2019 JUDGES' BIOGRAPHIES

JEFFERY BAZELL, USA

Jeff Bazell is the 3rd generation dog show enthusiast. His grandfather bred Black and Tan Coonhounds, his grandmother and father were heavily involved in Chow Chows and Jeff finished his first champion, a Pekingese purchased from Nigel Aubrey-Jones, at the age of 9 by winning a specialty. His involvement in Brussels Griffon began at age 12 and continues to the present, with over 1000 titled dogs bred, co-bred or shown by the St John Kennel. During the 1980's he bred many champion Newfoundlands including putting multiple group and best in show wins on two male Landseers. He a teenager he showed Afghans for Kay Finch in California, owned and showed many Kingsmark Greyhounds and has international experience with many sighthound breeds. He has been judging for over 25 years and has enjoyed judging all over the world along with his husband, Jeff Kestner. The Jeffs also have a new found love in the Lancashire Heeler breed and are actively opening a breeding program to help introduce this wonderful breed to North America.

Jeff is a garden designer, plant breeder and nursery owner and has won over 100 international design awards including the Queen's Gold Medal for Horticulture. He has been a featured designer at the Floriade in the Netherlands, the Ameriflora in the US and the Royal Horticultural Society Chelsea Flower Show. He has also taught in design schools at the university level and is a former special needs kindergarten teacher.

MICHAEL CANALIZO, USA

Mr. Canalizo of Mill Neck, NY has spent many years as a breeder, owner, professional handler, and judge. His first exposure to the purebred dog came in 1961 with his family's first Afghan Hound Babu Bamn of Grandeur, who's first litter was sired by the 1957 Westminster Best in Show winner, Int. Ch. Shirkhan of Grandeur.

Mr. Canalizo was the breeder, owner and/or handler of the two Afghan Hounds that remain the number one and two top winning Hounds of all time. He has won two Top Owner Handler Awards and six Quaker Oats Awards. Collectively he piloted over 100 Afghan Hounds to their championships, had over 300 all-breed Best in Shows and nearly 1,000 Hound group awards. He is currently approved to judge Best in Show, the Hound, Toy, Non-Sporting and Herding groups plus several breeds in the Sporting and Working groups.

Mr. Canalizo's credentials include developing and presenting dog-related educational seminars worldwide, feature writing, and working as a contributing editor for numerous national and international publications. He has officiated at events in 28 countries to date. The 2019 Westminster Kennel Club dog show will mark his 54th year of attendance. This will be his first judging assignment at Westminster, following in his mother's footsteps, a past WKC judge herself.

BILL DEVILLENEUVE, NY, USA

I began as a breeder-owner-handler in the early 1970's with my Scottish Terriers. I have whelped 20+ litters and shown 20+ Scotties to their AKC championships. I was the top Scottie owner-handler in the US with two different dogs in the 80's and 90's. In 2006 I owned the #1 Scottie bitch (#2 overall), a multi group, multi BIS, and multi BISS winner; CH. Wychwood Wyndola of Duff-De; shown by Bergit Kabel. I have also bred and owned several other multi group and BISS winners as well as the top producing Scottie brood bitch 20 years ago.

Although my judging schedule has forced me to cut back on breeding and limited my available time for showing, I am staying somewhat active and have produced two litters in the last 5 years. Two boys in the first litter were sold and owner handled to their AKC championships, and two girls from the recent litter 2 ½ years ago have also finished their championships. In fact, I kept one of the girls and returned to the show ring as an exhibitor for the first time in almost 7 years and finished "Hannah" myself. It was exciting and challenging to show once again and be in the ring on the other side of the lead. I have just bred my girl and hope to have a litter of puppies on the ground in early May.

With regard to judging, I was first approved for Scottish Terriers in 1983 and completed approval for the Terrier Group in 1991. Since then, I have been approved to judge the Toy Group and then completed approval for the Working Group in 2010. More recently, I have been approved for 8 provisional breeds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Beagles, Whippets, Scottish Deerhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, PBGVs, Bulldogs, and Lowchen. I have judged a Scottish Terrier specialty in Scotland and the national specialty in the US along with many regional specialties in the US and Canada. My judging travels have also taken me to Sweden, Mexico, Dominican Republic, almost every province in Canada, and most of the states across the US.

