The following CKC regular conformation classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy: Senior Puppy: 12-18 Month: Canadian Bred: Bred by Exhibitor:	A dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of the show. A dog between 6 months and under 12 months on day of the show. A dog between 12 months and under 18 months on day of the show. A dog which is born in Canada. A dog(s) owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need
0	not handle the dog for further awards.
Open:	For all dogs.
Specials Only: Veteran:	For dogs who are Canadian Champions only. Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Veteran Female classes will NOT compete for Championship points but goes directly into the Best of Breed competition. Spayed/Neutered dogs are eligible to compete. This class will be divided into three age groups: $7 - 9$ years, $9 - 12$ years, and $12$ + years.
The following additional <b>non</b>	-regular and unofficial classes (divided by sex) will be offered:
Baby Puppy	A dog between 3 months and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. Winners of this class do not compete for points. The class is judged after breed judging.
Brace Class	Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex); neutered or spayed Samoyeds are eligible. Ownership does not need to be identical. A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered. Dogs must be entered in one of the regular Specialty classes or for Exhibition Only to participate in this class.
Team Class	Shall be for four dogs (not necessarily the same sex); neutered or spayed Samoyeds are eligible. Ownership does not need to be identical. A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered. Dogs must be entered in one of the regular Specialty classes or for Exhibition Only to participate in this class.
Stud Dog and Get	Entry into this class shall comprise the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get (Note: Get MUST be entered in a regular class, Stud Dog must be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only)
Brood Bitch and Pr	<b>ogeny</b> Shall have all the same requirements as the Stud Dog & Get Class

Sexually Altered C	Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually

altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed. Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows: Altered Male and Altered Female. Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will

be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed

Working ClassThis class shall be open for all Samoyeds 12 months of age or older who have participated in<br/>sledding, skijoring, obedience, rally obedience, agility, draft dog, herding, or weight pull. Age<br/>divisions in this class will be Adult – 12 months to 7 years; Veteran – 7 to 9 years, and 9+ years.<br/>Classes will be divided by sex.

**Note:** the winners of these classes will compete for Best Working in Specialty - they DO NOT compete for Best of Breed.

3-Generation Class This class is comprised of a minimum of THREE (3) SUCCESSIVE generations, to a maximum of four (4) successive generations, regardless of sex, exhibited from oldest to youngest. All neutered or spayed Samoyeds are eligible. Ownership does not need to be identical. Entry fee is payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> Generation only. A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered. Dogs must be entered in one of the regular Specialty classes or for Exhibition Only to participate in this class.

- No Entry Will Be Accepted Without Payment in Full. Tendering of a dishonored cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.) Any dishonoured cheque or declined credit card(s) will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made
- Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Entries by any courier <u>must be sent prepaid</u>. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

Please allow ample time for delays in the mail. Exhibitors Please Note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary not later than closing date and time. If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

# ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

## EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event</u> <u>Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you.

**Cost - \$62.40+ applicable tax.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: <u>http://www.ckc.ca</u>

### ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

**24-12-3.** Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is **\$62.40 + applicable tax.**
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by <u>Canadian resident non-CKC members</u> and are not applicable to CKC members"

\*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <u>http://www.ckc.ca</u> under <u>Events</u> and then Event forms on the drop-down menu. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

## ERRORS IN ENTRIES

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **Notice of Agreement**

The Samoyed Association of Canada reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations (8.6.1).

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to be bound by the rules and regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in this premium list.

I (we) agree to hold the Samoyed Association of Canada, their members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.

I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

- 1. All rules and regulations applying to the Alberta Kennel Club Summer Classic shows shall apply to this specialty show.
- 2. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
- 3. SHOW PRECINCTS: within 50 feet of the designated specialty ring.
- 4. DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- 5. There will be no cover provided for the Specialty ring in the event of inclement weather.

**Please note:** The show is a public event, candid photos and/or videos may be taken on the show premises. Such images may be published in print or on a web-site without your consent. By entering this dog show, you waive all rights to such images and agree that the Alberta Kennel shall not be held responsible for their use.

## **MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS**

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of closing of entries for the show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner/handler at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show. When one or more all-breed championship shows and/or specialty shows are held on the same date in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Conformation Show Rules and Regulations (19.7)

Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules

Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show Section

**8.2.5** An error in an age specified class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. **Section 8.3.1** Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

a) registered with the CKC,

b) have an Event Registration Number,

c) be eligible for registration with the CKC, or

d) if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

b) that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;

c) that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC.

d) that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtain from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

Section 84.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

**Section 8.5.1** Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs. Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted,

cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may: a) decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or

b) refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on

account of disease or viciousness.

c) in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for nonacceptance.

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

Section 8.9.2 If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the moving of class dogs to Specials must be made prior to the scheduled opening of the first show.

**Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3** A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.2 (a) At his discretion, a judge shall have the authority to excuse or disqualify a dog which menaces, threatens, attempts to bite or bites the judge, another person, or another dog in the ring. When a dog is twice excused on this account, it shall have the status of a disqualified dog. (b) At his discretion, a judge shall have the authority to permanently disqualify a dog which bites the judge or another person in the ring. Dogs disqualified under this provision will not be eligible for reinstatement. The decision to permanently disqualify a dog must be clearly indicated on the Judge's Disqualification Form.

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. A dog disqualified under section 14.1.2 (b) is not eligible for reinstatement. Section 14.1.5 Any dog that is disqualified under section 14.1.2(a) shall automatically be disqualified from entering in any CKC event in any other discipline until such time as the dog is officially reinstated, if the dog is eligible for reinstatement.

#### **Championship Points and Cancellations**

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 -5	6-9	10-12	13 & more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

Section 15.1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners was also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total.

Section 15.1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. Section 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

**Clarification:** Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.

Section 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show:

Section 15.1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

Section 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an allbreed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

(a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 judges; and,
(b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event

Registration Number.

(c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.
