LOCATION AND SPECIFICATIONS

- These Events will take place at GUIDES CANINS, 1200A montée Poirier, St-Lazare, J7T 0L7.

- Conformation, Obedience, Rally, Agility will be held indoors, on synthetic grass. Scent will be held indoors and outdoors depending on the classes. The Dock Diving will be held in an indoor inground pool. The Barn Hunt will be held indoors in the old building. The Sprinter and the WAE will be held outside, in the field. The Heart and Eye clinics will be held in the Complexe.

- These trials are being held under the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) regulations.
- Indoor ring fences are 24 inches high and have aluminium uprights with a mesh curtain.
- The rings are side by side but an opaque partition separates them.
- The Rally ring is 40'X50', the obedience ring is 30'X40', the agility ring is 80'X120'.
- All agility obstacles are conform to CKC specifications. The Contact obstacles are Galican Soft Line and tunnels are Galican Fullgrip. An electronic timer will be used for all the events.

ELIGIBILITY

- Doberman only for the Conformation, Rally, Obedience, Scent, WAE.
- All Breed (pure breed, unrecognized breed, mixed breed - must be individually registered with the CKC or eligible for CKC registration) for Agility and Sprinter.
- All Breed for Dockdiving (need to be registered with NADD) and Rats Sports (must be registered with Rats Canada).
- Dogs that are foreign-born and owned who enter Canada for the sole purpose of competing in CKC events do not require a CKC registration number, but do require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event.
- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the award/titles earned, the non-member will have the choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. These fees apply only for dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

REGISTRATION, FEES & PAYMENTS

- Conformation, Obedience, Rally, Scent, Rat Sports, Sprinter: Entries are online via <https://dogshow.ca/en/>

- Dock Diving Entries are on line via [NADD](#)
- Competitors, through the submission of entries, acknowledge that they know the CKC rules. www.ckc.ca and the rules of the sport they are entering
- Entries are limited. We reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- In the event that the entry limit is reached before the official closing date, an Alternate List will be compiled in the order received. Alternate dogs will be allowed to run in the place of any absent dogs. Alternate dogs which are not able to run shall have the entry fees refunded.
- In Scent, Handler/dog teams may enter one, two or all three components. A handler may enter a maximum of 1 dog in a given component.
- The the classes's price, please refer to the registration form or services.
- Dogs with Temporary Competition Numbers (TNC) will be charged \$10.50 per class
- There shall be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such a dismissal or in the event of inclement weather.
- Participants canceling before the closing date will obtain a refund.
- A refund will be issued for bitches that come into heat or dogs and/or handlers that are injured, providing that they send a doctor or a veterinarian note and that the trial secretary is advised at least 24 hours before the time of the registration of the first day of the trial.
- Any refund issued will be minus administrative fees.

PROCEDURE

- A confirmation email will be sent after the closing date.
- An email with general instructions and running orders will be sent.
- The Rally course maps will be available on site.

- The Agility course maps will be sent by email two hours before the test starts and will be posted on site.
- All dogs that run Sprinter must be present for Roll Call (before each event) to be checked for lameness and bitches in season. Handlers meeting will follow completion of the 1st roll call.
- Dogs who have earned a title may advance to a higher level provided that the secretary is notified in writing (you have to fill out a move up form) as soon as the results are published or before the end of the day.
- Same day move ups are accepted.
- The results will be posted onsite, on Dog Show.ca and sent by email as soon as possible.
- A ribbon will be awarded to each team earning a qualifying score.
- Placement rosettes will be awarded from 1st to 4th place.
- Title ribbons will be awarded for each title.

GUIDES CANINS AGILITY HALL CLEANLINESS POLICY

- You must bring clean shoes and change them before entering the Agility Hall.
- Soiled shoes or boots must be left outside the Hall.
- An 'OOPS' fee of \$10 per incident will automatically be billed to the account of the owner of a dog who urinates, marks, defecates, vomits or bleeds in the Hall.
- It is forbidden to consume food, gum or drinks (other than water) in the Hall.
- Please empty the remainder of your dog's water bowl into the water bowl, sinks, toilets or outside the building and please do not pour it onto the Hall mat.

JUDGES BIOGRAPHIES

Linda Krukar - DPCC National



Thank you to the DPCC club members for selecting me to judge your National Specialty. I've always enjoyed showing in Canada, and after many years away, am excited for the honor of returning Canada to judge my favorite breed. Linda began her journey in dogs in 1980 after purchasing her first show Doberman. Over the years she became successful as a breeder and owner handler in conformation, agility and obedience, winning over 70 Bests in Shows, hundreds of Group Firsts, and more than 70 Specialties. She's had three Top 20 Conformation winners (2 owner handled), bred an OTCH and Top 20 Obedience winner, dual Champions, won numerous National Specialties with her Doberman and German Pinschers, piloting both breeds to number one rankings. In addition, she also accomplished ranking her Doberman to #1 in the 2016 Agility Top 20 and 2nd in the AKC Agility Invitational. She's been fortunate to win BIS at some of the largest and most prestigious shows in the country, was nominated for Best Owner handler, and in 2007 her dog was awarded the Purina Champions Cup. She's been judging for over 26 years, and during that time has been fortunate to be selected 4 times by the club membership to judge the DPCA National Specialty and the Regional, and has judged Top 20 Conformation, and National Specialties around the world.