I truly enjoy judging and have fun doing it. I also try to make it an enjoyable experience for the exhibitors, their dogs, and the spectators too.

MICHAEL J. DOUGHERTY

Michael J. Dougherty started with his family in purebred dogs in 1961, acquiring his first Whippet in 1963. By 1974 he was approved by the American Kennel Club for a limited handler's license, attaining all-breed status in 1977 - teaming with his father, Jack Dougherty. While concentrating on handling he also bred and owned, with his family, Miniature Schnauzers, Smooth Fox Terriers, and Keeshonden, as well as Whippets. As a professional handler, he guided the careers of many top winning dogs, including Best in Show winning Whippets and Bichon Frise. His handling focused mainly on breeds in the Hound, Terrier, Non Sporting, and Toy Groups, but also included many breeds in the other three groups.

A graduate of United States International University, Dougherty has been in the public relations and publishing industry for 40 years. He has represented and worked with such luminaries as Gore Vidal, Maya Angelou, Joseph Wambaugh, Tom Wolfe, Robert Ludlum, Larry King, Donald Trump, Dick Morris, Sidney Sheldon, Judith Krantz, James Clavell, Christopher Isherwood, Richard Reeves,

Nancy Reagan, Doris Day, M. Scott Peck, William Manchester, Dick Cavett, Timothy Leary, Irwin Shaw, Arianna Huffington, Douglas Fairbanks, Jr., Howard Fast, Studs Terkel, Frankie Laine, Josh Logan, Dick Cavett, Ken Follett, Michael Crichton, Rex Reed, Dr. Robert Atkins, Michael Murphy, Ben Stein, and Alvin Toffler, among others.

From 1981 through late 1989 he directed his own Beverly Hills-based public relations firm. From 1989 through 1992 he held the position of Executive Director of Publicity for the book publishing company, Jeremy P. Tarcher, Inc. From September 1992 through mid-1997 he headed his reestablished independent public relations firm. From mid-1997 through the end of 2002 he was the Director of Marketing/Sales/Publicity at Renaissance Media/Audio Renaissance, a Los Angeles-based book and audiobook publishing company. Presently he heads Dougherty & Associates Public Relations, an independent PR and marketing agency.

In 1985 Dougherty retired from professional handling to pursue a dog judging avocation, again following in his father's footsteps. He is currently approved by the AKC to judge Best in Show, the Hound Group, the Terrier Group, Manchester Terriers (Toy), Bichon Frises, Boston Terriers, Dalmatians, French Bulldogs, Keeshonden, Lhasa Apsos, Poodles, and Tibetan Terriers, plus Miscellaneous Classes and Junior Showmanship. He has judged at shows across the nation such as Westminster (7 times, including Best in Show in 2013), Montgomery County (4 times, including Best in Show in 2007), Morris & Essex, AKC/Eukanuba, Westchester, Bucks County, Eastern, Ladies, Philadelphia, Chicago International, Atlanta, Maryland, Detroit, Beverly Hills, Great Western Terrier, and Santa Barbara. His international judging assignments have taken him to Australia, Taiwan, Colombia, Sweden, Germany, Italy, Ireland, Finland, Canada, Mexico, and Japan.

He and his wife Michelle, a fine artist and bonsai artist, reside in western North Carolina.

ROBERT D. ENNIS

Mr. Ennis resides in Blasdell, New York and is a retired elementary school teacher. He has dedicated his lifetime to the sport of purebred dogs. As a child he grew up with an American Cocker Spaniel and it is this breed that he has continually owned and exhibited for over 50 years.

