HEALTH REMINDERS:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. It is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

INFORMATION:

- If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred
- Email entries will not be accepted.
- All dogs will run individually. Lame dogs during roll call will be excused and any entry refunded.
- Slip leads recommended when starting your dogs, please bring a second lead for catchers
- Ostrich eyes are bigger than their brains.
- No Flexi-leads, or prong or electronic collars allowed.
- A \$10 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after the last event.
- All hounds will be slipped from a standing start.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs.
- Porta Potty available
- Do not stuff plastic bags down holes or in the port-a-potty.
- Please use the trash receptacles provided.
- The Event Committee will be in full charge of the events, which will be governed by CKC rules.

FIELD CONDITIONS, TIMING

- 40 acre fully fenced field
- Track might or might not be fenced
- Run Out area will be approximately 100 yards, this will not be fenced
- Stopwatches will be used, there shall be two timers positioned at the finish line. The starter shall signal the moment the nose of the dog crosses the start line. The timers shall start their stopwatches at the signal. The timers shall stop their watches when the nose of the dog crosses the finish line. The times from the two stopwatches shall be averaged to determine the recorded time.
- Continuous Loop will be used with plastic or fur lures.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB INFORMATION

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE POLICY (Effective January 1, 2011)

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$59.40, plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents Of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN):

- Effective November 1, 2019, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require a Temporary Competition number (TCN). This TCN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an TCN, go to the CKC website and register online. This number will automatically be generated once submitted and will be a 9-character registration number such as TC-AB1234567

- Flat ribbons for a qualifying time

FEMALES IN SEASON

- Females in season must wear a clean, dry, snugly fitting panties specifically designed for the purpose of preventing / containing discharge.
- Panties must be worn at all times
- It is requested that "females in season" be walked on the edge of the road away from the house.
- The host club(s) DO NOT assume any responsibility for "accidental" breeding's; it is the sole responsibility of handlers to ensure that this does not happen.

TITLES

The dog's time to complete the 100 m (328 ft) dash is converted into KPHs. The formula to complete this calculation is 360 divided by the dog's time over 100 m (328 ft). This calculation should be rounded to two decimal places.

A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 46 cm (18 in) or greater = handicap is 1.25.
- 30 cm (12 in) up to less than 46 cm (18 in) = handicap is 1.5.
- Below 30 cm (12 in) = handicap is 2.0.

7.2.3 Points = KPH multiplied by the dog's handicap. For example 20 KPH x 1.5 = 30 points. Round off points to the nearest whole number.

Sprinter Titles

- Novice Sprinter (NS) = 150 points
- Sprinter (S) = 500 points
- Advanced Sprinter (AS) = 1,000 points
- Sprinter Excellent (SX) = 1,500 points
- SE followed by a number (e.g. SX2) for every additional 500 points

Veteran Titles

- Veteran Novice Sprinter (VNS) = 75 points
- Veteran Sprinter (VS) = 250 points
- Veteran Advanced Sprinter (VAS) = 500 points
- Veteran Sprinter Excellent (VSX) = 750 points
- Veteran SE followed by a number (e.g. VSX2) for every additional 250 points

VOLUNTEERING

You can make a difference, even if you can help out for an hour or so... Easy ways to volunteer at a lure coursing field trial (and you don't even have to be an OLCA member):

Field Setup:

- Come early (one hour before roll call) and start by carrying equipment
- Learn as you go how to place pulleys and tie downs, eventually how the field is set up and how the machine works

Field Clerk:

- Volunteer to help the field clerk for even one or two breeds
- Learn how scores are tabulated and recorded – when you are comfortable with this you will be able start helping the field trial secretary
- Benefit is you will get a whole new perspective on the course and may learn by listening to the judges

Runner:

- Volunteer to run paperwork from the field clerk to the field trial secretary after each breed
- Scores can only be posted as quickly as the paperwork is delivered to the field trial secretary

Lure Operator:

- Hang around and talk to the lure operator between courses
- If you're interested, try running the lure around before the trial, at lunch, or after the trial at practice

Lunch:

- Volunteer to help set up lunch, serve and collect money

Practice:

- Give the volunteers who have been working all day a break!
- Take the practice list, call out the names and collect the money

Fundraiser:

- It's great when people donate things, but even better if you can organize and execute a fundraiser whether it be a 50/50 draw, raffle, silent auction etc – doesn't have to be complicated or too time consuming
- Feel free to do this at any OLCA trial!

To hold the Host Club including its members, directors, officers, employees and volunteers (collectively defined as "the Host Club"), as well as the owner and lessor of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.
2. To hold the Host Club harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the Host Club or any other person(s);
3.
