ATTENTION: CKC JUNIOR HANDLING RULES – EFFECTIVE JAN. 1, 2019.

Section 3.4.1 "Junior Handler with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handler Number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

Classes Offered: Pee Wee (non-competitive) / Junior Novice / Intermediate Novice / Senior Novice / Junior Open / Intermediate Open / Senior Open.

Age Structure: Pee Wee (4-6 years), Junior (7-11 years), Senior (12-18 years).

Entry Fee: \$2.00 payable at registration. Entries will be taken Saturday, 10:00 - 11:00 a.m. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the show/trial on that day. The LDKC will be offering a rosette for Best Overall Junior Handler.

PLEASE NOTE: ANYONE NOT CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOG IMMEDIATELY (THIS INCLUDES INDOOR EXERCISE PENS) WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE SHOWS FOR THE DURATION OF THE WEEKEND. YOU HAVE BEEN WARNED!!

A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a reporting that this rule has been violated.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following **CKC CONFORMATION** classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months	for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; <u>champions in any country excluded</u>
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
Open	for all dogs.
Specials Only	for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration, ERN or MSC number must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing. The entry of a "listed" dog in Specials Only is not allowed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Baby Puppy	for dogs 3 months of age but under 6 months of age. These puppies do not compete for championship points. Puppies need not be entered in Exhibition Only. There is no listing fee payable on Baby Puppies.
Veterans	for dogs 7 years of age or older. <i>These dogs do not compete for Best of Breed. Dogs may be spayed or neutered. This class will be judged after the Baby Puppy class.</i>
Exhibition Only	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
<u>Exhibition Only (3-6 months)</u>	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in <u>Exhibition Only 3-6 Months</u> provided the Owner has also entered an eligible dog in a Regular Class. <u>These puppies may participate in Sweepstakes, if offered.</u>

****** NEW **** CANINE COMPANION NUMBER (CCN)**

A CCN allows mixed breeds and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events: Agility, Obedience & Rally O. **To enter any trial, the dog MUST have a CC Number prior to entering the event.** A dog in this category may not be entered as "Listed". The application form for the CCN can be found on the CKC website, under Forms On-Line, Registration. The following CKC OBEDIENCE classes will be provided:

- Novice A** This class is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog through its C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent) title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.
- Novice B** This class is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.
- Open HA** The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. Group exercises in Open HA are out of site as before in the original open classes.
- Open18A** The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.
- Open HB** The Open HB class shall be for any dog which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher title may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group exercises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes.
- Open 18B** The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises. As described in the Open HA and Open 18A classes
- Utility A** This class is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X., but has not earned the title of U.D.. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.C.H title may not handle dogs in this class. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class.
- Utility B** This class is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Utility A and Utility B at the same trial.
- Pre Novice** This class is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D (Pre-Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercise. A dog that has earned the title of C.D. is not eligible for this class. This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.
- Novice C** This class is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D., or any Obedience Trial Championship Title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dog in the Novice C Class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title.
- Novice Intermediate** This class is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D., or any Obedience Trial Championship. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open classes.

The following CKC RALLY OBEDIENCE classes will be provided:

- Rally Novice A** Dogs entered in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or member of their immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dogs that have earned titles or are not the owners may enter in the Novice B class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
- Rally Novice B** Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class has been earned. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
- Rally Intermediate** This class shall be for dogs that have earned the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other Obedience or Rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely.
- Rally Advanced A** This class is for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
- Rally Advanced B** This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. Upon completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title a dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
- Rally Excellent A** This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (RE) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. A dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class after official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title (RE). No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A & B at any one trial. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judge off leash and the dog must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
- Rally Excellent B** This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title. A dog may compete in this class indefinitely. Any person is allowed to handle a dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Master

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE. A dog completing the RM.title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

For information only:

Rally Advanced Excellent title -- Upon completion of the Rally Excellent title, qualifying scores may be accumulated from Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B to earn the Rally Advanced Excellent (RAE) title. To receive the RAE title, a dog must qualify ten (10) times in both Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent at the same trial. The title will appear at the end of the dog's name and a numeric designation will indicate the number of times the dog has met the requirements, i.e. RAE2, RAE3, etc.

Rally Master Excellent (RMX) title -- Upon completion of the Rally Master title, qualifying scores may be accumulated from the Rally Excellent B class and the Rally Master class to earn the Rally Master Excellent (RMX) title. In order to receive the RMX title, a dog must qualify ten (10) times in both the Rally Excellent B class and the Rally Master class at the same trial with scores of 90 or higher in Excellent and 85 or higher in Master. Double qualifying scores must be earned under at least five (5) different judges. The RMX title will appear at the end of the dog's name and a numeric designation will indicate the number of times the dog has met RMX requirements – i.e., RMX2, RMX3, etc.

To be eligible to compete in these Obedience or Rally Obedience trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS – EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$63.90 plus 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. CKC Non-Member Participation Fee - (24-12-3)

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"*

This fee does not have to be paid before entering this show.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of closing of entries for show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the order/handler at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show.

When one or more all-breed championship shows and/or specialty shows are held on the same date in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

ERRORS IN ENTRIES

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience/Rally Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
3. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY EMAIL after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7.
5. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
6. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarians certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
7. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.

8. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
9. SHOW PRECINCTS shall be the entire North & Main Pavilions, and Exhibition Park.
10. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.

ATTENTION: building opening/closing times – open 6 am sharp, and close at 11 pm sharp

Dogs may be left in the building overnight, so long as they are crated and owners/handlers leave a phone number where they can be reached in case of emergency – on EVERY crate.
