Herding Clinic at Sheep Thrills Farm, Grandora, SK

Cost: **\$450/dog/working spot – only 8 spots available**

SASSA is very pleased to have Kristin Thomson coming to do a 2 day herding clinic. Not only does Kristin breed Shetland Sheepdogs, she also herds sheep, cattle, ducks and who knows what else with them! She has participated in conformation, obedience and rally-o as well. She has spent many years training and mentoring under Lynn Leach and is a trainer, teacher and handler of many breeds.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions in the province of Saskatchewan, social distancing (3 sheep) will be in effect. Masks will be available. **This event is NOT open to the public.** If you have been exposed to COVID-19 or are experiencing symptoms, please do not attend. Fees will be refunded less expenses if event is cancelled due to COVID. Lunches and refreshments will be provided at \$5.00 IF COVID-19 restrictions allow. Sandyridge Gas Station is the closest convenience store that does offer lunch options.

The clinic will be held on sheep with a CKC regulation size arena and a round pen that will be utilized to accommodate dogs and handlers of all levels. Sheep Thrills farm has free, on-site camping but no hookups. There is a map on Sheep Thrills website, [www.sheepthrills.ca](http://www.sheepthrills.ca), for directions to the farm. Best Western Blairmore is the closest pet-friendly hotel.

There will be NO refunds for cancellations unless the spot can be filled by someone on a wait list. A deposit of \$200 is required to hold a spot with the balance due by Sept 1, 2021. There is no discount for multiple dogs and switching dogs during the clinic is not permitted unless agreed to by the clinic host and clinician, and may incur an additional fee.

There is a STRICT stoop N scoop policy. ALL dogs must be on leash, crated or x-penned at all times when not being instructed.
