Juvenile Sweepstakes

Open to all Dachshunds puppies over 3 months and under 18 months of age who are entered in the regular classes of the specialty show. Puppies aged 3-6 months may enter Juvenile Sweepstakes from the Exhibition Only (3-6 mos.) class.

Classes divided by sex (not breed) as follows:

3-6 mos, 6-9 mos, 9-12 mos, 12-18 mos For finals judging the first place winners for each class with be judged together to select Best Puppy in Sweepstakes. Distribution of total entries will be as follows:

1st in Class receives 50% of that classes entry

Best Puppy in Sweeps receives 25% of entire entry Club retains 25% for expenses.

Rosette for Best Puppy in Sweeps, Ribbons for 1st to 4th in Class.

Veteran Sweepstakes

Open to all Dachshunds over 7 years on the day of the Specialty who are entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only.

Classes divided by sex (not breed) as follows:

7-9 years, 9+ years

Distribution of total entries will be as follows:

1st in Class receives 50% of that class entry

Best Veteran in sweeps 15% of entire entry

Best of Opposite in Sweeps 10% of total entry

The club retains 25% for expenses.

Rosettes for Best Veteran and Best of Opposite in Sweeps, Ribbons for $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ to 4th in Class.

JUNIOR HANDLING

Junior Handling for handling Dachshunds will be offered. Dogs partaking in juniors must be entered in the Specialty in a regular class or for Exhibition Only.

All Regular Classes including Pee Wee

Rosettes for $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ in class, and Best Overall, prizes for all participants.

Entry \$2.00 payable at the show.

ADDITIONAL PRIZES

CLASSES

Regular Classes:

Baby Puppy: for puppies 3 months of age not exceeding 6 months of age. Does not compete for CKC Championship points.

Junior Puppy: for puppies 6 months of age and not exceeding 9 months of age.

Senior Puppy: for puppies 9 months of age and not exceeding 12 months of age.

12-15 months: for puppies 12 months of age and not exceeding 15 months of age.

15-18 months: for puppies 15 months of age and not exceeding 18 months of age.

Canadian Bred: bred in Canada

Bred By Exhibitor: must be breeder, Owner/Co-Owner Handled **Open:** for all dogs, Except Baby puppies. Please check puppy box if a puppy under 12 months of age.

Veteran's Class: Dogs over the age of 7. DO not complete for CKC Champion Points, go directly to Best of Breed Leve;

Special's Only. For dogs who have obtained the CKC requirements for Canadian Championship and have a CKC Registration Number.

Sexually Altered Class: 2 Classes offered Male and Female.

Award of Merit: At the conculsion of Best of Breed competition the Club is offering Award of Merit. One for every 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed at the Judge's discretion.

Special Select: At judge's discretion, Select awards may be presented.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.

 No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Fax entries will be accepted. See instructions elsewhere in this premium list.

3. Post-dated cheques ARE NOT acceptable. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A \$35.00 SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL N.S.F. CHEQUES AND INVALID OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS.

4. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.

5. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing MUST BE MADE IN WRITING to the Show Secretary so as to be received BEFORE SHOW CLOSING DATE.

6. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or canceled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.

7. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be mailed or emailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's address. All online and fax entries will receive a conformation email, this is your receipt for our shows.
8. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and

exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron. The Show Giving Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.

9. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Chapter 24, Section 6, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules states "Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and the obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
 10. ACCORDING TO CITY BYLAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in designated areas. Anyone not following stop and scoop policy will be excused from the shows and trials.

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee. An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

Rules & Regulations

This specialty show is in conjunction with an all-breed show and there for the specialty will conform to their rules and regulations. Please see there premium list for further details.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:)

Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13+
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1.