Throughout his devotion to the sport of purebred dogs, Mr. Ennis has maintained an active membership in both national and local dog clubs and served in many capacities. He is a life member of the American Spaniel Club and for many years served as the Judges Education Coordinator. Currently, he is chairman of the standard committee. Mr. Ennis is also on the Board of Directors for the American Dog Show Judges, Inc. He is currently the Director of Education and chairman for the annual judges institute in Louisville, KY. In his local area, he is president of the Niagara Cocker Spaniel Club and vice-president of the Kennel Club of Buffalo.

Mr. Ennis' judging career began in 1993. Since that time he has been privileged to judge in most of the 50 US states as well as Canada, Europe, Australia, and New Zealand. Currently, he is approved to judge all Sporting, Toy and Non-Sporting breeds as well as some Hound and some Working breeds, Best in Show and Junior Showmanship. He is eagerly looking forward to his judging assignment at Erie Shores Kennel Club.

DONNA FRANCIS, USA

I have been involved with the world of pure-bred dogs for decades as a breeder, owner, professional handler and judge. As a Siberian Husky breeder, I bred a National Specialty winner and numerous champions. In Pembroke Welsh Corgis, we (Elfwish) have finished over 60 champions. In Dandie Dinmont Terriers, we have won at all levels here and abroad, including a Group 2 at Crufts!

As an AKC judge, I currently judge the Herding Group, several hounds, working breeds and terriers, as well as Best in Show. I have also judged abroad in New Zealand, Australia, N. Ireland and England, China and Russia.

DR. STEVEN D. HERMAN, USA

The sign in my office reads "Full Time Dog Man-Part Time Attorney". I started in dogs in 1980, just a couple of years after beginning my practice. Picking my first German Shorthaired Pointer puppy, at ten weeks of age, I did a pretty good job. Rommel was a top ten dog, along with being my versatile

dog—doing obedience and NAVHDA. I have remained active and successful in this breed. My bitch was Best of Breed at Westminster in 2010 and she went on to be the top producing dam for 2011. Her son garnered my first All Breed Best In Show with a German Shorthaired Pointer, in 2013. He was top producing sire for 2013 and 2014.

With my first Wife, I exhibited Afghan Hounds for many years. Then, I did some showing and breeding of English Cocker Spaniels and Golden Retrievers. However, my next big venture was with Pointers. Since 1990, I have been involved with this breed. Owning and breeding many Group and Best In Show winners. Most have had their hunting titles, too. One Best In Show bitch also was the top Field Trial puppy, a previous year.

Acquiring a German Wirehaired Pointer bitch in 1995, I campaigned her to the top ten. A bitch from her litter was shown by me to the top ten, three years in a row. During this time, I also owned a Miniature Wirehaired Dachshund.

My experience with the three Pointer breeds led me to present a comparison seminar about them. I now judge the entire Sporting Group, Best In Show and a number of Hounds. I have officiated at the German Shorthaired and Wirehaired Pointer, Pointer Club of Canada and Golden Retriever Nationals. My Wife and I live with, show and hunt a GSP in Wesley Chapel, Florida. I co-own a number of other GSPs, that allow me to remain active in conformation, breeding, hunt tests and field trials.

We collect dog art and travel to Cruft's regularly. I have judged in Colombia, Canada and Sweden.

NELSON HUBER, USA

I have raised Norwegian Elkhounds from 1967 till around 1995. Have bred and shown 3 BIS Elkhounds. I was a All Breed professional handler for 12 years. I first received my Judges license in 1980. I have also raised a couple of litters of Bassets, Beagles, Dobermans, Malamutes. Showed a Cesky Terrier who was the number one Cesky in the US for 4 straight years, and number one in Canada for 1 or 2 years. I judge all the Working and Hound groups, BIS, and Juniors. I have enough experience to apply for the Herding group, but have declined to do as I enough assignments to suite me with the 2 groups I already have.

PETER KING, AUSTRALIA

Like many people in the Canine world, Peter's association with purebred dogs can be traced back to his families association with Irish Setters, Standard Poodles and Dachshunds many years ago.

After establishing a career in aviation, Peter returned to purebred dogs in the early 1990's and established a small, yet highly successful kennel, breeding under the Greysouthen prefix.

