AKC National Obedience Invitational competitor Matthew Twitty finished his first OTCh in 2005 at the age of 22 with his Novice A dog "Tyler" VTCH (OTCH Twitty's Herdsmens Dream UDX OA OAJ HT RA FDCH-g). Tyler achieved multiple High in Trials and High Combined awards and was a nationally ranked Sheltie during his career. He finished his OTCh with a 1st place win at the very competitive Orlando shows under Judge Jose Martinez with a 198 out of the Utility B class of 41 entrants. Besides Obedience, Matthew and Tyler juggled multiple venues competing in Agility, Rally, Herding and Flyball.

Matthew's next competition dog, "Millie" (Twitty's Little Spice Girl CDX) was also a Multiple High in Trial winner and ranked in Shetland Sheepdogs during her short career. In 2002, Millie was High in Trial at the State of Florida Dog Obedience Clubs of Florida (DOCOF) Competition. Millie had two UD legs before she lost her sight.

Matt's current working partner, "Brandy" (OTCh Northlight Have Ewe Ever UD, VER, OM1, HT, RE) has had a whirlwind career. She finished her OTCh in 4 show weekends, gaining HIT at the ASSA National Specialty, HIT at the State of Florida's DOCOF competition as well as being the #4 Sheltie for the 2012 National Obedience Invitational with very little showing. Matt and Brandy were also invited to a National Obedience Invitational in 2013.

Matthew's true gift lies in his ability to teach and motivate others to raise their own bar and reach for higher goals. His obedience school, Lakeland Canine Academy in Lakeland, Florida has produced 5 Obedience Champions in the few short years it has been open, including the 1st OTCh All American. His students have won numerous titles ranging from Rally Novice Titles to Obedience Trial Championships with many different breeds and mixes. He has trained and coached several students to group wins at the AKC National Obedience Invitational. Always studying and learning new and more innovative techniques, Matt has attended seminars and private lessons with some of America's best Competition Obedience trainers. His joy for Dog Training is apparent and he lives by his motto- "Life is stressful, training your dog shouldn't be".
