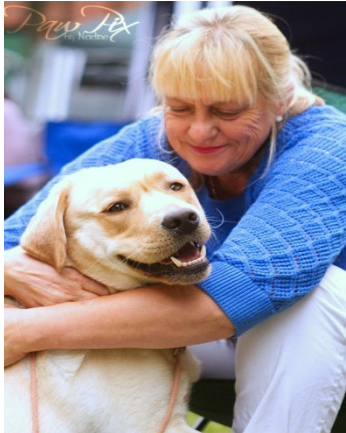

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

- Baby Puppy..... for dogs 3 months of age but under 6 months of age *These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points but they may compete in Sweepstakes if a 3-6 months class is offered.*
- Junior Puppy for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
- Senior Puppy for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
- 12-15 Months for dogs 12 months of age but under 15 months of age
- 15-18 Months..... for dogs 15 months of age but under 18 months of age
- Canadian Bred for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
- Bred By Exhibitor for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder
- Open for all dogs. **Divided by colour – Black, Yellow, Chocolate.**
- Veteran for any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. **DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED. Divided by age - 7-9 yrs., 9-12 yrs., 12 yrs & over.**
- Specials Only dogs which are registered individually, in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN number and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC, but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a 'listed' dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
- Exhibition Only for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club
- Exhibition Only
(3-6 months) puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only (3-6 Months) **provided the Owner has also entered an eligible dog in a Regular class. Puppies in this category may enter and compete in Sweepstakes if a 3-6 months class is offered**

NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes.

- Sire & Get Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Stud dog may be spayed/neutered. Get must be entered in a regular class.
- Dam & Progeny Brood bitch and two of more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Dam may be spayed/neutered. Progeny must be entered in a regular class.
- Brace Two dogs of one breed (either sex or mixed), **not necessarily owned by the same owner.** Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

Dogs entered in any Unofficial class must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Spayed or neutered dogs may compete in Non-Regular or Unofficial classes.

GUN DOG	For all dogs who have received a Junior Hunter Title or higher, a Working Certificate or higher, in Canada or the United States by the close of entries.
FIELD TRIAL DOG	For all dogs who have earned a Certificate of Merit or better at a Licensed Field Trial, in Canada or the United States by the close of entries
GENERATIONAL CLASS	Consists of three or more dogs in a three or more generation DIRECT line (i.e., Mother or Father with son or daughter and grandson or granddaughter or great grandson or great granddaughter). These dogs are shown together (handled separately). To be judged on similarity of type (similar to stud dog or brood bitch). Dogs may be spayed/neutered and breeder(s) owner(s) need not be identical. Please fill out "Extra Form" .

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Sexually Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered Dog Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes.

Two classes will be offered: **Altered Male & Altered Female**

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners.

The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

JUVENILE & VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Friday Evening, July 11th, 2014

TO COMPETE IN ANY SWEEPSTAKES CLASS, DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS. ENTRY IN JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS IS **NOT ALLOWED EXCEPT FOR PUPPIES AGED 3-6 MONTHS. THESE PUPPIES MAY ENTER FROM THE BABY PUPPY CLASS OR FROM EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MOS.).**

VETERANS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY. VETERANS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.

The Labrador Retriever Club of Canada, Inc. will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% shall be awarded as follows:

First in each class	25% of entry fee
Second in each class	20% of entry fee
Third in each class	10% of entry fee
Fourth in each class	5% of entry fee
Best in Sweepstakes will receive	10% of total entry fee & rosette.
Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweeps	5% of total entry and a rosette.

Juvenile Sweepstakes: Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

3 - 6 months 6 - 9 months 9 - 12 months 12 - 18 months

Veteran Sweepstakes: Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

7 - 9 years 9 - 12 years 12 years & older

BREEDER SWEEPSTAKES
Friday Evening, July 11th, 2014

ENTRY IN BREEDERS SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS IS NOT ALLOWED.

Breeders Sweepstakes: Dog must be handled in the ring by the Breeder or Co-Breeder, but it does not need to be owned by the Breeder or Co-Breeder. Each sex will be judged separately and a first and second place will be awarded. The first place winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. The second place winner to Best in Sweepstakes will then compete for Reserve Best in Sweepstakes.