Concentrating on Gundogs and in particular Retrievers & Weimaraners, his Greysouthen Kennel has produced numerous Australian & International, Grand & Supreme Champions amongst them MBISS Aust. Grand Ch: Greysouthen Kings Legend ET QC TD, a multiple All Breeds Best in Show and Royal Show winner, a prolific sire, an accomplished Field, Tracking and Endurance dog and arguably one of the finest all-round Weimaraners bred in Australia in the last 25 years.

Along the way, Peter has exhibited, handled or titled a number of other Gundog breeds, including Curly Coat, Golden, Labrador, Chesapeake Bay Retrievers, & Tollers, Cockers, GSPs, English Pointers, Springers, Setters and Continental Gundogs. He also has an interest in Dalmatians, Great Danes, British Bulldogs & Standard Poodles.

In recent years, along with his love of Weimaraners, Peter has concentrated on Flat Coat Retrievers and his current dogs are ranked as the top Flat Coats in Australia.

For Peter, the progression to judging was a natural step. He has earned a solid reputation judging at All Breeds and Specialty Shows across most States of Australia, both islands of New Zealand & around South East Asia. He is a regular visitor to the Pacific region, and to FCI CACIB events in Europe, Scandinavia and The Baltics. He is readily acknowledged for his friendliness, his keen eye for a quality dog, especially youngsters, his depth of knowledge of Gundog breeds, their form, function and inherent qualities.

In 2016 Peter was honored with judging the New Zealand Weimaraner National Show and attracted the largest entry of Weimaraners ever seen in that country. He has judged numerous Specialty Shows covering a variety of Gundog (Sporting Group) and Non-Sporting breeds in Australia, New Zealand, Thailand, Sweden, Denmark, Germany, Italy, The Benelux countries and The Baltics

Peter is a Specialist Judge, fully approved to award Championships and judge Best in Show for all Gundog breeds (FCI 7 & 8) as well as all Non-Sporting Group, well over 60 breeds in total. He is also approved to judge Toys at Open Show level as well as Handler Classes.

Outside of the show ring, Peter's interests include Tracking, Endurance, Field Retrieving and rough shooting during the winter season. He is past President of the Weimaraner Club of Queensland and is currently President of the Northern Gundog Society of NSW and Show Manager for the United Retriever Club.

Peter serves on the Executive of several leading Canine organizations & committees in Australia and is a highly experienced Ring Steward, Royal Show Official and commentator at the prestigious Sydney Royal Show (the largest dog show in the Southern Hemisphere).

Peter lectures and mentors on various breeds for Judges Training in several States, is a regular contributor to number of canine publications and magazines around the world and is a popular guest on radio and television where he provides specialist commentary on a variety of Gundog breeds.

He is a very keen traveller and has been a licensed Pilot for over 40 years.

GEORGE KOSTOPOULOS, GREECE

George Kostopoulos, was born in 1964 in Athens, Greece. From an early age his main interest was dogs. Although he graduated from the University of Athens with a degree in Political Science, this interest led him to England and then to U.S.A. in order to widen his knowledge of dogs.

While in England, he worked for boarding and breeding/show kennels (with Great Danes, Cockers, Am. Cockers & Pekingeses), regularly attending dog shows as exhibitor, ring steward and later judge (Open Shows). Simultaneously, taking a course run by the Canine Studies Institute, he studied the subjects of breeding, showing and judging, gaining the General Certificate of Canine Studies in 1988. In U.S.A he specialized in professional dog training at the National K-9 School of Dog Trainers in Colombus, Ohio and in 1989 he graduated with the Master Trainer Certificate. He then became involved in the American dog world, working together with a Professional Show Handler and helping showing many different breeds at shows all over the East Coast of the United States.

Back to Greece he started working as a professional dog obedience trainer and problem behavior counselor, which he does till today.

