Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to <a href="https://www.ckc.ca">www.ckc.ca</a> under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January — December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.

#### **GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION**

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept entries reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list.

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES.

TELEPHONE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

It is your responsibility to verify the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date.

Noteworthy Farm Show Services reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Dog Show Rules.

Identification cards and judging schedule will be mailed / emailed as soon as possible after entries close.

Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and the New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC, has ruled that where a conflict arises between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules that the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.

Changes or cancellation of any entry after closing date is prohibited. In the event that the dog is absent, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, disqualified, or barred from competition by action of the bench Committee, no entry fees will be refunded.

To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loudspeaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.

Only dogs eligible for registration with CKC may enter this show and trial. Canine Companion Numbers Accepted for trials and performance events.

Miramichi Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entries, subject to CKC rules.

#### **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- 1. send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
- Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

#### **TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER**

(\* EFFECTIVE MARCH 2, 2020)

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN.

A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN)

There is no fee to obtain a TCN, however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly.

\* Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. \*

If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

A TCN is required to enter the BABY PUPPY CLASS, however, listing fees do not apply to baby puppies.

#### **CONFORMATION CLASSES**

**Baby Puppy** A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show. **Junior Puppy** A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show. **Senior Puppy** A dog 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show.

**12-18 Months** A dog 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show.

Canadian Bred A dog which was born in Canada.

**Bred by Exhibitor** A dog owned and handled by the breeder.

Open Class A dog 6 months of age or older

Specials Only Dogs who are Canadian Champions.

**Sexually Altered.** Spayed or neutered dog over 6 Months of age **Veteran** A dog 7 years of age or older

#### **Championship Points**

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 +
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

## A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group. A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. 15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch.

Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh: Select dog = # of regular class dogs + # of specials dogs – 1, Select Bitch = # of regular class bitches + # of specials bitches – 1.

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

**Grand Champion Silver (GChS)** The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only

accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles, (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.

#### **Altered Championship Points**

Champions & Championship Points 13.8.1 Championship points will be awarded as per Chapter 15, with the exception of 15.1.11. The winner of an Altered Best in Show shall be awarded points according to the total number of dogs in competition following the point schedule in Section 15.1.2.

The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).



#### **TEST INFORMATION**

The tests will follow Rules & Regulations effective January 1, 2024

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Tests are open to all purebred Dachshunds and those Terriers in Group IV and on the Miscellaneous list seeking eligibility for Group IV that are small enough to fit into a 9 inch drain. Spayed, neutered and debarked dogs are eligible to participate. Dogs must be six (6) months or older.

#### **TESTS**

Introduction to Quarry (IQ – Not an official CKC Test) This test is a simple instinct test requiring no training or previous exposure to earthwork. Young dogs with no previous working experience and novice handlers are encouraged to enter. Open to all eligible dogs that have not completed requirements for a JE title or higher title.

Novice Earthdog (NE – optional) – This test is designed to provide a titling option for those dogs that are not yet ready for Junior but who have mastered the requirements for Introduction to Quarry. It is an elective test and dogs are not required to attain a Novice Earthdog title prior to entering Junior. The Novice Earthdog class is open to dogs who have not previously earned an Earthdog title. A dog may not enter Novice Earthdog and another regular class in the same test.

**Junior Earthdog (JE)** Open to all eligible dogs. A dog that has completed the requirements for JE is not required to move up to the next level but may no longer compete in IQ.

**Senior Earthdog (SE)** Open to dogs that have completed the requirements for the CKC Junior Earthdog title. A dog that has completed the requirements for SE is not required to move up to the

next level.he quarry used in these tests will be two live rats.

Fencing will be placed around the IQ, Novice, Junior, and Senior test locations.

## GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. If you pay by personal American cheque, it must be made out for the full amount of the

entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Do not write "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". This is not acceptable and will not clear the bank. To simplify the process, we urge you to buy bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Or use DogShow.ca.

**BORDER CROSSING:** A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate, and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Canadian Food Inspection Agency regulations can be viewed at:

**EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (Foreign Born/Owned Dogs):** For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born/owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering a first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a

photocopy of the dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (Canadian funds) along with the completed application form. The form can be downloaded from www.ckc.ca/forms or from the CKC Order Desk at 1-800- 250-8040.

**REGULATIONS:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC *Earthdog Test Rules & Regulations* are available from the Canadian Kennel Club at 1-800-250-8040 and online at www.ckc.ca

**CKC REGULATION 15.7:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred

**CKC Non-member Participation Fee:** An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a CANADIAN non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to become a CKC member or pay the non- members participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

**MOVE UPS:** Move ups are permissible one (1) hour before the class provided that the dog is not already entered in that test.

**CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY:** The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a return e-mail address on their form.

**AWARDS:** Qualifiers in the Introduction to Quarry, Novice, Junior, Senior Earthdog tests will receive rosettes.

**TEST PRECINCT:** The precinct of this test will be the marked section of Noteworthy Farm, Cross Creek, NB. Dogs waiting to be tested shall be kept at least 30.5 m (100ft) from the perimeter of the test area in a designated holding area.

