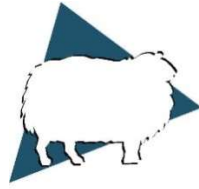

Obedience Judging is based on: Utility - 6 dogs/hour, Open - 7 dogs/hour, Novice A, B, C, Intermediate - 8 dogs/hour & Pre-Novice - 9 dogs/hour.

Rally Obedience Judging is based on 15 dogs/hour plus a 10 min walk-through time per class.

Exhibitors are advised to check judge's sheets when posted and to immediately advise of any inaccuracies.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to the trials.

No prong or spike collars are permitted on site.

All exhibitors will be responsible for the clean-up of their own dogs anywhere on the trial site and surrounding areas.

MG7 JUNIOR HANDLING

Maritime Group 7 is offering both Junior Conformation Handling and Junior Obedience Handling as part of our Specialty. There will be a charge of \$2.00 to be paid at Registration.

The Junior Conformation Handling will take place on Saturday, May 23rd in Ring 4, immediately following the MG7 Conformation Specialty. It could be around 1:00 pm or later. Each Junior Handler must handle a Herding Dog

The Junior Obedience Handling will take place on Saturday, May 23rd, immediately following the MG7 All-Breed Obedience Trial in Ring 5.

PHOTOGRAPHER

Official Show Photographer will be Oslach Photography, Ammon, NB (506-204-8355). No other photographers may take official photographs or photos for resale within the show's precincts unless by special arrangement with the Show Photographer and the Show Committee (this includes Live Streaming). Only pictures for personal use may be taken.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Exhibitors or Handlers are solely responsible for having their dogs at ringside when classes are called. It is not the responsibility of the Ring Steward to locate dogs. Absentees should be reported to the Ring Steward. Judges will not wait for any dog not present when called or for any exhibitor or handler in another ring. Please arrange to have alternate handlers available.

Breeds are grouped according to table, ramp or floor/ground.

The PRECINCTS of these shows will be in designated areas where the Shows and Trials are being held within The Moncton Coliseum Complex.

Exhibitors are advised to check the judges' sheets when posted and to immediately advise of any inaccuracies. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to know the rules pertaining to shows.

The Moncton Kennel Club and the Moncton Coliseum / Agrena Complex will not be responsible for any belongings left in the building or outdoors. Please do not leave valuables unattended.

No dogs are allowed to be left in the building overnight.