- Editor of the Greek Kennel Club's magazine (1991-1993) and contributor to many others.
- Editor of TOP DOGS newspaper (2006 2008).
- President of Greek Kennel Club's Judges Committee (2005 2009)
- Breeder of Champions in Afghan Hounds and Whippets with the kennel name ALLSATIN and exports to Canada, Italy, Serbia, Spain, Finland, Sweden and Israel.
- Today he is into Cavalier King Charles Spaniels.
- Judge at Open Shows (England) since 1992.
- F.C.I International Judge since 1996. Approved for All Breeds and Best In Show since 2007.
- Has judged in 47 countries in 5 continents: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, China, Croatia, Czech Republic, Cyprus, Denmark, England, Estonia,

France, Finland, F.y.r.o.m, Greece, Germany, Holland, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lebanon, Lithuania, Malaysia, Moldavia, New Zealand, Norway, Peru, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Serbia, South Africa, Slovenia, Slovakia, Spain, Switzerland, Sweden, Thailand and Ukraine.

RICHARD POWELL, USA

Richard Powell has been involved in show dogs most of his life, beginning with English Cockers and English Setters in his native England. He came to California in 1976 and decided to pursue a career in terriers, working for many renowned terrier handlers.

When he and his wife Sue decided to go into the handling business they moved East and bought a boarding kennel and small farm. As a handler Mr. Powell showed many breeds, including breeding and showing Welsh, Cairn, Norfolk, and Wire Fox Terriers. Mr. Powell is licensed to judge the Sporting and Terrier groups, Dachshunds, and Giant and Standard Schnauzers. He is presently working on the Toy breeds.

GARRY K. NEWTON, USA

I have been involved with the sport of pure-bred dogs since the 70's. Although my first show dogs were Great Danes, which I brought back from England from my overseas military service, I am best known for my involvement with sighthounds, and more specifically Salukis. I first showed under the kennel name S'Dawn, but after marrying my wife, Dr. Judith A. Newton, we combined our kennels under the name of Solari, named after the first Saluki that we owned together.

We have successfully and bred and exhibited Salukis since the 1980's. Our Salukis have excelled in the conformation ring, obedience, lure coursing, and junior showmanship.

I have owned and /or bred Afghan Hounds, Salukis, Ibizan Hounds, Greyhounds, Petite Basset Griffon Vendeen, Borzois, and Great Danes, as well as a Golden Retriever, Italian Greyhound, a Toy Fox Terrier, and a Parson Russell Terrier.

I have been involved in the sport of lure coursing since the 1970's, both as a participant, as a judge and lure operator. I served on the first AKC (American Kennel Club) advisory panel for lure coursing when AKC first started lure coursing.

I am currently approved by the American Kennel Club to judge both conformation (Hound, Herding and Working Groups, Junior Showmanship, and Best in Show) and lure coursing.

I have been honored to judge throughout the United States, Canada, Ireland, Finland, Sweden, South Africa, Australia, Korea, Germany, Japan, and China. I have also been honored to judge multiple local as well as national specialties.

In my non-canine professional life, I am a Director of Nursing/Registered Nurse and an internationally known canine sculptor, working in both bronze and stone. I am also a published author of a fictional novel.

MELODY ROTH, CANADA

Trishamar Siberians was born in 1996 when my husband, son and I purchased two Siberian Husky females. We've been exhibiting since that time and commenced our breeding program in 1998. In addition to Siberians, I have exhibited and bred Whippets and Pomeranians though on a much smaller scale.

Some of our highlights include Best in Show littermates - MBIS Ch Trishamar's What a Star Aurora and BIS Can/Am/Hun Ch Trishamar's Whole Nine Yards. We've also had a number of specialty winners; the first was MBISS Ch Trishamar's Bacardi Select who twice won a specialty, the 2nd time as a Veteran. Another testament to our program is MBISS Can/Am Ch Trishamar's Pinball Wizard winning his first specialty as a 5-year-old and his 2nd as a Veteran.

In addition to exhibiting in conformation, I have been active in the obedience ring. Training three different Trishamar Siberians to their CD titles as well as earning a Rally Novice title on BISS Can/Am Ch Trishamar's Night of the Hunter CD RN CGN. Not to be forgotten I was also to successfully trial my Pom, Ch Jolvin's Rocket Man CD RN to 2 obedience titles.