**VALIDATION OF ENTRIES:** Entries must be complete, with entry fees, signed including Participation Agreement. Entries submitted without this agreement filled in and signed will be refused participation in the tests.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be

eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the test, must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The trial-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

You are responsible for reading the club waiver (attached) which you will electronically sign with your online entry. Your helper (if you bring one) must complete a paper waiver and bring it to the tests (or email it to <a href="mailto:patrickmudge2@yahoo.ca">patrickmudge2@yahoo.ca</a> beforehand). You are responsible for calculating/checking your own points and knowing if your dog has achieved any titles. Your dog's Sprinter points (earned \*after\* August 28, 2019) are now available on your CKC online portal. The calculations and handicaps are available via the Sprinter Rules & Regulations from the CKC website at:

#### On arrival for your scheduled time slot:

 When you arrive, go to the main check-in station for the lameness and in-season inspection. You will need to swab your bitch with a tissue for in-season check and all entries may also be measured to determine their handicap. <u>AS OF Jan 1, 2024,</u> <u>bitches in season are permitted to enter these test but must wear clean, dry, snugly fitting panties specifically designed</u>

- for the purpose of preventing/containing discharge. Bitches in season will run at the end of the day.
- 2. Have your dog's name added to the running order. Two to three dogs before your run, proceed to the start line waiting area with your dog and have your Catcher (which maybe you or your helper) proceed directly to the finish line with a leash. \*Catchers CANNOT wait at the start line then walk/run down the chute when their dog steps to the start line for their turn. The Catcher must ALREADY be at the finish line and ready to catch the dog as the dog steps to the start line with their Releaser.\* Dogs may run "naked" or wear a flat, snug-fitting buckle catch collar with nothing hanging from it that can become entangled in the line (NO running in martingale or slip collars and NO tags on catch collars). You may walk your dog to the start line in a martingale, slip collar or harness, but it MUST be removed prior to releasing them.
- Once your dog runs and is caught and leashed, clear the chute area, and prepare for their second run. For safety reasons, please stay CLEAR of the chute when walking your dog back from the finish line.
- 4. Once you have completed your entered runs per dog, collected your ribbons and times from the table, and taken your photos, please feel free to stay and enjoy the day at Noteworthy Farm, have lunch at the Woodsmoke Café and cheer on your friends. There are other events you might want to participate in.

#### OTHER EVENT INFORMATION

You will need to crate your dog in/by your car. There will be no shade provided so please keep your dog cool by keeping windows open, using shade cloths, and providing fresh water (Water is available on site). There's plenty of room for pop-up tents.

All competitors must bring \*TWO\* leashes, one each for the Releaser and Catcher. A slip leash is ideal for the Catcher. You may bring your own helper to act as your Catcher or Releaser. If you are not bringing a helper, you may list another exhibitor as your helper or request that a club volunteer release your dog. This information will be gathered in a form via email ~2 weeks before the tests.

Also, Noteworthy Farm would appreciate and will post any event pics/candids anyone wishes to share. (again to <a href="mailto:patrickmudge2@yahoo.ca">patrickmudge2@yahoo.ca</a>)

Please ask for help when getting your title and Q ribbons from the checkin table. There are different rosettes for each Sprinter title and club members will help you get the right one.

There will be a "photo booth" set up near the parking area with title/event boards. Feel free to take some pictures of your dog with their ribbons.

\*\*Miramichi Kennel Club and Noteworthy Farm will be following all current federal, provincial, and local COVID rules at the time of the tests

\*\* Further information, if required, will be emailed to participants with the running orders prior to the event

**Important Notes:** Please respect instructions, pick up after and maintain control of your dog. Retractable leads, prong collars, and electronic collars are not allowed on the premises. Owners may have their dog wear a muzzle, if they desire. Dogs may run "naked" or wear a flat, snug-fitting buckle catch collar with nothing hanging from it that can become entangled in the line. You may walk your dog to the start line in a martingale, slip collar or harness, but it MUST be removed prior to releasing them. There is a risk of injury for all active sports; you can reduce this risk by warming up and cooling down your dog, only running your dog when you feel the field and weather are appropriate and staying aware of your environment and any safety hazards. A \$10 fine, payable to Miramichi Kennel Club will be levied for any dog loose on the field from the time of inspection until the completion of all events for the day. A \$10 fine, payable to Noteworthy Farm will be levied for any exhibitor not picking up after their dog. Events run rain or shine.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Sprinter Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club online or via mail. Tel: 1-800-250-8040.

**CKC Regulation:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Test Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

ERRORS IN RECORDED RESULTS: The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).

Eligibility: Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age that are: (a) Individually registered with the CKC, (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN), (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN), (d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, or (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed. PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary

action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

**Awards and Prizes:** Qualifiers will receive flat ribbons. Rosettes will be provided for dogs achieving a title during these events. **Entries accepted through dogshow.ca ONLY.** 

Day-of entries will be accepted if limits limits are not reached.

Day-of entry fee will be \$25.00 per dog per event.

Entries close when the 75 dog limit is reached

- Splashes include up to three minutes on the dock for one optional practice jump and two judged jumps. You must inform the judge prior to your jump if you want it to be considered a "practice jump".
- This event is an **Open Splash** event. This is done at Portable Dock trials and other shows that have timing conflicts with other dog events. The time for each splash for the day will be set such as 9am for example for all the splashes. You have between the posted start time and end time (either before AR starts or the end of the last day, usually 3pm) to complete your splashes for the day. When you check in you will be handed "Splash Cards" for each splash that you pay for. When you are ready to jump during the day, hand a splash card to the wrangler to get put into the running order. It is the handler's responsibility to be sure to be present it before their turn to jump. Please be aware that at many events, the running order board fills very quickly and early in the day.

- Please Note: You must pay for all pre registered splashes at time of check-in. Any splashes not paid for will be put back into the event's on-site registration availability list and result in a no-show. If you are registering multiple dogs there will be a no-show for each dog. You are responsible for all pre-registered splashes.
- Each distance jumping Splash allows 2 judged jumps, back to back. The longest jump of them will be your Qualifying Score.
- You can earn a <u>Diving Dog Title</u> at this event.
