Entries open on Tuesday, June 3, 2025 at 7:00 pm on a first received basis. Entries will continue to be accepted until limits are met or until June 24, 2025. Late and/or Day of Show entries are not a guaranteed entry and will be accepted only up to judging limits. Up to 20% of the entries may be taken by club workers. Confirmations may not be sent for late entries. Judges are limited to 8 hours judging and a maximum run value, which will require this Club to limit entries accordingly. **Move Ups, Move Downs and Lateral Moves** are allowed between trials.

Entry Fees \$15 (CA) Instinct, Line Drive; \$20 Novice, Open; \$25 Senior, Master and Crazy 8s, per class.

Event Grounds – are designated as the barn, the area between the barn hunt barn and the cow barn, the parking lot and the roadway from the left dyke access to the right dyke access.

Run Order - Tentative run order for all days will be Ring 1 & 3 Instinct, Novice 1, Novice 2, Open 1, Open 2, Senior 1, Senior 2, Crazy 8 2 Ring 2 Crazy 8s 1, Master 1, Master 2; Ring 3. Line Drive will run in Ring 1 and be judged by club members.

Fraser Valley Ratters reserves the right to change the run order based on entries received and shall send out the final class run order and judging schedule **TWO DAYS** prior to the start of the trial.

Senior and Crazy 8s dogs will be staged in groups of 5 in a 10 × 20 tent blind. Instinct, novice, open and line drive will have blinds of 6; crazy 8s and master will have blinds of 5 in spacious 16×25 foot indoor blinds. Dogs handled by the same person will be in separate blinds.

Judge of Record and Event Official dogs may be judged prior to the official start time or as the first blind(s) of the Event.

Directions to 4480 Hunt Road, Agassiz, BC

From Mission, take the Lougheed (BC 7) eastbound. Right on Cameron Road (first right after you come off Woodside Mountain.) Right on Hunt Road (past the railroad tracks, then between the farm and the rose garden.) Follow to the end of the road, which ends in the farmyard. Barn Hunt barn on front right side, across from sink.

From the Trans Canada (Highway 1) eastbound, take Exit 135 (BC 9) towards Agassiz/Harrison Hot Springs. Follow through Agassiz on BC 9. At 4 way stop, go left on BC 7 towards Mission. Left on Cameron Road. Right on Hunt Road (past the railroad tracks, then between the farm and the rose garden.) Follow to the end of the road, which ends in the farmyard. Barn Hunt barn on front right side, across from sink.

Exhibitor Information

Crating

All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times unless actively working. The trial will be held in a concrete and dirt floored partially open barn. Indoor dog crating will not be available. There is parking nearby to crate in cars. Parking spaces are first come, first served.

Collars and Leads

Electronic collars, bark collars, muzzles and head halters are not allowed on Barn Hunt show grounds. Collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced are strongly recommended for the ring. No flexi leads in the barn, except in Line Drive class.

Bitches in Season - Bitches in season MAY compete at a Barn Hunt Trial. They will be run at the end of each class and will be crated and pottied in a designated area. Bitches in season MUST wear pants at all times except when being pottied. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial. Bitches in season will be crated between the cow barn and the Quonset and will be pottied in that area.

Eligibility - Open to all breeds and mixed breeds, 6 months or older. Your dog **must** be registered with the Barn Hunt Association to participate in this event.

Height Divisions (at withers) - a measuring wicket is available at the trial secretary table.

Small - 15" and under Medium - 15.1" to 22" Large - over 22"

Dog Aggression

Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner towards another dog or a person may be dismissed from the trial at the discretion of the judge and/or trial committee.

Safety

The safety of our dogs and rats are a primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport (<u>Barn Hunt Association Competitor Rulebook</u>) and that their dogs are familiar with and physically able to perform all course elements.

Abuse of any kind towards volunteers, dogs, rats, competitors, judges or trial committee will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from this event.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each height category of the A classes and Master B, 1st through 4th in the remaining B classes and for all qualifiers. Rosettes will be awarded for 1st place, High in Class, Clean Crazy 8 Runs and New Titles. Special awards may be made at the discretion of the Trial Committee.

Refunds and Cancellation Policy

After the closing date, entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. No event fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.

Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog will be eligible for a 75% refund of entry fees paid upon receipt of a note from a veterinarian. The note must be dated and emailed or mailed to the Trial Secretary prior to the close of the trial.

Returned Check

A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$35 fee for all returned checks.

Smoking or Vaping There is NO SMOKING or vaping in the barn area. If you must smoke, please do so inside your vehicle or off the event site.