Without intentionally trying to breed a 'working' Siberian, a number of Trishamar born dogs are running successfully on sled teams and have earned Working Dog titles.

I have been a member of the CKC since 1996 and am also a member of the Siberian Husky Club of Canada. Currently I am the President of the Siberian Husky Club of Ontario and the Show Chairperson for the Woodstock & District Canine Association.

Thanks to the Erie Shores Kennel Club for giving me this judging opportunity.

DAVID A. STRACHAN, AUSTRALIA

David's career in dogs began in 1970 when he acquired his first Boxer. As he had asked for a show quality Boxer the breeder insisted he take him to at least one show. The dog won his class and had their first "blue" ribbon. This was to influence the direction of his life for the next 48 years.

David began judging in 1987 and he is now an International all breeds judge. His International judging career has taken him to many parts of the world. He has had the privilege of judging in the following countries – England, Ireland, Canada, the USA, Sweden, Norway, Finland, Germany, Denmark, India, South Africa, New Zealand, Malaysia, Thailand, South Korea, Taiwan, Indonesia, Singapore, Russia, Japan, Hong Kong, Vietnam, China and the Philippines.

He was also NSW CC Show Dog of the Year in 1993 and Best Exhibit in Show at the Canberra Royal Show in 1992 and the Nation's #1 Boxer 1992/93/94. Grand Champion Thasrite Topless Bikini (Al) won BIS at All-Breed Championship

Shows on 26 occasions and was # 1 Boxer in Australia for 1998 and 1999 and among the top show dogs all breeds during those years. BIS/BISS Aust Grand Ch/RSA Ch Thasrite The New Yorker SOM (BOB/Group 2 Sydney Royal 2003) a winner of some 20 BIS awards (in Aust and RSA) and Australia's #1 Boxer 2003/04.

In recent years David has also been involved in the breeding and exhibition of Pugs and Labrador Retrievers.

He has also been involved for many years in dog show administration. Having been involved as show manager, club secretary and until recently all breeds dog club president for over 10 years. He has also been involved in judges training and assessment.

MONIQUE VAN BREMPT, BELGIUM

Before the Scottish and Dandie Dinmont Terriers came, Monique Van Brempt, since her childhood, was fancied and surrounded by her loving dogs: Belgian Shepherds, Dachshunds, German Shepherds and Rough Collies.

So far 23 countries are members of "The International Association of All Terrier-Clubs (FCI)". With her team she created the Asian Interra section and the Interra section of the Americans.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$62.40 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. Entries positively close 8:00 p.m. Wednesday, May 22, 2019 and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$30.00 service charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Erie Shores Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- 5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. Friday, June 7, Saturday, June 8, Sunday, June 9 and Monday, June 10, 2019. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in judging schedule.
- 6. SHOW PRECINCTS: will be 30 feet from the rings and the official areas.
- All judging will be done outdoors, unless otherwise specified. There are no provisions for inclement weather.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 4-Section 4.7.3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

GRAND CHAMPIONS AND GCH POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Section 15.2.4 The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT AND GCHX POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Section 15.3.3 A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) or a Best in Multiple-Breed Specialty with at least three (3) breeds represented plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Section 15.3.5 The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Section 15.3.6 Additional Requirements: To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

Junior Puppy – a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

Senior Puppy – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12 - 18 Months - a dog between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.

12 – 15 Months – a dog between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.

15 – 18 Months – a dog between 15 months and under 18 months on day of show.

Canadian Bred - a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner <u>and</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class – for all dogs.

Veterans – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Field Class - This class is optional at Specialty shows for breeds that have performance events in the field. Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging with winners of each sex competing for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only – dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

Stud Dog & Get: Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud Dog may be neutered.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch may be spayed.

Each entrant for Brace, Team, Stud Dog, or Brood Bitch must be entered in one of the Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. All Get and Progeny must be entered in an Official Class.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Parade of Champions, Titleholders or Veterans: Champion dogs must have completed all requirements for Championship status. Titleholders must have titles recognized by the CKC and AKC. 