75% of the total entry fee will be divided as follows:
25% to be divided equally between the two first place winners
20% to be divided equally between the two second place winners
A rosette and 20% will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes
A rosette and 10% will be awarded to Reserve Best in Sweepstakes

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary before the official date and time of entry closing. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Point System: The following point system will provide the basis for award of the LRCC, Inc. National Versatility Challenge Trophy at the annual National Specialty. Points are awarded for prior accomplishments as demonstrated by achievement of CKC titles as well as for demonstrated versatility at the Specialty.

General: A dog **must earn points in all three events** at the Specialty (Conformation, Obedience, and Working Certificate). For Conformation, the candidate dog must be entered in a class where it would compete for Best in Specialty (Exhibition Only classes excluded).

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Evelyn Kenny Kennel & Obedience Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
2. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
3. A judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under CKC rules shall not be subject to any indignity (*CKC dog show rules, 19.7*).
4. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the Club in advance. Please contact the Show Secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.
5. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy +13% Ontario HST.

ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$59.40**. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. **The fee is \$59.40 + 5% GST.**
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

This fee does not have to be paid before entering the show

Information for U.S. Exhibitors on entering Canada

To enter Canada from the States, U.S. Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all U.S. Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.

Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry to Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

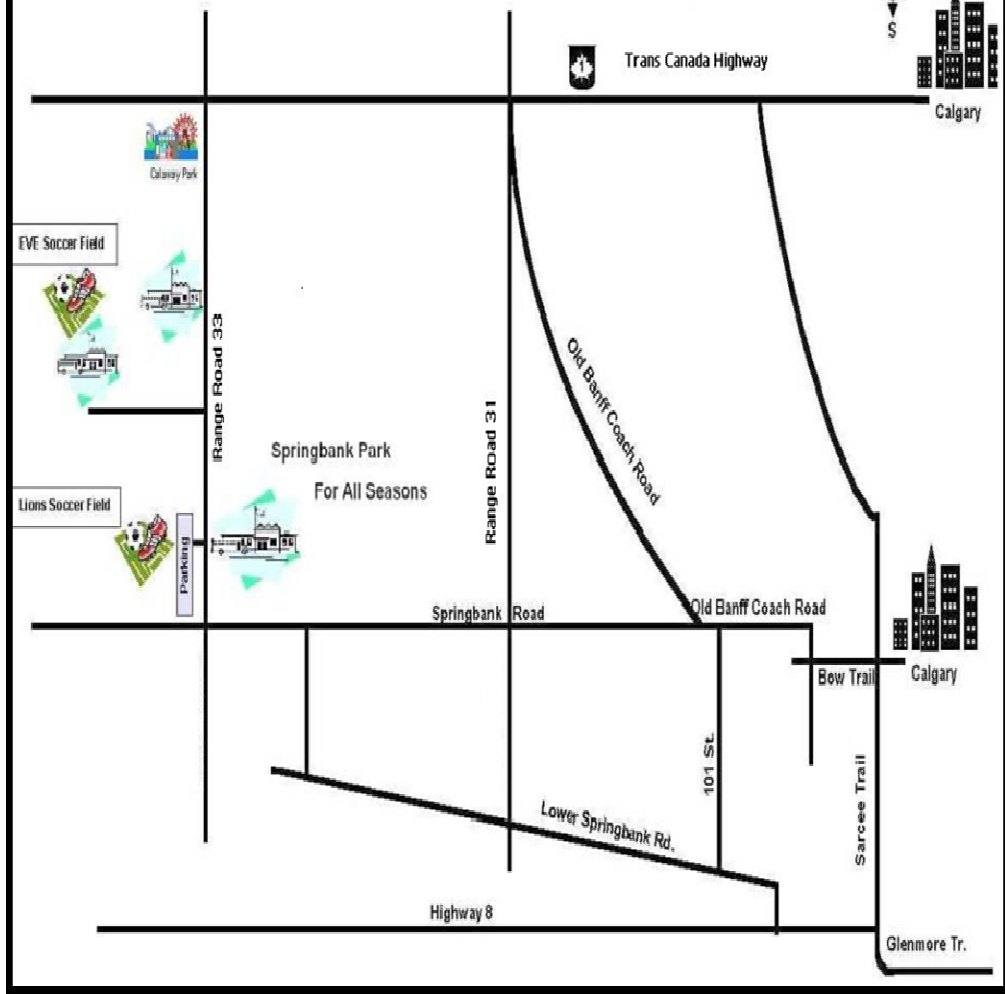
