SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows:

Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed

ALTERED SWEEPSTAKES

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. All dogs <u>MUST</u> be entered in the Altered class or for Exhibition Only.

This Sweepstakes event will be divided by sex as follows:

Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be will then compete for the awards of Best Altered in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex Altered in Sweepstakes.

PRIZES: Best Altered in Sweepstakes - 30% of total fees collected/ rosette/prize, Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes - 25% of total fees collected/ rosette/prize, 1st in each class - 10% of total fees collected/rosette/prize. A rosette will be awarded to 2nd through 4th place in Altered Sweepstakes.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED BY SEX AS FOLLOWS:

7 to 9 years Male/Female, 9 to 11 years Male/Female 11+ years Male/Female

<u>PRIZES:</u> Best Veteran in Sweepstakes - 25% of total fees collected/ rosette/prize, Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes - 20% of total fees collected/ rosette/prize, 1st in each class - 5% of total fees collected/rosette/prize. A participant rosette will be awarded to all other entrants.

Balance of 25% to be retained by the club to defray costs

BREEDER SWEEPSTAKES

Open for dogs bred and handled by but not necessarily owned by the breeder. The following classes will be provided:

Breeder Sweepstakes – Males Breeder Sweepstakes - Females

PRIZES: Best in Breeder Sweepstakes - 30% of total fees collected/ rosette/prize, Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes - 25% of total fees collected/ rosette/prize, 1st in each class - 10% of total fees collected/rosette/prize. A rosette will be awarded to 2nd through 4th place in Breeder Sweepstakes.

Balance of 25% to be retained by the club to defray costs

Conformation Classifications

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered **BABY PUPPY CLASS-** This class shall be for Rottweiler puppies **3 months of age**

and under 6 months of age on the day of the Specialty. (Note: dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE for points).

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog **9** months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12 to 18 MONTH CLASS - For dogs 12 months & under 18 months on the day of this Specialty

<u>CANADIAN BRED CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.

(Champions of any country excluded)

<u>BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler <u>MUST</u> be the owner/co-owner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog, which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

ADDITIONAL REGULAR SPECIALTY CLASSES

The following additional regular classes will be offered at this Specialty:

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u> For dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of this Show. Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS (*This class will be divided into 3 age divisions* – 7 to 9 yrs, 10 & 11 yrs and 12+ yrs. Winners of each class will carry through to compete for Best of Breed) PLEASE NOTE: SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS MAY COMPETE IN THIS CLASS

ADDITIONAL NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL SPECIALTY CLASSES

The following unofficial/non-regular classes will be offered at this Specialty:

BRACE CLASS - Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily of the same sex)

(Note: effective January 1, 2006 – identical ownership NO LONGER applies)

<u>SIRE & GET</u> - Shall comprise the Sire and two or more of his Get (Note: Get <u>MUST</u> be entered in a Regular class)

<u>DAM & PROGENY</u> - Shall have all the same requirements as the Sire & Get Class (Note: Progeny <u>MUST</u> be entered in a Regular class

PROPERTY CLASS (Best Tailed) – best Rottweiler with a tail

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

- 1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
- 2. ANY DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT, COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR THE BALANCE OF THE SHOW
- 3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
- 4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED. 5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM THE ENTRY WAS MADE.
- 6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- 7. DOGS ARE TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF SHOW RINGS
- 8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
- 9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, THERE IS NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
- 10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.

ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall not be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and (2) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

NEW CKC RULES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2006

8.2.5 – An error in the class, date of birth or sex of the dog may be amended on the entry form up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show.

8.5.8 – In the case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes within the show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition (armband) number. A new entry, along with accompanying entry fees and listing fees (if applicable), will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the opening of the show (see section 3.32, 3.51 & 8.5.4)

8.9.3 – When one or more all-breed and/or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the all-breed or Specialty show.

12.3.1 – A Puppy awarded Best Puppy in Group is NOT required to stay for Best Puppy in Show.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL.

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL

RALLY NOVICE A: Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY NOVICE B: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on

RALLY ADVANCED A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY ADVANCED B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. RALLY EXCELLENT A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY EXCELLENT B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash except the Honour Exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL

the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN **ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE "B" CLASS **NOVICE "B"** - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but **MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN** "B" CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>OPEN "B"</u> - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS**. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'A'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'B'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES: Unofficial

Refer to Section 15 of the O.T.R.&R. The rules are paraphrased below. The following classes are offered at these Trials:

<u>VETERAN'S CLASS</u> - is open to dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years and older. Dogs entered in this class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

<u>GRADUATE NOVICE CLASS</u> - This class is open to all dogs that have not gained a qualifying score toward the "CDX" title in Canada BUT that has obtained the title "CD" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

<u>GRADUATE OPEN CLASS</u> - This class is open to all dogs that have not obtained a qualifying score toward the "UD title in Canada BUT which has obtained the title "CDX" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

<u>VERSATILITY CLASS</u> - This class is open to all dogs that have attained the title of "CDX" in Canada and at least 1 leg on the Utility title, or that has obtained the "UD" title in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

<u>BRACE CLASS</u> - This class is open to any two dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person NEED NOT own both dogs.

<u>TEAM CLASS</u> - This class is open to any four dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person NEED NOT own all four dogs.

DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN ANY OF THE REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: The word 'trainer' means any person who conducts or has conducted a dog obedience training class or who regularly assists with the training of dogs in said class or who regularly trains dogs belonging to any person outside his/her immediate family

TRANSITION OBEDIENCE CLASSES

<u>PRE-NOVICE</u> – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "C" – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
