herding, hunting, rally). Titles must be indicated on the entry form. This prize is offered by Isabelle Giroux (Élevage Boomrang) in honour of her dog, Indy (CH OTCH ATCH Indiana Jones Oakhill HT BH)
- The best qualifying score by a Bouvier des Flandres in the Saturday afternoon Trial (Trial #2) on May 26 will receive a prize offered by Bouvier des Flandres Élites Québécois.
- Spock kennel, Denis and Murielle Guérin, will sponsor a Société Canine de Québec rosette for a Corgi that receives a CKC agility title at these trials.

How to get to the trial:

From 20 West:

Take exit St-Étienne (Exit 305). At the stop, turn right. You are on Route Lagueux. Continue to the end, up to the traffic lights, turn left on Rue Principale. At the next set of lights, turn right, cross the bridge and at the Petro-Canada, take the road on your right. You are then on Chemin Ste-Anne Ouest. Continue up to 87 Chemin Ste-Anne. You should see the Agility grounds on your left.

From 20 East:

Take exit St-Étienne (Exit 305). At the first light turn left. At the second set of light, turn left. You are on Route Lagueux Continue to the end up to the traffic lights, turn left on Rue Principale. At the next set of lights, turn right, cross the bridge and at the Petro-Canada, take the road on your right. You are then on Chemin Ste-Anne Ouest. Continue up to 87 chemin Ste-Anne. You should see the Agility grounds on your left.
