

Judges Biographies

Conformation



Mr. Roger Hartinger

Roger Hartinger, of Cincinnati, Ohio, has been involved with dogs since early childhood, his family having had a German Shepherd Dog and a Wire Fox Terrier. While at college, he obtained a Great Dane, a breed he continued to own after marriage. Mr. Hartinger first bred and exhibited Standard Schnauzers, most of which he finished to championships, and later bred Lakeland Terriers. He began exhibiting in 1965, and both he and his wife, Paula, were AKC Licensed Handlers.

Mr. Hartinger is an all-breed judge who ranks his Working Group assignments at the first two AKC/Eukanuba shows among the highlights of his judging career. A life member of the Clermont County and Cincinnati kennel clubs, Mr. Hartinger has served both organizations as president and show chairman. He is a board member of the Dog Judges Association of America and a founding member of the OKI Dog Judges Workshop. Mr. Hartinger has held memberships in many other clubs, including the American Miniature Schnauzer Club, the Buckeye Associated Specialty Clubs (past president), and the Standard Schnauzer Club of America (past president and show chairman). Mr. Hartinger was an AKC delegate for fifteen years, serving as chairman of the nominating committee among other committee appointments. He thanks his wife of over 50 years and all-breed judging partner, Paula, for having a profound influence on his life.



Mrs. Paula Hartinger

Paula Hartinger, of Cincinnati, Ohio, is half of one of dogdom's best-known husband-and-wife teams. "When I first met my husband, Roger, it was predestined that I would become involved in purebred dogs," she says. "When we were dating, we went to dog shows and kennels. Many times our chaperone on dates was Roger's Great Dane!" The Hartingers began breeding and exhibiting dogs in the late 1950s, first Basset Hounds, then Standard Schnauzers and Lakeland Terriers. They finished several Standard Schnauzer champions and have mentored other exhibitors. Mrs. Hartinger was a professional handler of note, guiding many dogs to championships.

An AKC judge with more than 30 years' experience, Mrs. Hartinger's major assignments have been "just too many to single out a few," but she refers to the AKC/Eukanuba National Championship as "a true highlight." She is approved for all sporting, hound, terrier, toy, non-sporting, and herding breeds, most of the Working Group, Juniors, and Best in Show. Mrs. Hartinger is past president of both the Standard Schnauzer and Miniature Schnauzer clubs of Cincinnati. She has served as show chairman for the Standard Schnauzer Club of America national specialty, the Clermont County Kennel Club (life member), and the Standard Schnauzer Club of Cincinnati, and as show secretary of the Cincinnati Kennel Club (life member).



Mr. Harto Stockmari

Harto began breeding Australian Terriers in 1969 under his prefix Sassatown. He also breeds Deerhound and Poodles and has experience with Cairn Terrier, Irish wolfhound, Pekingese, Pomeranians, Shar Pei, and Finnish Lapphund over the past four decades. His first Best In Show winning Australian Terrier was in Finland, FIN & NOR CH Taralee Bobby Dazzler (Aust imp) in 1980's. In 2009 he sent Stranger's Blue Buick to Australia. He came back one year later as Aust Ch and is also CIB & Aust & Fin & Multi CH with 15 titles. Buick was the first European import to receive the title AUST CH in the country of origin. Harto was the first Australian Terrier breeder to be given the Vuolasvirta award and he has also been awarded Turunmaa Kennel Association's silver medal, Finnish Kennel Club's pennant and SUKOKA Breeder's Award for being the first person to breed Australian Terriers in Finland. He has judged internationally and is looking forward to his appointment at the Purina Pro Plan Sydney Royal Dog Show and returning to Australia. He is an Economist, married to Tanya Ahlman-Stockmari who is also a Judge and has a daughter Nora.



Mrs. Irene Latchford

I have been involved with dogs since 1992. I breed and exhibit Shetland Sheepdogs under the prefix of Nitelatches Perm Reg. I have been judging since 2007. I served on the board of the CKC as the Zone 7 Representative for Junoir Handling. I also hold an executive position for an All Breed Club.



Mr. Murray Eason

My journey in purebred dogs start in 1984 with the purchase of a white miniature poodle, the rest as they say is history. I have bred all three varieties of poodles under the Belcourt prefix as well as whippets in partnership under the Poseidon kennel prefix. I have produced many Best in Show poodles as well as top performance dogs. I am happy to say that this year I bred the number two all breed obedience dog in the country. My journey continues as a licensed Canadian Kennel Club judge, licensed for both the Toy and Non Sporting groups. I am currently on permit for 1/2 of the working group. I would like to take this opportunity to wish everyone a great show weekend and wish you all much success with your beloved companions

Mr. Lionel Whittaker

I have been involved in the sport of competitive obedience for the past 20 years. During that time I have been fortunate enough to train and trial four exceptional Labrador Retrievers. I actively campaigned for 3 years with two dogs (MOTCH Denmoney Black Eyed Kate SH WCX in 2004 and MOTCH Denmoney Abby of Carnmoney JH WCI in 2005 and 2006). Kate, who retired from competition in 2004, finished that year ranked #1 Obedience Labrador, #4 Sporting breed and #6 All-Breed Obedience dog in Canada. Abby was ranked #2 Obedience Labrador in Canada in 2004 and #1 Obedience Labrador in 2005 and 2006.

While the majority of my ring experience has been in the regular classes, I have trained and handles my dogs in both the brace and team classes. In addition to Obedience and Rally

Obedience, I am also licensed to judge all levels of Hunt Tests and Working Certificate Tests and am a member of both the Obedience and Working Certificate councils and the Appeal Committee.