Judging and running agility has given her the opportunity to learn about many wonderful breeds. Discussion with breeders, owners, friends, and interactions with their dogs are essential to a judge's education. Everyone loves to talk about their breed, so she takes advantage of their enthusiasm to learn as much as she can. She feels that having a sense of humor and empathy in the show ring is important too. Everyone can enjoy themselves when a judge understands the pressures of breeding and exhibiting. She previously worked at the American Kennel Club in Manhattan holding numerous responsibilities including writing the manual for new breed applicants for AKC recognition, served on the DPCA Board of Directors and has been their AKC Delegate. In addition she's authored numerous articles and booklets on the Doberman and German Pinscher standard, conducting judging seminars, as well as serving as a mentor.

She remains active in Conformation and Agility, has two Dobermans and two German Pinschers at home, and a wonderful husband of 49 years that tirelessly keeps everything running smoothly...

John Schoeneman - DPCGM Regional and WAE



For forty-four years I have had the great pleasure of sharing a home with several special Doberman Pinschers, which I have shown, bred, trained, handled, and loved. DPCC CLASSES - Divided by Sex

- Regular Classes: Junior (6-9), Senior (9-12), 12-18 mos, Canadian Bred, Bred By Exhibitor, Open Black, Open AOAC, Veteran, Specials Only, and Sexually Altered
- Non Regular Classes: Baby Puppy, Brace, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Parade of Title Holders, Parade of Veterans and Parade of Rescues & Exhibition only
- Obedience Classes: Pre-Novice, Novice A/B, Novice Intermediate, Open A/B, Utility A/B
- Rally Classes: Novice A/B, Intermediate, Advanced A/B, Excellent A/B, Master

Note: Dogs entered in a Non Regular or unofficial class (excluding Baby Puppy) must also be entered in one of the official classes or Exhibition Only. If entered in unofficial classes, spayed/neutered dogs must be entered in Veterans Class or Exhibition Only

DPCC TROPHIES AND ROSETTES

Trophies and Rosettes are offered by the members of the Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best Puppy, Best of Winners, Best Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch

Award of Merit: One rosette will be offered for every ten dogs competing at Best of Breed level, awards of merit will be presented at the discretion of the judge.

Trophies shall be offered for all first place class winners in all classes in conformation, obedience and rally with the exception of Pre-novice and Parades. Each "Parade" entry will receive a rosette. Rosettes shall be offered for 1st-4th in Conformation, Obedience and Rally, qualifying rosettes are offered for each obedience and rally entry who qualifies. The Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada offers an annual perpetual trophy for Best of Breed, High in Trial Obedience and High Qualifying Score in Trial Rally with a keeper trophy to be given to each of these winners. In the event of a tie score in Obedience the winner will be determined by a runoff; in the event of a tie score in Rally, the highest class level will be deemed the winner.

DPCC PERPETUAL TROPHIES

DPCC Best of Breed: Troll Arabesque/Vintage Year: The Troll Arabesque/Vintage Year Memorial Trophy is offered each year by the Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada for Best in Specialty. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. A keeper trophy will be awarded to the winner.

DPCC High in Trial Trophy: The High in Trial Trophy is offered each year by the Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada for High in Trial. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. A keeper trophy will be awarded to the winner.

DPCC HQS Rally Trophy:

The Am/Can Ch. Holmrún's Bo Coup CDX, RE, CGN, ROM-C, ROM Memorial Trophy is offered each year by the Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada for High Qualifying Score in the National Rally Trial. In the event of a tie the trophy will be awarded to the class of higher difficulty. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. A keeper trophy will be awarded to the winner.

DPCGM TROPHIES AND ROSETTES

Trophies and Rosettes are offered by the members of the Doberman Pinscher Club of Greater Montreal for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best Puppy, Best of Winners, Best Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch & First in each class. Rosettes will be awarded for all placements in the regular classes.

Award of Merit: One rosette and trophy will be offered for every ten dogs competing at Best of Breed level, awards of merit will be presented at the discretion of the judge.

Trophies shall be offered for all first place class winners in all classes in Conformation, Obedience and Rally with the exception of Pre-Novice.

Rosettes shall be offered for First to Fourth in Conformation, Obedience and Rally, qualifying rosettes are offered for each obedience and rally entry who qualifies.

Obedience: A Trophy and Rosette will be awarded for the Highest Scoring Doberman in Trial

DPCGM PERPETUAL TROPHY

DPCGM Best of Breed: The Best of Breed Memorial trophy is offered each year by the Doberman Pinscher Club of Greater Montreal in memory of Françoise Allard of Fabert Dobermans. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. A keeper trophy will be awarded to the winner.




