Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone <u>but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time.</u> If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show

JUVENILE / VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in both Sweepstakes. 25% of the entry fees shall be retained by the club for expenses, with the remaining entry money divided as follows:

First in each class - 50% of entry fee for that class. Rosette and 15% for Best in Sweepstakes.

Rosette and 10% for Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

All dogs must be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete in Veterans' Sweepstakes.

The following classes will be offered (divided by sex):

7 - 10 years 10-13 years 13 years & older

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

All dogs in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular Official Classes at this Specialty. The following classes will be offered (divided by sex):

6-9 months 9-12 months 12-18 months

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered. Classes will be divided by sex and broken down 7-10 years, 10-13 years, 13 years and older.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

WORKING	For any dog who has attained any CKC Working Title, American Working Terrier Association, (CKC recognized) Certificate of Gameness, or an American Kennel Club Junior Earthdog, Senior Earthdog or Master Earthdog title. Spayed or neutered dogs may compete.
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.

Special Events

Following the judging of the Specialty, we will have two "FUN" events: Best Otter Head and Breeders Class.

Best Otter Head competition is open to any dog entered in the Specialty. Our judge, Nina Karlsdotter, will select which Border Terrier among those present, has the most typical "Otter Head". A rosette and trophy will be awarded.

Breeder's Class: The breeder of record enters a team with a minimum of three and a maximum of five dogs, without distinction as to gender. The entrant must be the breeder of record for all exhibits. Note: it is not required that the breeder of record be the current owner. All dogs entered must be a minimum of 6 months of age - spayed and neutered dogs are eligible. Breeders may enter more than one team. Each team will be judged as a unit, standing and moving to determine their overall quality, consistency and similarity, breed type and conformation to the breed standard. Awards will be presented to Best Breeder's Team and Reserve Best Breeder's Team.

Border Essentials: open to all Border Terriers present, regardless of whether they are entered in the Specialty or not. Perhaps your Border Terrier doesn't have the greatest head but maybe he has a wonderful carrot tail, or a hide and pelt to swoon over, so enter him for his strength and don't worry about the less than perfect parts. A team of Conformation and Earthdog Judges will collaborate in determining which dogs have the most characteristic ribs, heads, tails, hides (pelts) and gait.

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.</u>
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border...

To (re)enter the U.S. the rabies certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to the date of crossing unless you have proof of continuous vaccination.

As requirements in respect to puppies have changed, we recommend verifying with the appropriate government web site when planning your trip.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
- 2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7
- 5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

Attention Canadian Exhibitors!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$57.60 + 5% GST.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is** \$58.50 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. BORDER TERRIER CANADA ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

(adapted with permission from the Border Terrier Club of America Room Policy)

Border Terrier Canada (BTC) has adopted the following rules in order to insure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future:

Any individual attending a Border Terrier Canada (BTC) sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all of the following actions by the BTC Board of Directors.

- 1. May be banned from showing at the next BTC sanctioned event(s).
- 2. May be subject to CKC sanctions.
- Membership in the BTC may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

Damages shall be defined as:

- Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.).
- 2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground.
- 3. Any verified complaint by a BTC member.

BTC Room Regulations:

- All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog.
- Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel or campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
- No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms. A grooming room will be available whenever possible.
- Dogs are to be allowed on hotel furniture/beds ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.
- All owners/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 20 - Dog Show Rules: Champions and Championship Points

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these dog show rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder:

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	•					15 or more
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}includes dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of championship points by a dog awarded WINNERS, total of all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with Championship Certificate the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at a breed or group level. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges, and be Individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a C.K.C. EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN) and have 1 two point win from the Breed or Group level.