Mrs. Carolyn Wray

My name is Carolyn Wray and I live in Oregon with three Miniature Poodles and one oversize Toy Poodle; the gang and I participate in AKC events including obedience, rally, agility and tracking. I have done conformation and herding as well. All my dogs are spoiled house pets and they all sleep on the bed.

I grew up in a dog show family and earned my first CD in 1966 (I was still in grade school). I am an AKC obedience and rally judge (all levels).

I have titled and loved a variety of breeds including Keeshonden, Shelties, Doberman, Pekingese, and Poodles. Achieving a CDX title on my beloved Peke, Kenny, is one of my fondest memories. His registered name was Wraynbow Unique CDX and he was indeed unique; I miss him to this day.

In addition to many years of showing, I have also written many articles on dog sports, most specifically obedience and rally. I have contributed to such magazines as the Poodle Club of America's "Poodle Papers," the Versatility in Poodles quarterly newsletter and the now defunct, Kee Topics.

I bring a varied background to the ring every time I judge and this experience gives me a balanced perspective both as a judge and as an exhibitor. I enjoy every assignment. Being a performance judge is the best hobby you can have!

You may only Obedience/ Rally O bench ringside if you have paid/reserved benching, NO exceptions. Please note the size of the spaces, and ensure that you reserve the number of spaces required.

There will be no Conformation benching at ringside, reserved Conformation benching/grooming space will only be available in designated Conformation benching/grooming area.

Once benching is sold out, no further reservations will be taken. Rules and Regulations

GENERAL INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

Dogs should be in the building at least one hour prior to ring time. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of the posted schedule and be at ringside at the time of judging. The club will not call individual dogs to ringside. Please remain at ringside until judging is completed. A practice ring will be set up in the benching area. Regular rings must not be used for this purpose. Dogs must be exercised in the areas provided, anyone exercising their dogs on the grounds outside the building and not cleaning up after them, will be excluded from the show or trial.

Exhibitors are reminded to respect hospitality facilities. The Red Deer & District Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse future entries from any exhibitor who creates excessive destructive or disruption to host facilities (Hotel, motel or campground). The show superintendent is in complete charge of the shows and trials which, are governed by CKC rules. No judge or any other person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under CKC rules shall be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the show. The Show Committee has a responsibility to see that this rule is enforced. Chapter 19.7, Page 55, CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations.

The Dog Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune. The Red Deer and District Kennel Club reserves the right to remove from the shows or trials any person or dog for any just cause. Any dog excused by the show superintendent or veterinarian, for any reason, shall not compete in any classes or accept any awards for the duration of the shows or trials. No refund of any fees will be made.

If because of riot, civil disturbance, or any other acts beyond the control of the show committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds shall be made!

EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES - BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED:

12.2.1 Regular official classes at a CKC conformation show shall be as described in (a) to (k) of this section. All classes must be divided by sex (except for Specials Only). Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs at least six months of age and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs 9 months of age and under twelve (12) months of age on the day of the show.

12-18 MONTH - for dogs over 12 months of age but under 18 months of age.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

UNOFFICIAL/NON-REGULAR CLASSES OFFERED

BABY PUPPY Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female
Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

VETERAN In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran, Best Veteran in Breed, Best Veteran in Group, Best Veteran in Show. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

BRACE At an all-breed or specialty show a club may, but is not required to, offer a Brace Class. This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

RESERVE BEST IN SHOW: will be selected from the remaining 6 Breeds competing for BIS

OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED:

Novice A, Novice B, Novice C, Novice Intermediate Open HA, Open HB, Open 18A, Open 18B, Utility A, Utility B, Pre -Novice, Exhibition Only,

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED:

Novice A & Novice B, Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Masters, Exhibition Only

See **OBEDIENCE & RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS** for complete information on classes.

CHAPTER 4 – JUDGES

SECTION 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Entries sent by Greyhound must be sent prepaid; To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

Exhibitors Please Note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but **written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary not later than closing date and time.** If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Rally/Obedience comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary **before the starting date and the time of the trial.** The Red Deer and District Kennel Club will refund entry, recording and listing fees if the above conditions are met. No Refunds will be given for the service fees provided by the dogshow.ca

A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a Veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Show Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Show Superintendent to verify she is in season.

There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments.

Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules

Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show Section

8.2.5 An error in an age specified class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

- a) registered with the CKC,
- b) have an Event Registration Number,
- c) be eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d) if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- b) that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- c) that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC.
- d) that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtain from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

Section 8.4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

Section 8.5.1 Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

- a) decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
- b) refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.
- c) in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

Section 8.9.2 If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the moving of class dogs to Specials must be made prior to the scheduled opening of the first show.

Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.2 (a) At his discretion, a judge shall have the authority to excuse or disqualify a dog which menaces, threatens, attempts to bite or bites the judge, another person, or another dog in the ring. When a dog is twice excused on this account, it shall have the status of a disqualified dog.

(b) At his discretion, a judge shall have the authority to permanently disqualify a dog which bites the judge or another person in the ring. Dogs disqualified under this provision will not be eligible for reinstatement. The decision to permanently disqualify a dog must be clearly indicated on the Judge's Disqualification Form.

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until

the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. A dog disqualified under section 14.1.2 (b) is not eligible for reinstatement.

Section 14.1.5 Any dog that is disqualified under section 14.1.2(a) shall automatically be disqualified from entering in any CKC event in any other discipline until such time as the dog is officially reinstated, if the dog is eligible for reinstatement.

Championship Points and Cancellations

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 & more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

**Includes the dog awarded Winners.*

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

Section 15.1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners was also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total.

Section 15.1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.

Section 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show:

Section 15.1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

Section 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 judges; and,
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number.
- (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.


